I started my passion for purebred dogs at 12 years of age when I received a Pomeranian puppy as a gift from my parents in 1964. He was from Mrs. Evelyn Kenny's, Kenlynn Pomeranians and I soon was learning obedience, how to groom and how to show him. Needless to say, I got hooked. As time went on I got an Afghan and showed her then in 1974, I finally found my first two Borzoi which came out of two famous kennels of the time. The sire was from Volga Kennels of Bruna Henry's in the USA and the dam from Sirhan Kennel in Canada, Audrey Benbow. It's been a life time passion ever since.

I started judging in 1994 and am licensed to judge Groups 1, 2 and 3.

Over the years I have held the position of president of Borzoi Canada and Alberta Sporting Hound Association and helped with facilitating the judges committee in Alberta with breed workshops. I currently breed only Borzoi under the Taugo Perm Reg'd name and have enjoyed a fair amount of success with the dogs I've bred. They have also done well all over the world for many other breeders. I look forward to judging their smaller cousins at your first Specialty! I find them very delightful.

**VALERIE HANSEN
KHARDHANI AFGHANS and RISQUÉ CHINESE CRESTEDS**



Most of my purebred dog life has been in Afghan Hounds. I bought my first Afghan from Miles & Greta Phillips of Kophi Kennels fame back in 1969 and subsequent to that, I bought two boys from Glorvina Schwartz of Sandina Kennels in New York. Those 2 boys were the foundation of my breeding program. Every single dog I kept from my breeding program were Group winning or placing dogs, and two of these became best in show winners. All of the Afghans I specialized were within the top 5 Afghans with 2 of them No 1, 2 & 3 in the Breed. After my last Affie was retired, I acquired a Chinese Crested boy – Ryley, from Wind Chinese Cresteds. He & his Afghan were best buddies. Ryley mostly hangs out at home these days bringing us great joy and playing in the rings occasionally as a veteran.

I began my judging career back in 1997 when I wrote my first exam. I have been fortunate to judge several Afghan and Sighthound Specialties including Canada and the U.S. and have also judged in Bogota, Columbia. I am currently licenced to judge Gr. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 7, and am completing my final permit of Gr. 6.

I am currently Past President of the Afghan Hound Club of Canada (yes, still my heart breed) – a total of 3 terms. In the past, I've been President, Director and Education Chair of the Southern Alberta Canine Judges Association. I've been involved in the past with the Alberta Kennel Club assisting with show secretary duties and was a founding member of the Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club. Besides show secretary assistance, I've stewarded for many years for many clubs. Lately, I've been Show Secretary for some Specialty Clubs which is something I certainly enjoy.

In addition, I was employed in the oil & gas industry in Calgary, Alberta from the early '80s until 2013 - it seems I'm retired now. These days as I really hate not working, I'm putting my name in the professional show secretary ring. I have been happily married for 31 years to my very patient husband Marshall.

Important Information

ISWS Show Rules page 11: SECTION 3 — Conditions Affecting Eligibility of Dogs No entry may be made and no entry shall be accepted by a Show Secretary which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

1. Any Silken Windhound shall be eligible to be entered in an ISWS show if it meets one of the following conditions: a) the dog is individually registered and entered into the ISWS Stud Book; or b) the dog is part of an ISWS-registered litter that has been assigned a Litter Number.
2. Any Silken Windhound that is part of an ISWS-registered litter with a previously assigned Litter Number may be entered in an ISWS show. Such a dog will remain eligible to enter additional ISWS shows for 30 days after the date of the first show in which the dog was entered. The dog must be individually registered with the ISWS during that 30 day period.
3. If the dog is not individually registered with the ISWS during that 30-day period, any points, majors, or championships earned may be lost unless the owner of the dog can clearly demonstrate (in writing to the ISWS Show Recorder and the ISWS Registrar) that the delay in registration is due to circumstances beyond the control of the owner.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following regular ISWS classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs (except Champions) between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs (except Champions) between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show that are not ISWS Champions. This class does not compete for BEST PUPPY.
NOVICE	dogs (except champions) 6 months of age or older that have not yet won: (a) 3 first place prizes against competition in the Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class, (b) 3 or more points towards their ISWS championship or (c) have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries.
CANADIAN BRED	dogs (except champions) 6 months of age or over that have been both bred and whelped in Canada.
AMERICAN BRED	dogs (except champions) 6 months of age or over that have been both bred and whelped in the United States of America.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs (except champions) that are: a. 6 months of age or over on the date of the show, b. owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record on the date of the show and c. handled by a breeder/owner or breeder/co-owner of record on the date of the show. There are no handler restrictions in any subsequent classes for which the dog becomes eligible at the show.
OPEN CLASS	any dog (except champions) 6 months of age or over.
VETERANS CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
PERFORMANCE CHAMPION CLASS	all dogs (except ISWS conformation champions) that have earned a performance championship. Proof of a championship title for straight racing (ISWS or LGRA), oval racing (ISWS or NOTRA), lure coursing (ISWS or ASFA) or open field coursing (NOFCA or other recognized open field coursing association) must be submitted with the show entry. A copy of the championship certificate or a printout from the website of the appropriate organization showing that the dog has earned a championship will suffice as proof of championship title. **
CHAMPION	dogs who are ISWS Champions at the time the entry is submitted

