If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Lady Slipper Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.

- > The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- > Due to the limited amount of space, the superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to cooperate with the superintendent in this regard.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- > Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted in the building.
- The building will be open from 3 to 8 pm Friday evening and will open I hour before the start of each day's shows. Dogs will not be permitted in the building overnight. No vehicles permitted inside the arena.

## CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS - chapter 15

**Section 1** - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

#### Section 2:

Dogs competing \* 1 2 3-5 6-9 10-12 13 or more Points allocated 0 1 2 3 4 5

\* includes the dog awarded winners

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded winners also places in the group.

A class dog awarded best in show at an all breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.
