ERN Numbers - Policy has been updated and amended

Foreign born dogs entering Canada for the purpose of competing in CKC events, whose primary owners' address on the foreign registration certificate is outside Canada, must obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN)

- (a) The dog must be registered with a CKC-recognized Kennel Club and must be a CKC-recognized breed or be a breed that is registerable by a Breed Association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada.
- (b) A copy of the registration certificate showing the name and address of the owner must accompany the application along with the required fee.
- (c) The Event Registration Number (ERN) must be obtained from the CKC within ninety (90) days of the first event entered.
- (d) Failure to obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN) within ninety (90) days of the first event entered will result in any points, scores or awards cancelled.
- (e) Dogs with an Event Registration Number (ERN) earning CKC titles in CKC events will receive the appropriate title certificate.
- (f) An Event Registration Number (ERN) is not a CKC Registration; it simply allows the dog to be entered in a CKC event without registering the dog.
- (g) A dog registered with a CKC-recognized Kennel Club on a Limited Registration, or any type of non-breeding registration, or registerable with a Breed Association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada will be eligible for an Event Registration Number.

(2) Canadian born dogs of breeds that are registerable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN).

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS
To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN.
- Include full payment in the amount of \$57.60 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non- Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- Provide us with your full return address.
- Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.
- An ERN must be obtained within 30 day of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension.

NOW ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN PERFORMANCE EVENTS

“MIXED BREED” (MIXED BREED of no breed designation)

Canine Companion Number (CCN) Effective: July 1, 2015

- a) Mixed Breed dog: is a dog of unknown ancestry that belongs to no recognized breed and is not the result of selective breeding.
 - b) Unrecognized breed: is a dog of known ancestry not on the CKC list of recognized or miscellaneous breeds, and that is registered with a Registry recognized by the CKC.
 - c) Recognized breed is a breed that CKC is authorized to register in accordance with the Animal Pedigree Act (APA) or a dog of a breed included in the CKC Miscellaneous Breed list
- 2 Purpose
- a) A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows mixed and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events of Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials.
- 3 Eligibility a) In order for a dog to receive a Canine Companion Number (CCN) the following criteria must be met:
- 1) The dog must be either a mixed breed or unrecognized breed as defined herein.
 - 2) Mixed breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
 - 3) The dog must be identified with a Canadian Kennel Club approved microchip.
- 4 Applying for a Canine Companion Number (CCN)
- a) Complete the appropriate Canadian Kennel Club Canine Companion Number application form.
 - b) With the completed form, accompanying documentation must be included as follows
 - 1) Mixed breed dogs - proof of spay or neuter.
 - 2) Unrecognized dogs not eligible for registration by CKC and not on the Miscellaneous List – a copy of a registration certificate from a CKC recognized Registry.
 - 3) The appropriate fee as noted in the CKC fee schedule.
- 5 Upon receipt of a Canine Companion Number (CCN), the dog may be entered in any of the events noted in 2 a. 6 A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.

The following Official CKC Classes will be provided: Pre – Novice, Novice “A”, & “B”, “C”, Intermediate Novice, Open “HA”, Open “18A”, Open “HB”, Open “18B”, and Utility A & B.

6.9 MOVING UP – OBEDIENCE

CKC Rules And Regulations (Effective January 01, 2021)

6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, and ERN, or a MCN and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for the trial has not received confirmation of the title may be moved to the next level of competition providing the request is submitted to the trial secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler a minimum of one half hour before the opening of the first trial on that day, schedule permitting.

6.9.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

6.9.5 If it is established by the CKC that a dog moved up to the next level has not completed the requirements for the lower level before moving up, then all qualifying ribbons and/or awards earned by the dog incorrectly entered shall be forfeited and cancelled by the CKC and the owner may be subject to disciplinary action.

6.9.6 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered in the CKC or have a Performance Event Number (PEN), an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

6.9.7 **Exhibitors incorrectly entered** in the "A" class are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding "B" class up to one hour before the start of the trial.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN)

Effective Jan 01, 2002,

A Performance Event Number (PEN), allows an unregisterable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in those competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Those events are as follows: Obedience, Tracking, Herding, Draft Dogs, Agility, Lure Coursing, Earthdog Tests, Hunt Tests, Working Certificate Tests, and Pointing Field Dog Tests. A Dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a listed dog. Dogs may only enter events after a PEN has been issued to that dog. This restriction shall also apply to dogs with ILP numbers. Unregisterable Dog means, a dog of a recognized CKC breed that cannot be registered because of unknown parentage or the unavailability of its registration papers.

CKC Conformation Rules & Regulations 12.2.2 - PUPPIES 4-6 Months

- a) Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.
- b) Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes including parades. Puppies must be either registered or have a "TCN" number.