**Copy of championship to be emailed to event secretary (cswseventsecretary@rimouski.org) when entry is submitted.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASS

In order for a dog to be entered in any Non-Regular or Unofficial class, dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

ALTERED NOVICE***	For all altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over that have not yet won (a) 3 first-place prizes against competition in the Altered Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class, (b) 3 or more points towards their Altered ISWS championship or (c) have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries.
ALTERED OPEN***	for all altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over
ALTERED CHAMPION ***	dogs who are ISWS Altered Champions

BRACE	A brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of one handler. This class shall be judged 40% on conformation, 40% on matching looks, and 20% on difficulty of the match. Entries in this class are not required to be intact, to be the same sex, or to be entered in any regular class. Both dogs must have one common owner.
STUD DOG CLASS	Stud dog with 2 or more of his progenies (max four). The stud dog must be shown in the ring with his progeny. The stud dog may be neutered, but the progeny must be intact. The stud dog's owner is not required to own the progeny. All progeny shown in this class must be entered in one of the regular classes. .
BROOD BITCH CLASS	Brood Bitch and two or more of her progenies (max four). The brood bitch must be shown in the ring with her progeny. The brood bitch may be spayed, but the progeny must be intact. The brood bitch's owner is not required to own the progeny. All progeny shown in this class must be entered in one of the regular classes
EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in non-Regular classes (Brace, Stud Dog & Get, Brood Bitch & Progeny).

*** If your altered dog was neutered via a vasectomy, please provide a copy of the Veterinarian's certificate to be emailed to event secretary (cswseventsecretary@rimouski.org) when entry is submitted.

If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- Please check the Canada Border Services website for current travel requirements to enter Canada.

To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens aged 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by ISWS rules.
3. Entries will be acknowledged by email, with receipt and judging schedule. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.

4. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. 5. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under ISWS Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

About the Fast Dash Program

The Fast Dash Program is a 100-yard timed dash program.

This program is meant to parallel the AKC Fast CAT program offering Silkens titles with the parent club subject to the following rules:

1. The Silken Windhound must be 12 months or older AND be registered with the International Silken Windhound Society. When an owner is providing the record keeper for the program with documentation for the Silkens' first timed event they must also provide a copy of the dogs ISWS registration certificate. This can be done by sending the record keeper a link to your dog's page in the pedigree database or by scanning and emailing its ISWS papers to the recordkeeper
2. The AKC club or other organization that is administering the Fast CAT tests (100-to-200-yard speed timed event) must be amenable to providing either a ribbon with the dog's call name, owner and speed written on it or write the information on an index card or some other document that the owner can take and then later provide the documentation to the record keeper for the program.
3. All Silkens will receive their miles per hour as their score for each test and may participate in 2 tests per day. They will not receive any extra points for being smaller or larger.
4. Owners are advised that if you agree to pay TO THE ADMINISTERING CLUB a FULL ENTRY FEE rather than a practice fee the clubs are much more likely to be amenable to timing your dog and providing you with written documentation of dog's name, owners name, date, speed, and name of the club and the person (secretary) for the event on a card or ribbon.
5. Titles shall be as follows:
 1. 150 points (mph) shall be the BFAST title (Beginning Fast)
 2. 500 points (mph) shall be the IFAST title (Intermediate Fast)
 3. 1000 points (mph) shall be the FAST title
 4. Should a dog participate to 2000 points etc. it shall be FAST2, FAST3 etc.
6. Owners are responsible for providing proof of participation and scores along with the dog's registration with ISWS to the registrar for the program.
7. Dogs achieving any of the above titles will be posted on the ISWS official email groups as having done so and will receive a certificate stating such via email that they may print out. At any ISWS shows they are to be used as suffix titles to the dog's name.
