- 1. The Show Superintendent will have full charge of the Shows and Trials.
- All entries must be complete. Handlers or Agents Note: The full name and address of owner must be included. The Show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries will not be accepted (except in the case of a postal strike).
- 3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of an entry after the closing date, except in the case of Obedience entries or moving Class Dogs to Specials, is prohibited.
- 4. Entries must be received by the Show Secretary prior to closing. Withdrawal of OB/Rally entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but must be FOLLOWED UP BY WRITTEN or ELECTRONIC NOTIFICATION to reach the Show Secretary no later than OFFICIAL CLOSING DATE AND TIME as stated in the premium list. If such notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.
- 5. Exhibitors will receive a judging schedule as soon as possible after entries close.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
- No refund of entry fees will be made if impossible to open or complete the Show and Trials because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Kenora & District Dog Club.
- 8. Refunds will be made when a bitch entered in Obed/Rally comes into season after entry has been submitted if a Veterinarian's certificate is delivered to the Show Secretary two (2) hours prior to judging.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 - The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with Ch. 13, Sec. 13.8 of these rules after closing date and time for entries for a show but whose Championship is unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from the regular classes to SPECIALS ONLY provided the request for same is submitted to the Show Secretary AT LEAST ONE HOUR (1) PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW by the owner or handler.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY, 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration BEFORE the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a LISTED dog. Listing fees, however, WILL NOT be refunded.

CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATIONS

In all breeds recognized by the CKC the following classes will be provided for, divided by sex:

Junior Puppy - A dog between 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show Senior Puppy - A dog between 9 months and under 12 months on the day of the show 12 - 18 Months - A dog between 12 months and under 18 monthson the day of the show Canadian Bred - A dog born in Canada (Champions of any other country excluded)

Bred by Exhibitor - The handler of the dog is also the breeder and owner

NOTE: In breeds where classes are divided by color, weight, or coat, indicate clearly in the class division on the entry form.

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

NOVICE A - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its UD Title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongly entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled. **NOVICE B** – Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person and shall be for purebred dogs of any breed, which have not won the title of CD in Canada.

OPEN A - NO licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its UD Title in Canada or elsewhere what be allowed to compete as an exhibitor or otherwise. When a dog is wrongly entered in this class, any score

OPEN B - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person and shall be for purebred dogs of any breed which have won the title of CDX in Canada.

UTILITY - This class shall be for purebred dogs of any breed which shall have won the title of CDX in Canada. Handlers. trainers and kennel employees may compete in this class.

PRE NOVICE -- Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person and shall be for purebred dogs of any breed which have not earned the title of PCD in Canada or earned the title of CD in Canada or any other country. NOVICE INTERMEDIATE -- Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person and shall be for purebred dogs of any breed who have earned the title of CD or any other advanced obedience title in Canada. Dogs may

compete indefinitely in this class. Not eligible for High in Trial. NOVICE C - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person and shall be for purebred dogs of any breed who have earned the title of CD or any other advanced obedience title in Canada. Dogs may compete indefinitely in this class. Not eligible for High in Trial.

NOTE: The word "trainer" means any person who conducts a dog obedience class or who regularly assists with the training of dogs in said class, or who regularly trains dogs belonging to persons outside his or her immediate family. A dog which has earned its CD title in the USA is hot eligible for entry in NOVICE A class and a dog which has earned its CDX title in the USA is not eligible for entry in the OPEN A class. Such dogs must be entered in the B classes respectively. Entry of a listed dog in OPEN or UTILITY is not permitted. UNOFFICIAL CLASSES: Brace, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Team and Veterans.
