All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee in full, and all TCN fees (\$10.50 including GST) where applicable. A TCN fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number is not shown on the entry form or ERN notice. <u>Scratches</u> will be refunded for a bitch in season totally. All other scratches will be refunded at the hunt test committee's discretion, other than a fee of \$15.00.

Please ensure our continued welcome at this facility by obeying the following rules:

- 1) Dogs must be leashed at all times while on campground property;
- 2) Dogs are NOT allowed on the golf course;
- 3) You must pick up any "fecal deposits" left by your dog.

Wabamun is a busy summer resort. You will need to reserve well in advance of your visit.

RULE 20.7 of the Hunt Test Rules and Regulations states: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Copies of the Hunt Test Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400, 200 Ronson Drive, Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9.
- 2. Entries must be typewritten or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. The Alberta Clipper Hunting Retriever Association does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of information on any entry form. Make cheques payable to the Alberta Clipper Hunting Retriever Association.
- 3. A separate Entry Form for each dog in each test is required (official CKC Entry Form).
- 4. Entry fees will not be refunded after 7:00 P.M., Tuesday, June 15th, 2021. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or if it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry will be made.
- 5. In the event of a mail strike, please courier or hand deliver entries to the Test Secretary prior to the closing date.
- 6. No POST-DATED cheques will be accepted.
- 7. Post entries will not be accepted.
- 8. Running order will be determined by random selection. Running order will be available after 6:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 24th, 2021.
- 9. Bitches in season shall not be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the test grounds.
- 10. Ducks and pheasants may be used in all stakes. Pigeons may be used for the upland hunting test in the Master Hunt Tests. Wingers may be used in any stake.
- 11. Tests will be run at separate locations.
- 12. All throwers, Judges and competitors should wear dark or camouflaged clothing.
- 13. Any dog not appearing within 15 minutes of being called to the line by the Marshall may be disqualified.
- 14. You are responsible for your own lunch.
- 15.Entry and TCN fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the test to qualify for a refund. All other refunds must be requested in writing within 14 days of the event, explaining the reason for the scratch. Scratches will be refunded at the discretion of the Hunt Test Committee, all but a fee of \$15.00.
- 16. Effective Jan. 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, send a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/Mastercard number. Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. Cost \$63.90. ERN numbers must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.
- 17. The Alberta Clipper Hunting Retriever Association and its members will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident, injury or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 18. Electric Collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by any dog on the test grounds at any time during the event.
- 19. There shall be no training of dogs on the test grounds, except for single training bumpers, which are thrown by hand by the trainer, within 24 hours of the commencement of the event or anytime during the event.
- 20. All qualifying dogs will receive a rosette.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

By entering this Test (as handler, spectator or in any other capacity) each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to these Tests and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the Alberta Clipper Hunting Retriever Association and its members, any volunteer and the owner(s) and/or leasee(s) of any property upon which the Test may be held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Any person participating in any capacity at a Hunt Test or Working Certificate Test held under the CKC rules and regulations shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the tests and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Alberta Clipper Hunting Retriever Association to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the Alberta Clipper Hunting Retriever Association of an alleged indignity of any kind the Test Chairman will report the infringement to the CKC and the Test Committee shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall have the power to take action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

Travel West from Edmonton on Highway 16, (Yellowhead Hwy).

Exit North off Hwy 16, at the Wabamun town exit (also signed for Whitewoods Golf).

Head North 3kms on Range Road 41 to Twp. Rd. 534.

Head West on Twp. Rd. 534 for 3.3 kms.

Turn left onto the gravel road, our property is a small drive up the road, has a green gate at the entrance, on the right hand side.

if you reach Whitewoods you have gone about half a kilometer too far



Please note that vehicle access is restricted to designated main roads only.

Drive and park as directed.

Please respect the test grounds. Clean up after yourselves and your dogs.

Notice to All Canadian Residents Only

New CKC Rule

Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC
- B) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

To follow current Alberta Health Regulations due to Covid-19 there will be restrictions in place during the event. Please respect the guidelines to ensure we keep everyone safe.

- If you have any symptoms DO NOT ATTEND the event.
 - 1. Do you have any of the following symptoms:
 - a. A fever
 - b. A cough that is new or different from usual if you have a chronic cough
 - c. A sore throat that is not related to a pre-existing condition
 - d. A runny nose that is not related to a pre-existing condition
 - e. Nasal congestion that is not related to a pre-existing condition
 - f. Shortness of breath that is not related to a pre-existing condition
 - 2. Have you travelled internationally within the last 14 days?
 - 3. Have you come into contact with individuals who have a confirmed or presumptive diagnosis of COVID-19.

Any attendees exhibiting symptoms will not be allowed on the grounds.

- All handlers will be notified to go directly to the site of their stake and avoid all congregating in central areas.
- Social distancing practices will be in place. Be mindful when speaking with others.
- Bring your own food and drinks.
- Remove all your garbage from the grounds. There will NOT be garbage bins available.
- Bring your own duck call and whistle. We will NOT supply them.
- You may be required to place the bird in the bucket and/or on the drying rack. Judges will NOT be required to take the bird from the handler but it will be entirely up to the judges discretion as to how this is handled at each stake
- Bring your own mask and gloves (if you choose to wear them). If handlers choose to wear rubber gloves to the line, they must dispose of the gloves after leaving the line and put on new gloves with each ensuing series. If handlers choose to wear a mask to the line, they cannot touch the mask to move it up or down to use their whistle. This is equivalent to touching their face/mouth and MUST sanitize their hands immediately.
- There will NOT be washroom's available. Come prepared.
- If possible, only the handler of the dog should attend the event. This helps to keep attendance numbers low and reduce the risk.
- A hand hygiene station will be set up at each stake between the last holding blind and the line. The station will include a hand pump bottle of hand sanitizer. Hand hygiene is required to be performed by everyone when:
 - on their way to the line
 - o after leaving the line
 - o routinely throughout the day

Please bring your own sanitizer for your personal use outside of the stake area.

Commonly touched areas will be cleaned and disinfected a minimum of twice daily.
