

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Terrier Breeders' Association of Canada will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- 5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. on Saturday, May 18, 2013. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in the judging schedule. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your needs known to the club in advance. Please contact the Show Superintendent by the closing date of this show to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.
- SHOW PRECINCTS: The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers, and an area of 30 feet outside of the judging rings. There will be NO GROOMING TABLES, CRATES OR EXERCISE PENS ALLOWED UNDER THE SHOW TENT.

SHOW ETIQUETTE

Any exhibitor who allows their dog to defecate or urinate inside or outside the building other than in the designated exercise area without Immediately cleaning up or arranging for a clean up may not be permitted to exhibit at future shows or trials held by this club.

EXHIBITORS SMOKING IN THE BUILDING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO EXHIBIT AT FUTURE SHOWS.

PLEASE CO-OPERATE in keeping these grounds tidy.

RV PARKING AND RESERATIONS

Reservations and payments should be made payable to the K-W Kennel Club and mailed to MJN Show Services with your entries. A limited number of RV hookups with hydro and water are available at \$20.00 per night or \$55.00 for all three nights. There will be an unlimited number of non-serviced sites available at \$40.00 for three nights. Shower facilities are also available. RESERVATIONS and PAYMENT with your entry is highly recommended.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4-Section 4.7.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$58.50 per dog after January 1, 2012 plus applicable taxes.

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. Entries positively close 9:00 p.m. Wednesday, MAY 1, 2013 and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- 6. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- 7. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge.

SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following classes will be provided for both sexes:

BABY PUPPY - 3 months and under 6 months. This class does not compete for points.

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months and under 9 months

SENIOR PUPPY - 9 months and under 12 months

12-18 MONTH – 12 months and under 18 months (not a 'puppy' class) ABOVE CLASSES ARE BASED ON AGE ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW.

CANADIAN BRED For Terriers born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - For Terriers owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/ co-breeder of the Terrier. The owner/breeder must handle the Terrier in the class but need not handle the Terrier for further awards.

OPEN CLASS For all Terriers

VETERANS - Terriers 7 years of age or older on the date of the CLASS specialty. The first place dog and bitch compete for Best of Breed but not for championship points. Dogs/Bitches entered in the class may be spayed/neutered.

SPECIALS - Terriers which have a recorded CKC or ERN number ONLY and have attained the required points for championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC championship. Terriers entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible. Entry of a listed dog is not permitted.

SEXUALLY ALTERED - For dogs/bitches 6 months of age and over who have been sexually altered by

veterinary procedure. The breed standard for each breed shall be followed: all disqualification's shall apply. Judges shall judge this class as if judging regular conformation classes. Withholding of awards for lack of merit is encouraged.

CLASSES & AWARDS - Winners Altered Male/Female Class. In each breed there may be 1 such award in each sex. Reserve Winners Altered Male/ Female. The second place male/female shall be given this award.

BEST ALTERED IN BREED - In each breed, there may be 1 Best Altered award. This award shall be confined to Winners Altered Male/Female.

BEST ALTERED IN GROUP - The highest award is Altered Group 1st. Sexually Altered class will be judged after the judging of Best of Breed in the Regular Classes. Best Sexually Altered in Group will be judged after Best Puppy in Group.

CATALOGUES

Catalogues are available on a PRE-ORDER basis. Those who wish to preorder at a price of \$6.00 may do so by indicating this on their entry form. Your catalogue will be waiting for you at the show. There will be a limited number of catalogues available for sale at the show for a price of \$8.00.
