BEST OWNER HANDLED DOG IN GROUP AND SHOW SATURDAY ONLY

The handler of the dog must be the owner of record or a direct family member. The owner must show the dog at all levels of competition. This competition is open to non-professionals only. Anyone who has handled dogs in a professional capacity in the past 2 years is not eligible to participate or CKC licensed judges. There are no additional fees for this event. Participants do not need to preregister but the dogs must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Owner-Handled competition is an unofficial class. Participants do not need to pre-register but will need to inform the ring steward following the breed judging that they are the owner. The owner of the dog must handle the dog through all class levels.

Only owner-handled dogs that receive a Best of Breed ribbon are eligible to compete in the Best Owner

Handled Dog in Group. The winner of BOH in breed may compete in BOH in Group unless the dog was already defeated at the Best in Group level, by another owner-handled dog. The winner of BOH in Group will compete in BOH in Show after the completion of Best Puppy in Show unless the dog was already defeated, at the Best in Show level, by another owner-handled dog that is entered in this competition

Please note that effective January 1, 2016, in accordance with Section 3.4.1 of the Junior Handling Rules & Regulations, Junior Handlers will be required to apply to CKC Head Office for a Junior Handling Number.

Section 3.4.1 “Junior Handler with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.”

The Application for a Junior Handler Number is posted on the CKC website under the Events tab, and then under Event Forms, Exhibitor, or Event Supplies, Junior Handling. **This application can be mailed, faxed, or emailed to CKC Head Office and there is no fee.**

NOTE: Payment in full must accompany your entries. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees, and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$100.00 fee charged for any N.S.F. cheque.

Attention US Exhibitors: Current exchange rate favours the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they must be payable in US funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian fund, or "at par" as such items are not readily cleared through the bank. Your co-operation is appreciated.

ATTENTION: ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - ERN NUMBERS All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard number, (expiry date, cardholders name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. ERN number must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.

Temporary Competition Numbers or (TCN) – A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN off (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC by mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, score, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

2022 RV Parking for Edmonton Kennel Club

No day of arrival RV spaces, only prepaid and prebooked sites will be available.

Please note the following parking requirements/restrictions:

1. Those wishing to park together must arrive together.
2. Space changing will not be permitted. All vehicles must park as directed by parking personnel.
3. Confirmation of your reservation will be sent if you enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope.
4. Tow vehicles must fit into assigned space (not in the isle), or be moved to day-of-show parking area.
5. No foul or abusive language will be tolerated; anyone not following parking rules will be asked to leave, and no refunds will be given.
6. Vehicles parked on grass will be required to have ground cover placed under their generators or exhaust pipes to protect the grass.
7. All generators must be turned off between 11 pm and 6am daily.
8. No dumping of gray water or sewage is allowed.

Handler Set Up

If you use an RV spot you will be required to pay the same fee as RV's. Please see Pam Jodoin if plan to set up in the day tenting area and will require a larger spot than a normal size day tent. A \$20.00 cash refundable deposit is required for each site. This will be collected when you arrive.

Day Tenting

A space will be provided for day tents in designated areas only. **Tents cannot have bottoms on them and no grass mats on the field.** Please see the day tenting attendant before setting up your tent.

We will have reserved day tenting at a cost of \$25.00 for a 10 x 10 space, this will be nearer to the rings, **NO** generators will be allowed in the reserved day tenting. There will still be free day tenting around the fence line (outer edge of the field), generators can be used here but must have protection so they do not burn the grass. A \$20.00 refundable deposit is required before you can set up. The deposit will be returned at the end of the show if your space is clean.

This also applies to Obedience & Rally-O day tenting.

No day tenting set up will be allowed on Tuesday. Set up will begin on Wednesday after the rings are set up. No bathing facility on Tuesday.

No exhibitor vehicle parking or driving on the field or surrounding berms. This will be strictly enforced. We will supply a shuttle service to get your equipment on and off the field.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of chapter 20 of the dog show rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "specials only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed championship shows or specialty shows are held on the same date, same venue and in conjunction, the moving of the class dogs to specials must be completed not less than one (1) hour prior to the scheduled opening of the first (1st) show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
2. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
3. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts, judging schedules, and exhibitors passes will be e-mailed
4. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
5. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
6. SHOW PRECINCTS: Whitemud Equine Learning Centre Assoc., excluding the commercial booth space.
7. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
8. 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be **not** in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level

(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

15.2.4 GRAND CHAMPION BRONZE (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. a. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand championship. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. c. Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 GRAND CHAMPION SILVER (GChS) a. The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 GRAND CHAMPION GOLD (GChG) a. The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty

level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.3 GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT (GCh.Ex) 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Champion Silver title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

a. one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed National specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).

b. three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.

c. a CKC performance title from any CKC event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance Title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward it to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honored up until July 1, 2022.

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that " these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of the Edmonton Kennel Club Show & Trials if it:

- Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or any other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to event)
- Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or any other communicable disease.

The Edmonton Kennel Club has the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

COVID 19 – The Edmonton Kennel Club recognizes the impact and risks that COVID-19 continues to have on our community. It is important to ensure the safety of our club members, volunteers, ring stewards, judges, and exhibitors. The EKC will follow all federal, provincial, municipal and facility protocols related to COVID-19 that are in place at the time of the show, and by entering our show you agree to abide by these rules. If any club members, volunteers, ring stewards, judges or fellow exhibitors are subject to abusive language or behavior, or if you fail to abide by the show protocols, this may result in your dismissal from the show with no right of entry refund.
