Introducing Our Judges

DONNA CONOD

My mother, Betty Conod, passed her incredible passion for dogs to me making me a second-generation dog person. Our first dog, a Great Dane was acquired in 1953. She earned her championship in 1954 and was our foundation bitch (Ch Delta of Tollhurst). Whisper Hill Kennel, registered in 1962, has produced multiple BIS,BISS, American and Canadian Champions along with the number one Great Dane and number five Working dog in the country, As a handler I have shown across Canada and the US and continue to exhibit both Great Danes and German Shepherds Dogs. Other Breeds I have had an active involvement in include Pharaoh Hounds, Mini-smooth and Standard Smooth Dachshunds, Mini and Toy Poodles, American Cocker Spaniels, Wire Haired Fox Terriers, and Shih Tzu. My two heart breeds though are Great Danes (since a child) and The German Shepherd Dog which I have had an active involvement in all aspects for 30 years. I had the honour of judging bitches at the German Shepherd Dog Club of Canada's National Specialty and then in 2019, I judged both dogs and intersex. In 2018 I judged the top 20 for the Great Dane Club of America and have also judged the Great Dane National in Finland plus many more memorable assignments.

My goal was always to judge and that dream came true for me in 2002. It has been a pleasure to judge in other countries including Australia, Mexico, Finland, China, Japan, Philippines, Jamaica, Argentina, Columbia, the USA, and Canada.

There is nothing more fulfilling than the world of dogs which has consumed my life. It is an honour to be asked to judge your show and I thank you very much for the invitation. ***(Donna Conod is also judging the Bullmastiff Regional Specialty at this show as well as BOOSTERS for Great Danes, German Shepherd Dogs, and Bouvier des Flandres.)***

JEAN DELISLE

I have been involved in purebred dog for over 30 years. With Pierre Talbot, we have been breeding and exhibiting American cocker spaniels under the Kebec's prefix. I will always cherish the moment when I handled my dog Calif to Best Veteran. That was at ASC in January 2010. Most of our dogs are Canadian and American champions and some are FCI International Champions and FCI World winners. I'm proud that our Cockers have won the Canadian National 3 times; 3 different dogs from the 3 varieties and over 3 decades.

I own and maintain Cockers-worldwide.com / Cockers.com, the Online Pedigree Database with some 190,000 American cocker spaniels from all over the world. I currently serve on the Canadian Kennel Club Communications Committee, continuing to be involved advancing the interests of purebred dogs.

I'm a member of the Canadian Dog Judges Association (CDJA) and the current Editor of the CDJA Quarterly Newsletter. I also wrote articles for Dog Magazines in Canada and the USA.

After working all my life in the media, specifically in Television Broadcast as National News TV Director (TVA Network), my journey brings me now to consider judging as another aspect of the dog show scene. I judge all Sporting, Toys and Non-Sporting breeds. I have been invited to judge in the USA at specialties and all breed shows including the prestigious Flushing Show of the American Spaniel Club. ***(Mr. Delisle is also judging the American Cocker Spaniel Club of Canada Regional Specialty at this show.)***

SUSAN DES COTES

I trained and showed my first dog (a Samoyed) back in 1969. I then fell in love with Shelties and have owned them since 1979. On my first four Shelties we earned four O.T.Ch. and a Ch. & O.T.Ch. on my third Sheltie. I love behaviour work with dogs and have had the pleasure to work with thousands of dogs in my training classes. Currently I have my own training hall on my country property and offer small classes for all breeds. The sire of my first Sheltie herded horses and now life has come full circle as I currently own 2 quarter horses and a mini horse. I barrel race and have won 4 buckles and I am still showing my horses. Whether it be a dog that is acting up or a horse that won't load in a trailer, I love to work with any behaviour issues. I am very enamoured with blue merle shelties and finished my boy, Ch. Surona Stardust and am now working with his daughter and his great grand-daughter, who is also a blue merle. ***(Susan Des Cotes is judging Obedience and Rally at this show and as well is judging the Shetland Sheepdog Fanciers Specialty Obedience & Rally Trials and their Specialty Sweepstakes.)***

JEAN-JACQUES DUPAS

Mr. Dupas has been the owner/handler of Afghans (one of his dogs was shown with success in the USA in 1983); the owner/handler of Berger des Pyrenees; the owner of Shih Tsu and Cavalier King Charles Spaniels. He has show his dogs in France, Belgium, Netherlands, Germany, Switzerland, Tchecoslovaquie, Austria, Yougoslavia, Spain, Italy, Portugal and Luxembourg.

He is presently the President of Club St Hubert du Nord (Kennel Club for the north of France), is now the Treasurer of the Club du Caniche de France (Poodle Club) , and has been the President of the Afghan and Saluki French Club, the President of the Greyhound French Club, the President of the Poodle Club of France, Secretary of the Bergers des Pyrenees and Pyrenean Mountain Dog French clubs and the Secretary of the French Kennel Club (SCC).

