JUDGES BIOGRAPHIES



Terry Carter is an all-breed judge who has owned and handled Old English Sheepdogs, Chow Chows and Norfolk Terriers. Terry's first dog was a Smooth Fox Terrier given to her by her grandfather when she was a child. Her father had Border Collies, which were working livestock dogs and later Australian Cattle Dogs. Her involvement with dog shows and OES began with her marriage to Gary in the mid-60s and together, under the kennel name, "Some Buddy Reg'd" they have bred over 100 CKC champions, approximately 40 AKC champions, a National Specialty winner in Australia, plus a dog exported to Denmark who went on to be a top producer there. Included in this are specialty winners in the U.S. and Canada as well as about a dozen Best in Show winners. In 1977 Terry exhibited "Some Buddys Titled Hero" to #3 all breed and #1 Working dog. They have more recently added Norfolk Terriers to the household and have produced a number of Canadian and American champions, including an all-breed BIS Winner. Terry and her husband have maintained a small herd of Shorthorn cattle and have bred high-ranking Event horses, an interest they still follow. She has been honoured to have judged the American National and the breed at the American Centennial, the Australian National, a German National plus specialties in other breeds. Besides the U.S. and Canada she has judged in Australia, Brazil, Japan, Ireland, Hong Kong and Germany.



Tempest Deptuch started exhibiting dogs as a junior in 1974, showing standard poodles, miniature poodles and afghan hounds for her parents. In 1975 she left home and lived/worked at a grooming shop and a kennel that bred poodles. From that point on she was hooked. Over the past 40 years she has bred and shown standard poodles under the prefix Diplomat. As a breeder/owner/handler she finished multiple American, Canadian Champions, as well as achieved many Best in Shows and Group wins on her homebred dogs. She has also competed in obedience trials putting CDs and CDXs on her poodles. In 1987 she met her husband (Sandy) Russel Fletcher and for the next 10 years they exhibited their own dogs as well as handled for many other breeders and bred and exhibited purebred Hereford cattle. In 2008 she had the privilege of becoming a CKC conformation judge and is currently licensed to judge Non-Sporting, Sporting, Working and the Hound Group. She is a contract computer instructor, specializing in electronic health records software, working with First Nation Health Centres in British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba.



Mel & Lynda Saranchuk began in English Setters in 1972 and bred successfully under the Hystepin name (perm reg). Many of their dogs were shown successfully in both Canada and the United States and were champions in both countries. They have owned or shown Wolfhounds, GSPs, Sibes, Labs and Scotties and presently own an English Cocker Spaniel imported from

Argentina. They began judging in the early 90s and have been honoured to judge many specialties including working, herding, toy and sporting groups and have also done numerous sporting dog breed specialties. Mel has judged the Schipperke National Specialty and a Bouvier Specialty, as well as the Southern California English Setter Specialty. Judging the Gun Dog Specialty in New Zealand was also a highlight. Lynda's most recent specialty assignments include the Pug Specialty in New Zealand, English Setters in Palm Springs and the Toy Specialty in Pennsylvania. They are founding members of the Chatauqua Kennel Club and

have held many executive positions, are lifetime members of the Canadian Kennel Club, members of the Canadian Dog Judges Association and have held executive positions with the English Setter Club of Canada and the CDJA. Mel was a successful educator/Vice Principal and recently has worked for the Dept. of Agriculture in Alberta. We raised Gelbveih Cattle and had numerous quarter horses. Lynda worked for the private sector as an office manager as well as having a successful grooming and retail shop employing four full-time groomers. They have two sons, a wonderful daughter-in-law and two beautiful granddaughters.



Jacqueline L. Stacy began exhibiting dogs in 1958. Her father, a German Shepherd Dog fancier, allowed her to choose her own breed. Mrs. Stacy chose Pomeranians and eventually bred and showed over 50 champions. Under the Tamarin Affenpinscher prefix Mrs. Stacy and her husband and fellow judge Terry Stacy have produced over 70 champions, owning or breeding seven national specialty winners, eight all-breed Best in Show winners, the top-winning American-bred Affen in breed history, and 2008's number-one toy dog. As a licensed professional handler, Mrs. Stacy showed the Maltese Ch. Keoli's Small Kraft Warning to first in the Toy Group at the 1984 AKC Centennial Show. Mrs. Stacy has been a member of the American Pomeranian Club for better than 25 years, serving on their board as director, treasurer, standard-revision committee member, and judges' mentor. She will judge their national specialty in 2013. A longtime member of the American Maltese Association, Mrs. Stacy judged the club's 2008 national. She served as the newsletter editor, vice president and president of the Affenpinscher Club of America and spearheaded the creation of the club's first Illustrated Standard. Mrs. Stacy serves as a breed mentor.



