To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or Visa/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$62.40 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.