He started judging in 1989. He has judged in France, Belgium, Germany, Austria, Netherlands, Danemark, Norway, Luxembourg, Switzerland, Italy, Spain, Great Britain, Ireland, Japan, USA, Tchequie, Poland, Finland, Hungary, Sweden, Canada, Portugal, Slovaquie, Lithuania, Monaco, Russia, Ukraina, Croatia, Latvia, Australia, Uzbekistan, Estonia, Indonesia, Thailand, Iceland, Khazakstan, Taiwan, Colombia, Peru, Brasil, New Zealand, Greece.....

He has judged the Eukanuba World Challenge Show in 2017 at Crufts. ***(Mr. Dupas is also judging the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Canada Regional Specialty and the Bouvier des Flandres of Canada Specialty at this show.)***

JOCELYN GAGNE

All Breed Judge / Lure Field Trial Judge, Starkeeper Perm Reg'd Irish Wolfhounds

In 1978 I acquired my first Irish Wolfhound. Leland started me on my journey of learning about wolfhounds, sighthounds, and the dog world. She kindled my passion for this breed that has grown and strengthened over 45 years.

The first Starkeeper litter was born in 1980. Since then I have produced over 150 Irish Wolfhound show champions, obedience & rally titlists, lure coursing and racing champions in Canada, the USA, Italy and Australia. Four wolfhounds in my home today go back to my original hounds. I don't breed frequently, usually when I am ready to add a puppy to my home.

I am committed to breeding Irish Wolfhounds that are both typical examples of the breed and can perform in the field. As a judge I strive to recognize dogs that are functional. I am both a Lure Field Trial Judge and all breed Conformation judge, approved by the Canadian Kennel Club for all breeds, and by the American Kennel Club and the FCI for several additional breeds. The Kennel Club (England) has approved me to award CC's to Irish Wolfhounds.

Over the years I have owned Scottish Deerhounds and co-owned a Whippet with my daughter. Given the amount of time I spent on the field, in my home and the show ring with sighthounds, I consider myself a sighthound specialist. I look forward to judging the Alberta Lure Coursing Association Sighthound Specialty and am grateful for the invitation.

My judging assignments since 2000 have literally taken me around the world, and I have had the pleasure of going over some outstanding dogs in the course of my travels at both all breed and specialty shows. Through judging invitations I have travelled across Canada, the USA, Mexico, South America, United Kingdom, many countries in Europe, Russia, South Africa, Australia and New Zealand.

The dog world has provided me with ample opportunities and positive experiences in my areas of interest: dogs, travel and meeting interesting people!! In giving back to the sport that has so enriched my life, I have developed a form and function educational presentation on the Irish Wolfhound that I have delivered to owners, judges and breeders in many countries. I have contributed to the current Illustrated Standards for Irish Wolfhounds sponsored by the Irish Wolfhound Club of America and the Federation of Irish Wolfhound Clubs in Europe.

I have served as President of the Irish Wolfhound Club of Canada for 4 years, and currently am President of the Upper Canada Irish Wolfhound club. For several decades I was the performance chairperson for the IWCC organizing specialty lure coursing and racing events for Irish Wolfhounds.

I live in Welland Ontario with my two adult children. 45 years since my first wolfhound, I am still active in breeding and exhibiting Irish Wolfhounds and have had many successes in performance events, all breed and specialty rings with my hounds. So I know what it's like to be judged, as well as doing the judging. ***(Mrs. Gagne is also judging the Alberta Lure Coursing Association Specialty at this show (which includes an Irish Wolfhound BOOSTER) as well as a Bouvier des Flandres BOOSTER.)***

MARGARET HENIGMAN

I can't think of a time when dogs didn't play a significant role in my life. I came from a large family and we always had dogs when I grew up in New Westminster. I started obedience training my very own first pup in 1960. Tass was a Lab/Samoyed cross and I quickly learned that she had a mind of her own but she also had a huge heart. She taught me a lot about the value of patience and consistency in working with these amazing animals. Years later I moved to Nanaimo where I became active in Obedience and Agility with my Shelties. In 1999, I completed my first UD with Marpoint's Charlotte Harlot OTCh. Carley was also a wonderful clown, and she clinched my love of the Obedience and Rally obedience sports. She also sparked my interest in judging. Eventually I was smitten by the intelligence and wonderful attitude of Papillons. I completed 2 more UD's with Ch. Keandas Blazing Rainbows OTCh and Ch. Littlewing's Tiddlywinks OTCh, RAE before being licensed to judge in 2016. My youngest Pap, Ch. The Canadian Kennel Club Genetics and Medical Committee reminds breeders and owners about the risks of infectious diseases and the Baby Puppy class.

The CKC Rules and Regulations for shows, trials and tests, with some exceptions, have explicit rules to minimize the transmission of communicable diseases.

- A dog may not be entered or exhibited at a show, trial or test if it has any communicable disease. Dogs entered in a show, trial or test must have current immunization status.
- No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of a show, trial or test if it:
 - (a) is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
 - (b) has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease with the last 30 days;
 - (c) has been housed within 30 days prior to the show, trial or test on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;

8.1.3 Where it is found that these rules have been contravened, the dog in question shall be removed from the show, trial or test premises/grounds and **the exhibitor will be subject to disciplinary action.**

*At this time there are no Government of Alberta COVID restrictions in place. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the Conformation, Obedience & Rally rules as set out by the Canadian Kennel Club

CONFORMATION

The following CKC conformation classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

Junior Puppy: for dogs 6 mths of age but under 9 mths of age.

