- A 6-foot leash with dog wearing a buckle, slip or martingale collar made of nylon, fabric, leather or chain.
- A grooming tool brush or comb
- A plastic bag for picking up after your dog

Test to include the following exercises:

1. Accepting a friendly stranger.	7. Come when called.
2. Politely accepts petting.	8. Praise/interaction.
3. Appearance and grooming.	9. Reaction to a passing dog.
4. Out for walk.	10. Reaction to distraction.
5. Walking through a crowd.	11. Supervised isolation.
6. Sit/Down on command and stay in place.	12. Walking through a door/gate.
