ELECTIVE CLASS INFORMATION

Note: 2015 brought in a new Rally class called Intermediate. It is an OPTIONAL class that uses signs # 1 to 118 and is performed ON LEASH with no jump incorporated. Earning a title in Intermediate is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced

- To be eligible to compete in a rally trials, a dog must be 6 months of age and be registration with the CKC, with an Event Registration Number (ERN), a Performance Event Number (PEN), a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or a Canadian Companion Number (CCN) all of which can be obtained by contacting CKC at www.ckc.ca
- Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
- Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

The following classes will be offered in each Rally Obedience trial: Rally Novice A, Rally Novice B, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced, B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B.

RALLY NOVICE A:

Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B:

Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE:

The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes.

(CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the

R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely.

The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course or it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A:

This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A:

This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

DETAILS AND INFORMATION ABOUT OUR FACILITY – KELOWNA DOG SPORT CENTRE

Precincts of the trial are the barn and parking area. Other areas are out of bounds.

Parking is along side the red barn ONLY. (facing south) Form two rows leaving enough room for the vehicles parked against the barn to back out easily.

These trials are being held in a dog training centre that is only partially heated. Be prepared for winter conditions.

There is non heated crating room in the building along the concrete walk way. Very limited power.

Porta Potty on site.

This facility is in the middle of a turf farm. Please do not let your dogs onto the farm whether it looks like turf or not.

There is no off leash area at this trial site. But there is a dog park only five minutes away. Ask for directions.

Please pick up after your dog.

No Concession on Site

Tim Hortons, Subway, and various other restaurants are available within 2 KM.

Directions to Site ----- Kelowna Dog Sport Centre

From the North: at Highway 97, immediately after the overpass, turn East (left) onto Hereron Road. Turn North (Left) almost right away onto Bulman Road. Watch for the Kelowna Dog Sport Centre sign on the right. THIS IS A TURF FARM! Drive down to the red barn and park on the North Side. DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DOG TO MAKE ANY CONTACT WITH THE TURF!

From the West/South: Travel North through Kelowna and as you are leaving the city you will see signs about Golf. Turn Right at the "go to golf" sign which is just before the overpass. (Hereron Road.) Turn North (Left) almost right away onto Bulman Road. Watch for the Kelowna Dog Sport Centre sign on the right. THIS IS A TURF FARM! Drive down to the red barn and park on the North Side. DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DOG TO MAKE ANY CONTACT WITH THE TURF!

Other information – GENERAL, CKC

19.6 Any person, either within or outside the judging ring, who does anything calculated to attract, distract or otherwise interfere in any way with the attention, deportment, or performance of a dog under judgment, may be disciplined by the Discipline Committee in whatever way it considers to be in the best interest of the club, or the judge may take summary action.

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

Non Member Participation Fee will apply to dog owners wishing to receive titles for their dogs if they not CKC members \$57.60 + HST. A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member

participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

ATTENTION: FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you sent a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please DO NOT make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds.

NSF Cheques

In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheques.

Telephone entries are not accepted by the Trial Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries. Please mail or email entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date
