The trial precinct shall consist of all areas inside the St. John's Recreation Center as well as the parking lot.

The National Pekinese Club of Canada (NPCC) will consider the judging of Pekinese by Lee Anne Bateman on Sunday July 9th (Show 3) as a breed booster. President Lois McIntosh, Vice President David Kelland, Treasurer Tammy Bletcher, Secretary Michael Hill, and Director, Atlantic Provinces Gary Tucker. Prizes will be awarded for Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best Puppy, Best Baby Puppy, and Best Veteran.

The Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Atlantic Canada will consider the judging of Cavalier King Charles Spaniels by Douglas Anderson on Saturday July 8th (Show 2) as a breed booster. President Paul Oslach, Vice President Trish Wright, Secretary & Treasurer Jayne Hudson, Past President Peter Alders, Membership Director Janie Girouard, Communications Director Susan Smith, NS & NL Director Wendy Aalders, and NB & PEI Director Steve Hazelwood. Prizes will be awarded for Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best Puppy, Best Baby Puppy, Best Veteran, and Best Altered.

Puppy & Veteran Sweepstakes will be held on Saturday July 8th, judged by Jane Francis. Dogs must be entered in one of the regular official classes to be eligible for Sweepstakes. The following classes will be offered, divided by sex: 4-6 Months, 6-9 Months, 9-12 Months, 12-18 Months, 7+ Years.

The following percentage of entry fees per class will be offered as cash prizes: Best Puppy in Sweepstakes & Best Veteran in Sweepstakes – 15%, Best of Opposite – 10%, Class Winners – 50%.

Fee Structure

25% discount for three or more dogs entered in Regular classes in all four shows, all owned by the same person. Professional handlers excluded.

There will be no refunds for withdrawn entries after the closing date.

All exhibitors must cover the floor of their grooming area. Plastic, paper or fabric material which may be secured with painter's tape. (Duct tape is NOT permissible.) The floors have recently been replaced and there is a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for uncovered grooming space.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

There will be a veterinarian on call throughout all shows via the Veterinary Specialty Center at 709- 221-7838.

All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Clean up bags and garbage bins are available for this purpose throughout the show site. There continues to be those who do not take responsibility for their dogs, jeopardizing the club's access to this venue. For this reason, exhibitors who permit a dog to soil on the show grounds without cleaning up will be denied entry to NKC shows and trials for one full calendar year. NKC has a zero tolerance policy for unsportsmanlike conduct during and in relation to their events, including on social media.

Championship Point Ratings

A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* Includes the dog awarded winners.

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All-Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion it must win at least 10 points under 3 different judges, which includes at least one 2-point win. This 2-point win must be at the breed or group level.
