NEW EARTHDOG TITLE OPPORTUNITIES!!!!

NEW! Novice ED (title) -- Now you can get a title for working the IQ tunnel perfectly -- 2 legs required, not a prerequisite for entering JE and you can still enter IQ to train & practice, rosettes for passes

NEW! Grand JE (title) -- Now you can continue to enter JE after you pass the required 2 legs for your JE title. If you don't wish to go on to SE, you can continue to enter JE and if you pass 5 more legs you earn the Grand JE title.

NEW! Grand SE (title) -- similar to GJE, and if you are not ready for ME, you can continue to enter SE after you pass the required 3 legs to earn your SE title. You can enter and pass 5 more legs to earn a Grand SE title

REMINDER! In the past few years, you have been able to earn a Grand ME by continuing to enter ME. After passing the required 4 legs to earn an ME title, you can now continue to enter and pass 5 more legs to earn the GME title. THEN! You are able to enter your dog in both SE & ME in the same test. If your dog passes both the SE and ME legs, in the same test in 5 more tests, your dog will earn the title of GME Excellent (GMEX)

SOOO!!! Here are many more opportunities to have FUN with your Dachshund or Terrier showing off what they were bred to do -- their behaviour and skills as a working Earthdog!

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE: Effective Jan. 1, 2011 – (These fees apply to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. To protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards/titles to be cancelled.

ENTRIES: Must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC entry form, and must be accompanied by the signed WAIVER and the Entry Fee.

ENTRY CONFIRM: Advance entries will be confirmed for those providing their email address on the entry form once payment has been received.

ELIGIBILITY

- Tests are open to all purebred Dachshunds and those Terriers in Group IV and on the Miscellaneous list seeking eligibility for Group IV that are small enough to fit into a 9-inch drain (6.6.1)
- Spayed, neutered and debarked dogs are eligible to participate.
- Dogs must be 6 months or older.

DCGO and the Landowner will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs, the exhibitors, the spectators and the quarry, but will not be responsible in the event of any accident to dogs, exhibitors, spectators or quarry.

From West (Toronto)—Take 401 East to Exit # 436 Hwy 115/35 North. Stay on Hwy 115. Use Exit #29 (Rd #32/Porter Rd.) Turn left (North) and proceed to Solanum Way. Turn right (East) and then right on Col. Williams Lane to end of road.

From North – Take Hwy 35 south of Lindsay and turn left (East) on Hwy 7A towards Bethany. At the derelict Gas Station go right (South) on Rd #32/Porter Rd. to Solanum Way. Turn left (East) and then right on Col. Williams Lane to end of road.

From East (Kingston) Take 401 West to Exit # 436 Hwy 115/35 North. Stay on Hwy 115. Use Exit #29 (Rd #32/Porter Rd.) Turn left (North) and proceed to Solanum Way. Turn right (East) and then right on Col. Williams Lane to end of road.

GOING GREEN: No bottled water will be available.
Excellent well water will be available
for refilling dog bowls and your own
containers or you can bring your own.

TEST SITE: Bring water (if desired), shade and shelter for you and your dogs. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under leash control at all times (no flexis) Fencing will be placed around the IQ test location only.

A COOLING POOL WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE SITE

BEWARE POISON IVY ON THE SITE.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

TEST INFORMATION:

Introduction to Quarry (IQ – Not an official CKC Test) Open to all eligible dogs that have not completed requirements for an NE or higher title

Novice Earthdog (NE) A dog that has completed the requirements for an NE is not required to move up to the next level

Junior Earthdog (JE) A dog that has completed the requirements for a JE is not required to move up to the next level

Senior Earthdog (SE) A dog that has completed the requirements for an SE is not required to move up to the next level

Master Earthdog (ME)

Registration: Test Secretary Desk opens at 8 am and gate entries and move-ups will be taken at that time as well as up to one hour before the particular test starts.

Judging Order: The order of testing shall be the order that entries are received except when multiple entries of the same handler require separation when possible. Dogs that are entered in IQ and JE will be scheduled to run in IQ before JE if possible. A running order will be posted.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE SITE: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test, must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. DCGO will refund the entry fee, service charge and any listing fee.

AWARDS: Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry test will receive flat ribbons. Qualifiers in Novice, Junior, Senior and Master Earthdog tests will receive rosettes.

TEST PRECINCT: The precinct of this test will be the marked section of 'Laurelwood', Pontypool, ON. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100ft) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

VALIDATION OF ENTRIES: All participants are required to fill in and sign the Earthdog Participation Agreement form. Entries submitted without this agreement filled in and signed will be refused participation in the tests

MOVE UPS: Move ups are permitted one (1) hour before the Class to be moved up to, provided the dog has not already run in a lower-level class in the same test

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (cont'd)

QUARRY: The quarry used in these tests will be two rats or two gerbils.

VETERINARIAN: Cavan Hills Veterinary Service, 303 Hwy. # 7A, Cavan ON L0A 1C0 705 944-5776
Approximately 10 minutes from test site.

PARKING: Free parking will be available on Laurelwood grounds. Please follow signs and parking instructions.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to *consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted.* If you pay by personal American cheque, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Do not write "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par". This is not acceptable and will not clear the bank. To simplify the process, we urge you to buy bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Or to simplify the process use THE ENTRY LINE. (see box advertisement)

BORDER CROSSING: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Canada Food Agency regulations can be viewed at <http://www.inspection.gc.ca/10nglish/animal/heasan/import/dogse.shtml>

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (Foreign Born/Owned Dogs): For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born/owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering a first CKC event to avoid cancellation of legs awarded. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of the dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (Canadian funds) along with the completed application form. The form can be downloaded from www.ckc.ca/forms or from the CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC *Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations* are available from the Canadian Kennel Club at 1-800-250-8040 and online at www.ckc.ca

CKC REGULATION 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
