

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Effective January 1/92 all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$58.50 per dog plus applicable taxes.

ATTENTION FOREIGN **EXHIBITORS**

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

- * A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a nonmember of the CKC. The fee will be \$63.90 plus applicable taxes.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the nonmember will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- * No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date are prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- * Entries close on Tuesday May 21st, 2019 at 8:00 pm and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- * Armband numbers and Judging Schedules will be sent out as soon as possible after the entries close.
- * Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to the current fees charged by the LOC's financial institution.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- * The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- * The Labrador Owners Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors
- * If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- * Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused when not required for further Reserve Winners Bitch judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
- * Please bring your own lawn chairs.
- * The Show precincts shall consist of all judging areas set aside for the show officials, judges, exhibitors and handlers and thirty (30) feet outside of the rings.
- * It shall be the duty and obligation of the Labrador Owners Club to see that judges, club officials, volunteers or any participant at an event held under these rules are not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

ORDER OF CLASSES

The first classes of the day will be Veteran Sweepstakes followed by Puppy Sweepstakes. The Start Time will be announced in the judging schedule. The Specialty Show will follow Sweepstakes unless numbers warrant that both run concurrently. Be sure to check the judging schedule. On Saturday after Best of Breed and Best Puppy in Breed the following classes will run in this order: Baby Puppy, Altered, Non Regular and Unofficial classes.



CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPION-SHIP POINTS

Chapter 15 Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	Points Allocated
1	0
2	1
3 to 5	2
5 to 9	3
10 to 12	4
13 or more	5
WT 1 1 .1 1	1 1 777

*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with the official classes, Specials Only or Exhibition a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at

least 3 different judges and, (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or have a

Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN). (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO **SPECIALS**

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a trans- 5% plus a prize. fer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRIT-ING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all Labrador Retrievers 6 months and under 18 months on the day of the Sweepstakes. Dogs and bitches must also be entered in one of the regular official classes at this specialty. The following classes, divided by sex, will be provided:

Junior Puppy - 6 months and under 9 months Senior Puppy - 9 months and under 12 months Open - 12 months and under 18 months All class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Money received as entry fees will be divided as follows:

1st in each class will divide 30% of the class prize

2nd in each class will divide 25% of the class prize money.

3rd in each class will divide 15% of the class prize money.

4th in each class will divide 5% of the class prize

Best in Sweepstakes will receive 10% plus a

Best Opposite Sex will receive 5% plus a prize. Rosettes will be offered for the above placings. 10% will be held for administration costs.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Labrador Retrievers dogs and bitches, including spayed or neutered dogs at least 7 years of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. They must be entered in one of Only at this specialty. The following classes, divided by sex, will be provided:

7 years to and including 9 years

10 years and over

All class winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes. Money received as entry fees will be divided as follows:

1st in each class will divide 30% of the class prize money.

2nd in each class will divide 25% of the class prize money.

3rd in each class will divide 15% of the class prize money.

4th in each class will divide 5% of the class prize money.

Best in Veteran Sweepstakes will receive 10% plus a prize.

Best Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweeps will receive

Rosettes will be offered for the above placings. 10% will be held for administration costs.

CLASSES OFFERED

OFFICIAL CLASSES:

The following C.K.C. classes (divided by sex) will be provided at both of these Specialty Shows:

JUNIOR PUPPY - for puppies 6 months and under 9 months of age on day of specialty.

SENIOR PUPPY - for puppies 9 months and under 12 months of age on day of specialty.

12–18 MONTHS - for dogs at least 12 months and under 18 months of age on day of specialty.

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. Entry may be made by any person who is the owner/co-owner or breeder/co-breeder of the dog. That person must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for a higher award.

OPEN CLASS - for all dogs and bitches, divided by colour (yellow, black or chocolate). Please Note colour on entry form for each dog entered.

VETERANS CLASS - for all dogs and bitches 7 years of age and over on the date of the specialty. These dogs and bitches to compete for the regular placements, and the 1st place dog and bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Spayed/neutered dogs may compete in Veterans. FIELD CLASS - This class is offered at Specialty shows for breeds that have performance events in the field. Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging with winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY - for all dogs and bitches recognized as champions in the records of the C.K.C. Listed dogs cannot be entered into the Specials class.

BABY PUPPY CLASSES OFFERED BOTH SATUDAY & SUNDAY

BABY PUPPY - for puppies 3 months and under 6 months of age on day of specialty.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES OFFERED ON SATURDAY ONLY

Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

Altered Male Class – All sexually altered males, regardless of age will be judged together. Altered Female Class – All sexually altered females, regardless of age will be judged together. Winner of each of these two divisions competes for Best Altered in Breed.

NON- REGULAR CLASSES OFFERED ON SATURDAY ONLY

EXHIBITION ONLY - Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in Exhibition Only. Dogs and bitches entered for Exhibition Only, may only compete in the non-regular and unofficial classes. Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Please Note: All dogs and bitches entered in the following non-regular and unofficial classes MUST be entered in one of the regular classes or Exhibition Only.

STUD DOG - Shall be for a dog and 2 of his get. The Get must also be entered in one of the official C.K.C. classes or for Specials Only. The 3 dogs comprising the entry need not be owned by the same owner.

BROOD BITCH - Shall be for a bitch and 2 of her progeny. The Progeny must also be entered in one of the official C.K.C. classes or for Specials Only. The 3 dogs comprising the entry need not be owned by the same owner.

BRACE - Shall be for 2 dogs, of either sex or same sex. Both dogs must be entered in one of the official C.K.C. classes or for Specials Only. A brace shall be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait and stride, handled on one lead by one handler.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES OFFERED ON SATURDAY ONLY

OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASS – For dogs and bitches who have earned at least a C.D. degree. 3 GENERATION CLASS - Three consecutive generations, either dog or bitch.

Entries are to be made at the show to the Show Secretary. Held under CKC Rules. All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of the competition in Conformation.

Junior Handers (with the exception of Pee Wee's) must obtain a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.

Classes Offered

4.1 Conformation Class Structure

4.1.1 Classes in Junior Conformation Handling competition shall be divided by age as follows: (a) Pee Wee Class

This class is for handlers 4 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 7th birthday. This class is optional and noncompetitive. No placements are to be awarded; only participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.

(b) Junior Novice Class

This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date their 11th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

(c) Junior Open Class

This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition.

(d) Intermediate Novice Class

This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

(e) Intermediate Open Class

This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

(f) Senior Novice Class

This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

(g) Senior Open Class

This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Prizes and Trophies Offered

The Labrador Owners Club is pleased to provide a prize and rosette for each participant as well as Best Overall (excluding Pee Wee).

Required Materials

The handler is required to bring the following equipment to the test:

- 1. Proof of vaccination certificate.
- 2. Test Fee of \$25.00
- 3. A leash not less than .75 meters (2') nor longer than 2 meters (6') in length (Acceptable collars include a well-fitting slip, buckle or martingale collar, made of fabric, leather or chain. All other types of collars are unacceptable.)
- 4. A grooming tool either a brush or comb.
- 5. A plastic bag for picking up after your dog.

Certification

Dogs are rated as "Pass" or "Not Ready". The Canadian Kennel Club issues certificates for dogs rated "Passed" and blank certificates may not be photocopied. Once the test is completed, the LOC will submit to the CKC the Registration/Evaluation form along with the certification fee for each dog that passed. The Canadian Kennel Club will issue certificates for all dogs that pass the test.
