COVID RULES, INFORMATION and WAIVER

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ENTERING THIS SHOW!

By submitting entries or attending this show you are declaring that you agree to the following strictly enforced COVID RULES and the RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INFORMED CONSENT. Please do not enter this show if you have personal or political reasons for not abiding by the Alberta Government Covid-19 protocols.

1. Execution of the show is contingent on the Camrose area of Alberta remaining open for ADULT SPORTS in the Alberta COVID reopening plan and allowed to compete in the numbers expressed in the catalogue. Unfettered provincial, interprovincial and international travel is not a prerequisite for operating the show, and refunds will not be considered if you cannot travel to the show due to a restriction on travel.
2. The Camrose Regional Exhibition is following the Alberta Health **RESTRICTED EXEMPTION PROGRAM** that all people aged 12 and over show proof of:
 - **at least one COVID vaccination obtained before October 7, 2021 or**
 - **a medical exemption letter or**
 - **a privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test within 72 hours of service** (showing up at the building).We will be checking this requirement at the two screening areas and once accepted, will provide you a wristband that is good for the weekend. Youth under 12 can attend the show and will need to get a wristband to get in the building.
3. **WRISTBANDS are REQUIRED** at all times while in the building.
4. **MASKS are REQUIRED** in the building. Refer to the Alberta Government Covid website for the most recent masking requirements. If you do not bring or lose your mask, one will be provided for you at ringside.
5. **PHYSICAL DISTANCING is RECOMMENDED** inside the building. We will have to limit the number of people in the building at any one time to maintain a safe spacing between people. Rings will be larger to provide a buffer between exhibitors and people waiting outside the ring. If there is a large time gap between your showings, please go back to your vehicle. A few chairs will be provided at ringside. Only sit next to someone in your cohort.
6. Exhibitors should arrive on the grounds ONE HOUR before their scheduled show time for screening. Once screened, stay in your car until 15 minutes before your breed time for showing. The screening doors will be open one hour before show time. The JUDGING SCHEDULE will show more detailed judging times for each breed.
7. PARKING will be different. **PERFORMANCE** exhibitors should park in the **FRONT** lot and only use the doors at the main entrance for entrance/exit. **CONFORMATION** exhibitors should park in the **BACK** parking lot and only use the marked door on the south wall for entrance. The north and south doors will have Screening Booths. Washrooms and hand sanitizing stations will be provided in the parking lot while you are waiting.
8. Each exhibitor and helper will receive a maximum of ONE wristband only. NO replacement wrist bands will be issued if you lose yours. A replacement will be provided only if you bring in your old band.

9. Violation of any rule may result in your entries for the weekend being cancelled with NO refund of entries.
10. The concession will not be operating. Food trucks may be available in the parking lot.
11. Please stay outside of the building until just before your breed goes in the ring. The judging schedule will have specific times for each breed. Your breed should come in the show 15 MINUTES before its judging time. Once you have finished showing your breed, please leave the building promptly if you have no other dogs to show in the immediate future. You may then return 15 minutes before your next breed or Group judging, etc.
12. There will be NO BENCHING in the show building. Please do your grooming either outside or before coming to the venue. If you are showing more than one dog you may bring a crate/s in to hold your additional dogs, but must take them out when your judging is done for the day. NO X-pens. NO floor mats. NO chairs. If you are showing multiple dogs, a table may be brought in if you need to do a last minute brushing before you show. NO blowers. There will be NO power available in the building. The wash bay will only be available for emergency bathing only, but you will have to go outside to dry your dog. Absolutely no dryers inside the building. You may pop up a tent outside beside your car if you need one for grooming etc.
13. Please groom outside. Some power outlets will be available but they will be near the building.
14. The building will be CLEANED each night and anything left behind will be removed. Tables and other touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly throughout the day. There will be limited chairs at ringside.
15. **REFUND POLICY:** If we are required to CANCEL the show due to any Alberta Government, City of Camrose or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies or directives, a partial refund (based upon our unrecoverable costs) of entries will be considered. In the event of any refunds; credit card and Dogshow.ca charges will not be refunded.
16. If required to isolate due to a COVID-19 core symptom, try to find an alternate handler for your dog. In the event you are unable to find an alternate handler the BRCA will consider a 50% refund of applicable entry fees when accompanied by proof of an Alberta Health Services COVID-19 test (positive or negative), Doctors note showing COVID-19 symptoms and requirement to isolate, or an Alberta Health Services isolation order. Please note that submission for this type of refund will be evaluated after the Show's completion. All requests for refund must be submitted by email to refunds@battlerivercanine.ca and must include a copy of your receipt of entry and the dog number that was not shown.
17. There will be a PHOTOGRAPHER at this show. Judges are NOT required to take photos with you.

