Brace

Non-regular class: For 2 dogs handled by 1 person, with 1 lead. Dogs must be entered in a regular class, altered class or exhibition only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed. Ownership does NOT need to be identical.

Best Canadian Bred In Specialty

All Canadian bred dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another Canadian bred dog shall be eligible to compete for this award. The Best Canadian Bred in the regular classes and the Best Canadian Bred in the altered classes will compete for Best Canadian Bred in Specialty.

Stud Dog & Get.....And......Brood Bitch & Progeny

Non-regular class: A dog or bitch with 2 or more offspring.

Dogs must be entered in a regular class, altered class or exhibition only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed. Ownership does not need to be identical.

Award of Merit

One (1) Award of Merit for every ten (10) dogs competing at the Best of Breed level (regular classes only) shall be awarded.

Puppy & Veteran Sweeps
