# **CONFORMATION CLASSES**

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered <u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> – this class shall be for any dog **9** months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

<u>12 to 18 MONTH CLASS</u> – For dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of this Specialty

**<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u>** – This class shall be for any dog born in Canada (Champions of any country excluded)

**BRED BY EXHIBTOR CLASS** – This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards <u>OPEN CLASS</u> – This class shall be for all dogs

**VETERANS CLASS:** Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes will NOT compete for Championship points but goes directly into the Best in Specialty Show competition. SPAYED OR NEUTEREED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS.

**SPECIALS ONLY CLASS** – This class shall be for any dog, which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded. *EXHIBITION ONLY* – All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY.

#### NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

<u>Note</u>: Any dog entered in an Unofficial/Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

<u>SIRE & GET:</u> shall be for Sire and three maximum of his Get. <u>BROOD MATRON & PROGENY:</u> Shall be for Dam and three maximum of her Progeny.



In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Auld Lang Syne Dog Association, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