Note: TCN Fees do not apply to Baby Puppies or dogs entered for Exhibition Only

- ◆ Limited number of catalogues will be available at the show for \$ 25.00. (Pre-ordering is highly recommended.)
- ◆ The show precincts **30 feet from any ring or building housing show executives.**
- ◆ **"No Show - All Breed or Specialty, Event, Performance Event, or Best in Show Judging, shall be delayed for any Exhibitor who has a conflict in another ring or event. All exhibitors are expected to have alternative arrangements made for any possible conflict."**
- ◆ The Show Superintendent has the authority to ask exhibitors to move or take down any crates and private exercise pens, etc. Failure to do so when requested could result in disciplinary action.
- ◆ Exhibitors are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy. If space is at a premium, exhibitors must remove exercise pens if requested by the Show Superintendent or designate.
- ◆ Dogs not entered in these shows will NOT be allowed within the precincts of the show & trial.
- ◆ The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, governed by CKC rules.
- ◆ If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the controls of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show or trial, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- ◆ It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to ensure that a judge or any show committee members are not subjected to any indignities. The Conformation Show Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee will have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- ◆ Diana Edwards Show Services & the Stormont, Dundas, & Glengarry Dog Association will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortunes, however caused.
- ◆ Dogs need only to arrive 15 minutes before scheduled judging time and will be excused from each show when not required for further judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- ◆ Diana Edwards Show Services will only collect and utilize data and information that you provide us, and only for the purposes of the service we provide exhibitors entering a CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) event, and the subsequent documents generated for this event, and required by the CKC. The type and accuracy of the information is solely contingent upon what you voluntarily provide to us. We will not use or disclose personal information for the purposes other than those for which it was collected, except with consent or as required by law. Personal information will not be retained longer than needed for the specified purposes.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least an e2 point win either at the breed or group level

GRAND CHAMPION POINTS

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (17-09-20) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (07-04-21) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) 5354 (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE:

1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022

CLASSES

Novice replaces Novice A and Novice B. Excellent replaces Excellent A. Master Excellent replaces Excellent B.

Agility Novice (Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, Points and Distance): Open to any dog that has not earned a qualifying score in the CKC Agility Intermediate Class. Novice Standard and Novice Jumpers with Weaves will have one set of 6 weave poles, used once.

Agility Intermediate (Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, Points and Distance): Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent (Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, Points and Distance): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Master Excellent (Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, Points and Distance): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.

Steeplechase: One level, jumpers style course with weave poles and A-Frame. Scoring – time plus faults.

Jumps & Tunnels: One level, jumpers style course Scoring—Time plus faults.

Divisions – Regular, Selected, Veterans

Selected Classes

Any dog eligible to participate in a CKC agility trial may enter the Selected Class. In the Selected Classes, dogs jump one height lower than their regular jump height and the Standard Course Time is increased by 10%. Once a dog is entered in Selected Classes, the dog may not go back to compete in the Regular classes. Dogs move laterally and take any legs they have earned in the Regular classes with them.

Veteran Classes

Dogs 7 years or older may be entered into the Veterans division at one OR two heights lower than their Regular jump height. Dogs entered in Veterans may NOT move back into Regular or Selected. The dog will retain titles and/or qualifying scores accumulated towards titles and will have the same 10% additional Standard Course Time as Selected dogs.

JUMP HEIGHTS (one height lower than Regular for Selected, one or two heights lower than Regular for Veterans)

4 inches (Selected and Veterans only)	16 inches for dogs over 14” up to and including 18”
8 inches for dogs 10” and under	20 inches for dogs over 18” up to and including 22”
12 inches for dogs over 10” up to and including 14”	24 inches for dogs over 22”

Height of tire will be 4” lower than the jump height for other jumps, except for the 4” jump height. For example, if a dog jumps 20”, the tire jump will be 16”.

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. The precinct of the trials shall be the ring enclosure and 10 feet surrounding the ring.
2. Only dogs entered for competition will be permitted in the precinct of the trials.

Canine Companion Number (CCN)

1 Definitions

- a) **Mixed breed dog:** is a dog of unknown ancestry that belongs to no recognized breed and is not the result of selective breeding.
- b) **Unrecognized breed:** is a dog of known ancestry not on the CKC list of recognized or miscellaneous breeds and that is registered with a Registry recognized by the CKC.
- c) **Recognized breed:** is a breed that CKC is authorized to register in accordance with the Animal Pedigree Act (APA) or a dog of a breed included in the CKC Miscellaneous Breed list

2 Purpose

- a) A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows mixed and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events of Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials.