Senior Puppy: for dogs 9 mths of age but under 12 mths of age

12-18 Months: for dogs 12 mths of age and under 18 mths of age

Canadian Bred: for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded.

Bred by Exhibitor: for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

Open: for all dogs.

Specials Only: dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and have attained championship status may be entered in the 'Specials Only' class. **Exhibition Only:** for all dogs over 6 mths of age and eligible for registration with the CKC (non-competitive class).

Veterans: offered Saturday and Sunday only. Veterans will be divided Males and Females with a Best of Breed judged for each. The Best of Breed winner will go on to Best Veteran in Group and Best Veteran in Show. Dogs must be 7 years or older on the day of the show.

Baby Puppy (4-6 Mths): offered all four days. For dogs 4 mths of age & under 6 mths of age – dogs will compete in this unofficial class for Best Male/Best Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Group & Show. They do not compete for Winners.

OBEDIENCE

Pre-Novice: for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title PCD (Pre Companion Dog) title in Canada. Only dogs that have NOT earned the CD title may enter Pre-Novice.

Novice A: for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not won the title of CD. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The handler in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families.

Novice B: for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed has not won the title of CD. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise.

Novice C: for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed has gained a CD or any higher obedience titles. **Novice Novice Intermediate:** for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a CD or higher obedience title. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are NOT eligible for High in Trial.

Open HA & 18A: for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has won the title of CD but has not won the title of CDX. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.

Open HB & 18B: for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has won the title of CD and any dog that has earned the CDX or any higher obedience titles may enter either of the Open B classes. A dog may also be entered in the Utility class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person.

Utility A: for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has won the title of CDX but not the UD. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

Utility B: for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX or UD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class but the same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial.

RALLY

Rally Novice A: dogs entered in this class may not have earned a CKC Rally Novice title or any CKC Novice Obedience title other than PCD.

Rally Novice B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. No dog may be entered in Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Intermediate: for dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RI or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. Dog handled by owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Advanced A: for dogs that have earned the RN title but have not won the Rally Advanced title or any CKC Obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class.

Rally Advanced B: for dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RA title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.

Rally Excellent A: for dogs that have earned the RA title but have not won the RE title or any CKC Obedience title other than PCD.

Rally Excellent B: for dogs that have earned the RA title. A dog completing the RE title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

The Northern Alberta Canine Association and the specialty clubs reserve the right to remove from the shows or trials any person or dog for any just cause. Any dog excused by the show superintendent or veterinarian, for any reason, shall not compete in any classes or accept any awards for the duration of the shows or trials. No refund of any fees will be made. If because of riot, civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the show committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds shall be made.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Rally/Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial. The Club will refund entry, recording and listing fees if the above conditions are met. No refunds will be given for the service fees provided by the dogshow.ca. A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a Veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show superintendent to verify she is in season.

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times on the show grounds or within the show building.
- The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of these shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- **ANYONE PARKING IN THE FIRE LANES OR OTHER AREAS DESIGNATED AS "OFF LIMITS" WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOW.**
- All recreational units must have buckets underneath for their drains. Those discharging of any water on the grounds will be removed by order of the health department and subject to a fine.
- A judge officiating at this show held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. (4.7.1)
- A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent (5.1.6)
- There is to be NO SMOKING in the large show tent, nor entrances to it, and NO SMOKING is allowed in the show building.
- Dogs must be on the show grounds 1 hour prior to judging of their breed.
- All vehicles are left on the show grounds at your own risk. No security is provided.
- **No abuse of parking personnel, NACA members or volunteers will be tolerated!!**
- RV's will not be allowed to travel on the show grounds when judging is occurring. Under special circumstances (in case of emergency) the show superintendent will stop the show and parking personnel will assist in the safe removal of vehicle.

Section 15.1.12

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three different judges and.
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an *Event Registration Number* or a *Miscellaneous Certification Number*.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.2 GRAND CHAMPION

The title of Grand Champion may be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points earned in completing the conformation championship are not included in the Grand Championship.

Section 15.2.3

To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

a. Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to BB, BOS, Select Dog & Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh.:

- b. In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.
- c. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

15.2.4 GRAND CHAMPION BRONZE (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand championship.
- b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c. Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 GRAND CHAMPION SILVER (GChS)

- a. The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 GRAND CHAMPION GOLD (GChG)

- a. The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.3 GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT (GCh.Ex)

15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Champion Silver title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a. one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed National specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b. three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.

- c. a CKC performance title from any CKC event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance Title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE:

- 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward it to CKC upon completion of requirements above.
- 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honored up until July 1, 2022.

ENTRY AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules" and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Northern Alberta Canine Association has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these all-breed shows, obedience trials, agility trials or any of the associated Specialties, and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Northern Alberta Canine Association, associated Specialty Clubs, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
