Rules and Regulations of the FPOTC

COVID-19: FPOTC tracking events will be compliant with all relevant Federal, Provincial, Regional and other COVID-19 protocols. All entrants and other participants will be notified of all COVID-19 protocols as necessary via email. If entrants choose not to comply with protocols as communicated by FPOTC they will not be able to participate and may forfeit their entry fee.

PAYMENT: Please make all cheques or money orders payable to Forbidden Plateau Obedience& Tracking Club. E-transfers may be sent to fpotcpaymenttracking@gmail.com no sooner than one month prior to test date. A Temporary Competition fee (\$10.50) as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual, registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form

The test is limited entry. We shall be accepting entries by Mail, Email, and Hand Delivery. Entrants will be notified by phone or email that their entry has been received. Entry fees will be returned within 10 days of the day of the test to Alternates who did not participate in the test.

DRAW FOR ENTRY: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine placement in the test or on to an Alternate list. The drawing will be at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, October 1st, 2021, at the test secretary's residence. 1743 Sparrow Place Courtenay.

CLUB WORKER OPTION: At the entry draw, three TD tracks may be reserved per CKC Rule 6.6.2. "Club Worker" is defined by FPO&TC Policy (one worker track for every four tracks offered).

MEETING PLACE AND DRAW: Due to changing Covid-19 protocols, Rendezvous and track draw location to be determined at a later date and all entrants will be notified by email. Any primary entrant(s) who is absent at this time will forfeit their position to the first Alternate present.

BITCHES IN SEASON may compete, however, they will run last. Please advise the Test Secretary upon arrival.

AWARDS & NO-HOST LUNCHEON: To be determined.

REFUNDS: When an entered dog is withdrawn after the closing date, refunds will only be permitted when the vacancy is accepted by an "Alternate". If a position becomes available, Alternates will be contacted in catalogue order and asked to either accept or decline the position. (i.e. if #1 declines #2 will be contacted, etc.). Please note that withdrawing after the closing date due to COVID-19 protocols (eg: if travel restrictions are put into place after the closing date), a refund may be issued by the host club.

ARTICLES: Articles will be carried and scented by the track layer. Extra articles will be kept in a plastic bag.

RULE 14.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Limitation of Liability: In attending this test, competitors, spectators, and guests acknowledge they do so at their own risk and that of any dog. They also agree, upon submitting an entry form, that they will not hold liable the CKC, the FPOTC or its officials, the Judge or the landowner(s) for any loss, damage, or injury, however arising, to themselves, their dog(s) or any other chattels.

Exhibitors may not train on the tracking fields (this includes urban areas designated for an urban test) within 14 days of the test.

Effective January 1, 2011 Non-Member Participation Fee

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of CKC. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. For the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.

All Premium lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