3 Eligibility

- a) In order for a dog to receive a Canine Companion Number (CCN) the following criteria must be met:
 - 1) The dog must be either a mixed breed or unrecognized breed as defined herein.
 - 2) Mixed breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
 - 3) The dog must be identified with a Canadian Kennel Club approved microchip.

4 Applying for a Canine Companion Number (CCN)

Complete the appropriate Canadian Kennel Club Canine Companion Number application form.

With the completed form, accompanying documentation must be included as follows:

- 1) Mixed breed dogs - proof of spay or neuter.

- 3) The appropriate fee as noted in the CKC fee schedule.

5 Upon receipt of a Canine Companion Number (CCN), the dog may be entered in any of the events noted in 2 a.

6 A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.

7 The Canadian Kennel Club may cancel for cause, any Canine Companion Number.

PARKING GUIDELINES FOR THE WEEKEND AT THE SHOW

Due to the increased number of conformation and performance events at the show, we have had to set up parking guidelines for the weekend.

- There will be parking attendants at both the conformation and performance area this year, so PLEASE be respectful to the parking attendants. Any disrespect to the parking attendants can involve your being removed from the show by the Park personnel.
- We will have designated space for exhibitors to set up pop-up tents and it will be enforced that parking is in front of your tent not beside it.
- Exhibitors that are camping on the grounds are expected to leave their car parked at their own set up.
- You are required to use the designated parking areas otherwise **the Park have the right** to remove cars and/or fine the owner.
- We reserve the right to have any cars removed if these guidelines are not respected.
- We will be issuing an advance complimentary parking pass to all registered exhibitors. This parking pass MUST always be displayed on the dash of our car.
- All exhibitors MUST pick up their complimentary parking pass at the West end of the LSPW at the washroom/dump station. Your name must be on the exhibitor parking pass list to receive the complimentary parking pass. We will have attendants/staff to distribute the passes from 7:00 am to 12:00 pm Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. After 12:00 pm passes will be issued at the campground entrance.
- **All registered exhibitors require a complimentary parking pass and have it displayed on the dash of their vehicle prior to arriving at the park entrance.** You will only be permitted to enter the main show area if the parking pass is displayed on the dash of your vehicle.
- Parking on the main show area is limited to 175 cars total including conformation and performance areas. The park will always keep track of incoming and outgoing cars. The park staff will adjust the count of cars so they will continue to allow vehicles entry to the main show area as people leave. If the maximum is reached cars/exhibitors will be directed to the unloading zone site #67 and then directed to park on the West side of the Woodlands Campground to sites designated for overflow parking.
- On any of the show days, if we reach the maximum parking limit in the main show area, the registered exhibitors will be required to unload equipment and dogs in Site #67 then move their car to the overflow exhibitors parking on the West side of the Woodlands Campground, Sites #1, #2 and #66. You will return to move your equipment and dogs from Site #67 and set-up in the day set-up areas. There will be one attendant/person on site #67 to assist and control the traffic during this time.
- **If you do not have a complimentary parking pass on your dash** you will be directed to the overflow parking area on the West side of Woodlands Campground, sites designated by the Park Site #31-34, 35-37 as spectators/guests and you will be required to purchase a day pass at \$10.00/car with no refunds being issued. This is controlled by the Park and non-negotiable with SD&G Club.

- All Handicap parking must have an MTO approved blue sticker and park in the designated areas for handicap parking. Vehicles must not be parked on the road; they must park on the grass under the powerlines.
- There will be a Day Use Fee of \$20.00/car for the main show area and \$10.00/car for overflow area for all spectators/guests. You will then be directed to sites #31-34, 35-37 on the Westside of the Woodlands campground.
- **VERY IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CAMPERS.** The park will have new arrivals on Monday for camping therefore, every camper booked to leave Monday **MUST** have their equipment off the campsites by 1:00 PM. If you need to keep equipment on the site after 1:00 PM you must extend your stay for an additional night assuming the site is still available. This will be strictly enforced by the Park. This is non-negotiable.
- **NOTICE:** Park has requested that we keep fire lanes clear for any emergencies. Please refrain from parking on the side of the road. Cars can be removed at the owner's expense.

