There will be a \$50.00 charge for any returned cheque or declined credit card. Overpayment of entry fees or duplicate entries will not be refunded.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE APPLIES ONLY TO DOGS WHOLLY OWNED BY A NON CKC MEMBER AND ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CKC MEMBERS

Non-Member Participation Fee:

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".

OBEDIENCE

We are pleased to offer a Prize and/or Rosette to the following winners:

- High in Trial (Obedience) - prize and rosette
- High in Class - prize and rosette
- All regular classes will receive a rosette for each dog placing 2nd through 4th.
- Highest scoring Shetland Sheepdog in Obedience Trial each day

GENERAL RULES

1. The Trial Superintendent will have full control of the Trial, which shall be governed by CKC rules.
2. A judge officiating at a trial held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
3. Any dog excused by the Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the trial.
4. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs & Exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to dog or exhibitor regardless of cause.
5. It is expected that anyone participating in this trial will be familiar with the CKC rules pertaining to such an event. If you have any questions, CKC Obedience and Rally Obedience Trial Rule Books will be available for viewing at the Trial Secretary's table.
6. Entries will be acknowledged by mail as soon as possible after the closing date.
7. All dogs are to be exercised only in designated areas. Failure to do so may result in dismissal from the trial.
8. All dogs must be kept under control at all times.
9. Entry fees will be refunded if a bitch comes in season after entry of the bitch has been submitted. A veterinarian's certificate certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 days preceding the Trial must be delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
10. Trial Precincts are defined as the Makin Trax Canine Care and Training Center building.

DAY OF ENTRY - new rule of CKC. An entry will be accepted on day of entry 1 hour prior to beginning of first class of trial. Entry will not be accepted if the trial entered is at full numbers (8 hours of judging)

Please note all day of entry must be on Approved entry forms (some will be provided at the show secretaries table) and only accepted if paid in cash or money order. No personal cheques or credit card payments can be accepted at the show.

OBEDIENCE The following Official classes will be provided for all breeds

Pre-Novice For dogs who have not earned the title of "PCD" in Canada and have not earned the title of "CD" in Canada or any other country. This class is not eligible for High In Trial.

Novice A This is for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD (Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No person who has previously exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. A dog which has earned a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class

Novice B This is for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD(Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "Sit" and "Down" exercises. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for entry in this class.

Novice C For any dog who has earned a "CD", "CDX", "UD", or any advanced obedience title. Exercises as in Novice, and may be entered indefinitely. Not eligible for High In Trial.

Novice Int. Open to any dog who has earned a "CD", "CDX", "UD", or any advanced obedience title. This class may be entered indefinitely. Not eligible for High In Trial.



Open A This is for any purebred dog that has earned the title CD in Canada but has not earned the title of CDX (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a UD title may not handle a dog in this class. A dog which has earned a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.



Open B This is for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be handled by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for "Sit and Down" exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog that has won the title of CDX must compete in Open B. Dogs that have won the title of OTCH may enter this class. A dog eligible for Utility class is also eligible in the Open B class at the same time.

Utility A This is for any purebred dog that has won the title of CDX in Canada, but has not earned the title of UD. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class.

Utility B This is for any purebred dog that has won the title of UD or CDX in Canada.

Veterans The Veteran Class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class.
