

# NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES (IF OFFERED BY THE CLUB) ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A NON-REGULAR CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY.

#### NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

**BRACE CLASS** - This class is open to any two dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person NEED NOT own both dogs.

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u>- This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class".

## DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS <u>MUST BE</u> ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS

#### **Transition Obedience Classes**

**PRE-NOVICE** - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

**NOVICE "C"** - This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

#### JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

Judge: Louise Davie

This event is open to all SHETLAND SHEEPDOG 6 months of age and under 18 months on the day of this event. All dogs MUST be entered in one of the regular classes on the day of the Specialty.

CLASSES: For judging purposes, the classes will be divided by sex as follows:

6 months & under 9 months Males/Females (on April 13, 2013) 9 months & under 12 months Males/Females (on April 13, 2013) 12 months & under 18 months Males/Females (on April 13, 2013)

All first place winners will compete together for the award of Best in Sweepstakes. On completion of Best in Sweepstakes, the dog placing SECOND in the same class as the winner will return to the ring to compete for the award of Runner-Up in Sweepstakes.

PRIZES: A rosette and 15% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette and 10% of total fees collected will be awarded to Runner-Up in Sweepstakes. A rosette and 20% of class fees collected will be awarded to first in each class, a rosette and 15% of class fees collected will be awarded to second in each class, a rosette and 10% of class fees collected will be awarded to third in each class, a rosette and 5% of class fees collected will be awarded to fourth in each class.

#### **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

Judge: Louise Davie

This event is open to all SHETLAND SHEEPDOG 7 YEARS OF AGE AND OVER on the day of this event. All dogs MUST be entered in one of the regular classes, Specials Only or for Exhibition Only.

SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS EVENT, BUT MUST BE ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS (Competitive) OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

CLASSES: For judging purposes, the classes will be divided by sex as follows:

7 – 10 years Males/Females (on April 13, 2013) 10+ years Males/Females (on April 3, 2013)

All first place winners will compete together for the award of Best in Veteran Sweepstakes. On completion of Best in Sweepstakes, the dog placing SECOND in the same class as the winner will return to the ring to compete for the award of Runner-Up in Sweepstakes.

Rosettes and a cash award will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> in all classes. In addition, a Rosette will be offered to Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up in Sweepstakes. The remainder of veterans in Sweepstakes will receive a participant Rosette. All monies received for the entry of the Sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

Best Veteran in Sweepstakes: 30% of total entry fees received Runner-Up in Sweepstakes: 25% of total entry fees received 1st in each class: 5% of total entry fees received

Balance of 25% will be retained by the club to defray costs from both events.

#### REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" AT SAME TRIAL

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN **ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN THE NOVICE "B" CLASS NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs that have not earned the title of "CD" in Canada. Dogs in this class may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog does not have to be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER OF A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>OPEN "B"</u> - This class is open to all dogs that have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS**. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'A'</u>- This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'B'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

#### **CONFORMATION CLASSES**

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS</u> – This class shall be for any dog 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. (Note: Winners of the Baby Puppy Male & Baby Puppy Female, DO NOT compete for points) <u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog **9 months of age** and under **12 months of age** on the day of the show

<u>12 to 18 MONTH CLASS</u> - For dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of this Specialty

<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

<u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/co-owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

<u>OPEN CLASS</u> - This class shall be for all dogs (divided by colour Sable or AOAC)

<u>SPECIALS ONLY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. <u>Note</u>: A <u>Listed dog <u>MAY</u> be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class <u>MUST</u> be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees *WILL NOT* be refunded</u>

<u>EXHIBITION ONLY</u> - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class <u>MAY NOT COMPETE</u> in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

#### ADDITIONAL REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following additional regular classes will be offered at this Specialty: <a href="VETERANS CLASS">VETERANS CLASS</a> - For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS but rather the winner of the Veteran Male & Veteran Female Class go directly onto the Best of Breed competition

NOTE: SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS MAY COMPETE IN THIS CLASS

#### SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

Altered Male or Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed

#### **RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS**

- 1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
- 2. A DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
- 3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
- 4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
- 5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM ENTRY IS MADE
- 6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- 7. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS
- 8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
- 9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY.

#### **CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING\* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more POINTS AWARDED 0 1 2 3 4 5 includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

#### EXTRACTS FROM CKC DOG SHOW RULES

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

#### 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

#### Section 3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$9.40 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

#### Section 2.3:

#### **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES**

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being canceled, and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

#### Section 8.2:

#### **DISHONORED CHEQUES**

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

#### **CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION**

#### Section 1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules

#### CHAPTER 9 - EXHIBITORS and THEIR DOGS

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.