Please complete one entry per dog, per class (one entry for each of OPEN HB, OPEN 18B and UTILITY B) Dogs entered in an unofficial class must also be entered in an official class or "Exhibition only"

NOTE! No entry will be accepted without entry fees. **OVERPAYMENT** of entry fees will not be refunded. To comply with CKC, entries will not be accepted, altered, cancelled, or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries (except as provided for in 8.9.1 of the Dog Show Rules). Telephone entries cannot be accepted except in the event of a postal strike. In that event please contact the Show Secretary (Kathy McLaughlin 780-814-3665)

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You

ERN NOTICE: All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at: (416) 675 -5511 or Fax (416) 675 -6506

Temporary Competition Numbers

All dogs entered in CKC events that are not CKC registered must have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) before entering into the event(s). This includes Baby Puppies in Conformation shows. Please note that Listed Breeds are not eligible for a TCN (effective July 6, 2021, this includes Baby Puppies). Listed Breeds must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) before entering into an event. The Conformation Show Rules will be updated in this regard.

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

4.7.1 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty, and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

Show Officials 5.1.6

The officials of a show-giving club will be held responsible for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators during the show. Any person acting in an objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC that are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. have an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or Interac for payment.

CONFORMATION:

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

12 – 18 MONTH CLASS 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for “Specials Only” and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT Allowed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

VETERAN CLASS - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

PRE-NOVICE – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

NOVICE “A” - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.

NOVICE “B” - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada

NOVICE “C” – as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE - as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

OPEN “HA”- The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized

breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.

OPEN “18A” -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.

OPEN “HB” - The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes .

OPEN 18B – The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes

UTILITY “A” – For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

UTILITY “B” – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.

VETERANS (Unofficial class)– For any dog that has earned the title of C.D. or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. Exercises shall be performed and judged as in the novice classes. Dog entered in veterans must also be entered in any regular class or exhibition only. Owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.

RALLY OBEDIENCE

RALLY NOVICE A: Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE: The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes.(CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B: This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A: This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign

RALLY MASTER: This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE . A dog completing the R.M. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

No handler who has exhibited a dog through its C.K.C. Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the 'A' class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.

TEMPORARY CKC RULE CHANGES:

Motion: “THAT, the following be in place to allow clubs flexibility with their judging panels due to government COVID-19 regulations when every reasonable effort has been made to fulfill the judging panel with licensed or permit judges.

This is a temporary alteration to normal judge approval practices.

Exceptions will be permitted under the following circumstances where local guidelines limits the choice of judges to a region and no judges are available.

This includes circumstances where the guidelines change prior to the beginning of the show where judges can no longer officiate.

The club may obtain Shows & Trials Approval to allow permit judges to judge beyond their approved groups.

The club may also seek Shows and Trials approval to select as a Judge a CKC member who must meet following criteria:

- 1) Has attended Judges 101 course
- 2) Has a minimum of 10 years experience as an exhibitor or handler
- 3) Has acted as a Ring steward within the past 3 years
- 4) The breeds and/or groups to be judged should be aligned to their breeding or handling experience.

In the unlikely event that there is no individual who meets the above criteria, the club will be required to provide a short biography of the selected person to Shows and Trials for consideration.

These assignments will not count towards any future credit for assignments.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

A description of all *Conformation, Obedience and Rally Classes* and *Rule and Regulations* can be found at www.ckc.ca

1. This show is held INDOORS at the Camrose Regional Exhibition Grounds (4250 Exhibition Drive, Camrose, Alberta)
2. This is an UNLIMITED entry Conformation dog show. Performance shows entry limited to the timing restrictions of each judge.
3. DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES are not permitted at this show. All entries must be in the Show Secretary's hands by the closing date on the front page of this Premium List.
4. MIXED BREEDS are allowed in the performance events with CCN.
5. RALLY-OBEDIENCE will be held in a 50' x 50' Ring. The Precincts of the Rally trials are the ring and immediate area surrounding the ring. Only dogs entered in the trials are permitted within the Precincts of the Rally trials.
6. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to INDIGNITIES. The Conformation Show or Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7 CKC Conformation Show and 20.7 CKC Obedience and Rally-Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations.)
7. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by an act of the event club or because it has been entered incorrectly, except as provided in 8 below. Nor will entry fees be refunded if due to riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the BRCA, that make it impossible to open or complete the show. **See COVID Rules for Special Circumstances.**
8. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED INTO THE OBEDIENCE OR RALLY SHOW COMES INTO SEASON within 10 days of the show. A veterinary letter certifying that the bitch came into season within 10 days prior to the show must be delivered to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of that trial's judging.
9. NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:
 - a. An annual non-member fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
 - b. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member fee.
 - c. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members of the CKC.
10. The show building will be OPEN at 7 a.m. on Thursday before the show. Booths may set up after 3 p.m. Wednesday.
11. The Camrose Regional Exhibition will LOCK the doors at 10 p.m. each night of the show and OPEN the doors at 6:30 a.m. each morning. CRE staff will patrol the building overnight but will not be responsible for any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or their property.
12. All EMPTY rings are to be kept free of dogs one hour before the show and during the show.
13. Entries will be ACKNOWLEDGED after the closing date. Judging schedule and receipts available online or by mail.
14. Dogs must be EXERCISED in designated areas only. If you exercise outside you must clean up after your dog.
15. All dogs in the show building must either be REGISTERED in the show or "IN TRANSIT".
16. All entries must be CLEARLY filled out. The BRCA or the Show Secretary will not correct incorrect entries.
17. SIGNS advertising puppies or other services will not be permitted in the benching area or around the rings
18. BRCA has a ZERO tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with BRCA Shows, including spectators.

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.