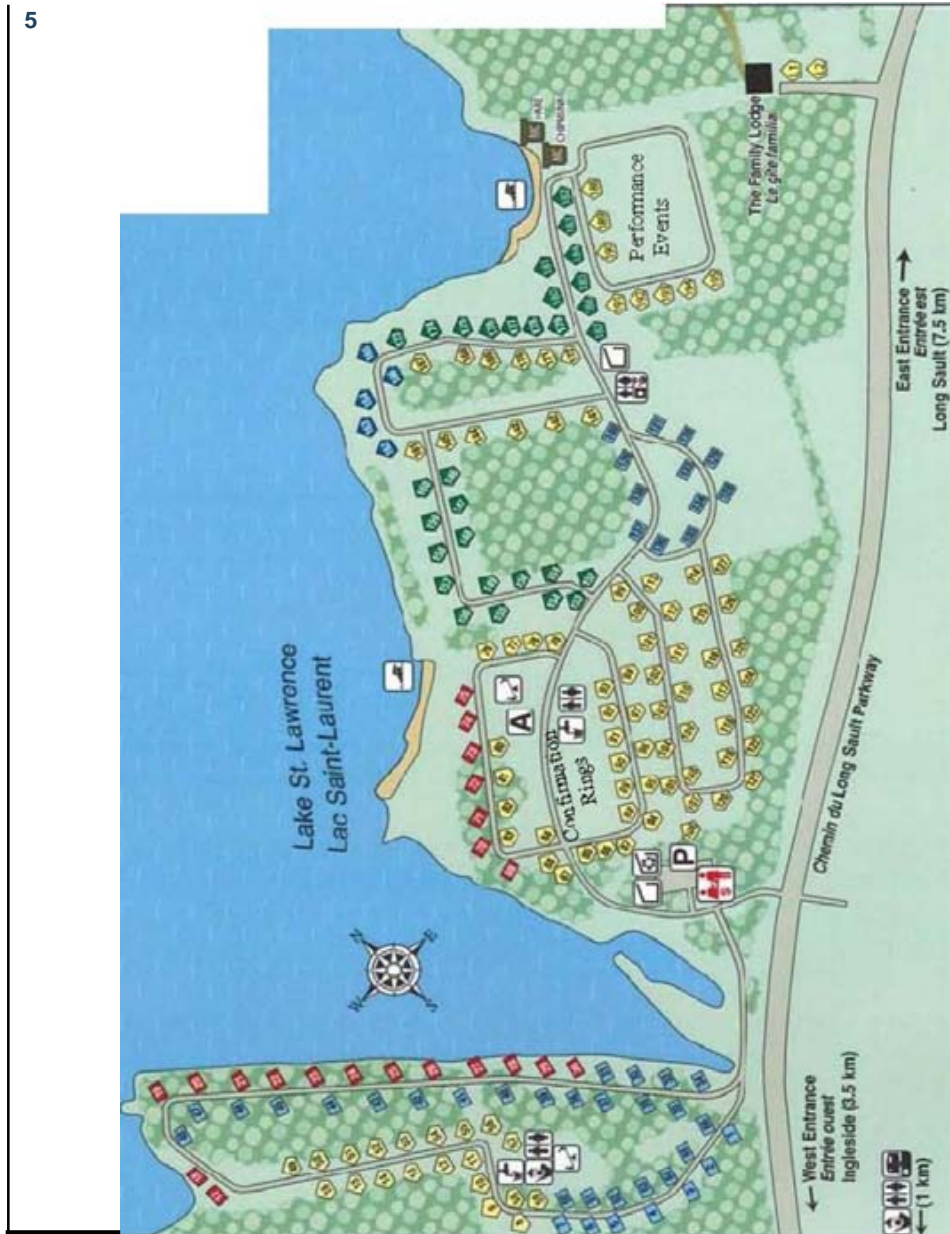

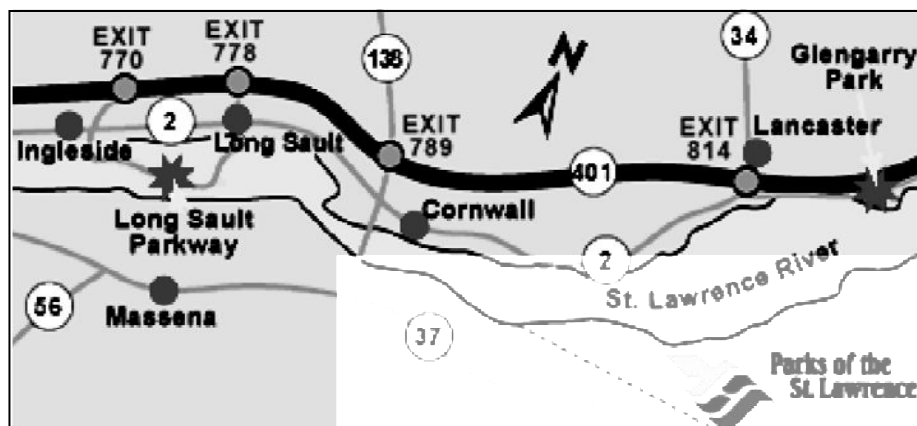