Mr. W. Terry Stacy finished his first breeder-handled champion in 1955. As a young man he managed the Downbraugh kennels of Mr. and Mrs. William Brainard. Between 1961 and 1979, he was an all-breed professional handler. During this period he also bred Cocker Spaniel champions and handled a homebred bitch to Best of Winners at the American Spaniel Club. Mr. and Mrs. Stacy have bred 27 champion Affenpinschers under the Tamarin prefix, including two BIS winners and two specialty winners. Mr. Stacy is approved to judge the Sporting, Hound and Terrier groups plus Boxers and Poodles. He has served as president of the

Cocker Spaniel Club of Virginia and the Silver Bay Kennel Club, show chairman Shoreline Dog Fanciers Association and the Affenpincher Club of America, and judges' education director for the American Spaniel Club. As an AKC senior vice president, he founded and created the AKC Judges Institute. He was Dogdom's Man of the Year, 1994. Outside interests include sports, music, theatre, genealogy and travelling. Mr. and Mrs. Stacy have three grown children and five grandchildren.



Corinne Walker was a medic in the Canadian Forces Reserves for 12 years and retired as a MWO. Needing something to throw herself into she purchased her first Rottweiler in 1984 and was bitten by the dog show bug, later purchasing a Bernese Mountain Dog. Since then she has bred or co-bred BIS Manchester terriers, group-placing French Bulldogs and multi BIS BISS Rottweilers. Her first love is definitely the Rottweiler and she cannot see herself ever being without one. Corinne is still actively showing and breeding on a small scale and is the show secretary for the Manitoba Canine. She works at Sport Manitoba as the manager of the

print and design area. Working with amateur sport is not only rewarding, it is definitely not boring! To say that dogs are her life would be an understatement, as she enjoys the interaction and nuances of the breeds that she has been fortunate enough to live with. She is a student of all breeds and is truly enjoying her journey as she proceeds through her judging career.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY - Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required points for Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

**** NOTE 1** Junior Puppies must be entered in the appropriate class in order to be eligible for the special rate.

The handler of the dog must be the owner of record or a direct family member. The owner must show the dog at all levels of competition. This competition is open to non-professionals only. Anyone who has handled dogs in a professional capacity in the past 2 years is not eligible to participate.

There are no additional fees for this event. Participants do not need to pre-register but the dogs must be entered in a regular conformation class.

TIME: Following Puppy in Group and Puppy in Show

Owner-Handled competition is an unofficial class. Participants do not need to pre-register but will need to inform the ring steward following the breed judging that they are the owner. The handler of the dog must be the owner for the classes.

Only owner-handled dogs that receive a Best of Breed ribbon are eligible to compete in the Best Owner Handled Dog in Group. The winner of BOH in breed may compete in BOH in Group unless the dog was already defeated at the Best in Group level, by another owner-handled dog. The winner of BOH in Group will compete in BOH in Show after the completion of Best Puppy in Show unless the dog was already defeated, at the Best in Show level, by another owner-handled dog that is entered in this competition.

*** NO CHARGE TO CAMP ON MONDAY NIGHT***

Pre-paid reserved parking is \$30.00 per night (see reservation form).

NOTE: For non-reserved RV parking, a parking fee of \$40.00 per night will be collected upon entry to the grounds. No cheques. Cash only.

1. Overnight parking access begins Thursday, September 1st, 2016 at 12 noon. You can stay of the grounds until Tuesday, September 6th @ noon.
2. Heavy units will be parked on compact gravel with a grassy area. All others will be parked on the grass.
3. Bring boards and use them under your generator and propane firepits.
4. All dogs must be kept on leash. Exhibitors must pick up after their dogs.
5. Power/Hookups are not available, water is available but bring your hoses.
6. **FLUSH TOILETS & SHOWERS**
7. There will be only one designated vehicle (or van & trailer) per site.
8. Handlers/box vans reserve day parking - \$120.00 for the four days (this is for anyone that wants to work out of their vehicles).
9. Generators may be operated between the hours of 6:00am and 11:00pm

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The show superintendent shall have full control of these shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the show superintendent or veterinarian for any reason shall not, compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.
4. Dogs must be on the grounds 1 hour prior to the judging of their breed.
5. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
6. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
7. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only, not in vicinity of show rings
8. All recreational units will have buckets underneath for their sink drains. Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed by order of the health department, and may be subject to a fine.
9. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, there is no refund of entry.
10. Dogs must be on leash at all times on the show grounds or within the show building with the exception of the obedience rings.

ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

SECTION 8.6.1 & 8.6.3 OF THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The authorities of any show may:

- decline to accept entries for just cause and/or
- refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- in the case of non-acceptance, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the organization holding the show, or any official connected therewith for the refusal of any entry.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

(a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed

(b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration

(c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A listing fee of \$8.40 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 8.2: INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled.

Section 8.6.2: DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitor who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order, cash or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 14.1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

CHAPTER 5 – SHOW OFFICIALS

Section 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

FOREIGN BORN MINIATURE DACHSHUNDS

Foreign-born Miniature Dachshunds if eligible for registration in the CKC, may be shown as a listed dog up to the age of one (1) year. The owner(s) must then submit an application for registration to the CKC within thirty (30) days. The listing fee for a Foreign-born Miniature Dachshund will be \$2.00 per show. Failure to comply with these rulings will automatically cancel all points on record.

Canadian Kennel Club Non Member Participation Fee (April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.
- The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
