CKC RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

8.2.5—An error in the age specified class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to ONE hour before to the start of the show.

8.5.8—In case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes of a show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show (see section 3.3.1, 3.5.1, 8.5.4)

8.9.3—When one or more all-breed and /or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

Agreement to Hold Harmless

The Portage Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.

There will be no night watchman.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN): Effective Jan. 1, 1992, all foreign born and foreign owned dogs that enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration #, but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Forms to apply for an ERN will be available at the show. Or simply send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, with a written request for an ERN number and a check for \$58.85 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club, Shows and Trials, 200 Ronson Dr., Suite 400, Etobicoke, Ontario. Attention Foreign Exhibitor

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian funds. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark the cheques "Payable in Canadian Fund" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the bank.

Juvenile Sweepstakes (FDCC only)

Open to all Dachshund puppies over six months and under eighteen months of age who are entered in the Regular official classes of the respective Specialty Show. Puppies will be divided by sex (not Breed) as follows: 6 – 9 months, 9 – 12 months, 12 – 19 months.

For final judging, the first place winners from each class will be brought together to select the Best Puppy In Sweepstake. The puppy placing second in class to this puppy will return for selection of First Runner-Up.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES: (FDCC only)

Open to all Dachshunds over 7 yrs on the day of the Specialty who are entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition Only in the respective Specialty. Altered Veterans are eligible. The Veterans will be divided by sex (Not Breed) into the following classes: 7-10 yrs and 10 yrs & over.

Prizes: A Rosette will be offered for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and for Best of Opposite Sex.

Ribbons will be offered for 1st to 4th in Classes.

Monies from entry fees will be allocated as follows 30% to Best Veteran in Sweeps; 20% for Best of Opposite Sex and 10% for 1st in class.

VETERAN For any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but

the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS

MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.

ALTERED eligibility for the Sexually Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have

been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Please refer to the Official CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations (January 2013) for a complete description and entry requirements for the following classes. CKC rules on classification shall govern and be controlling as to these requirements and any other requirements contained therein.

Stud Dog & Get Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. The stud dog may be

neutered and must be entered in either a Regular class or in Exhibition only. Get must be entered in a

Regular class.

Brood Bitch & Progeny This class has the same requirements as Stud dog and Get.

Brace Two dogs of one breed (either sex or mixed) and must be handled by one person, one lead.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS & CANCELLATIONS

SECTION 15.1.1 A dog awarded WINNERS at a CONFORMATION show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. SECTION 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING* $\,$ 1 $\,$ 2 $\,$ 3 to 5 $\,$ 6 to 9 $\,$ 10 to 12 $\,$ 13 or more

POINTS AWARDED 0 1 2 3 4

*includes the dog awarded WINNERS

In counting the number eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

See Sections 15.1.3 to 15.1.7 of the CKC Rules and Regulations for Championship Points.

SECTION 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group Level.

SECTION 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with no more than 5 championship points in a single show.

SECTION 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

SECTION 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best In Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

SECTION 15.1.12 In or for a dog to be recognized as a Champion, and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, a dog must:

- (a) earned 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an ERN or MCN
- (c) have earned a least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

SECTION 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
