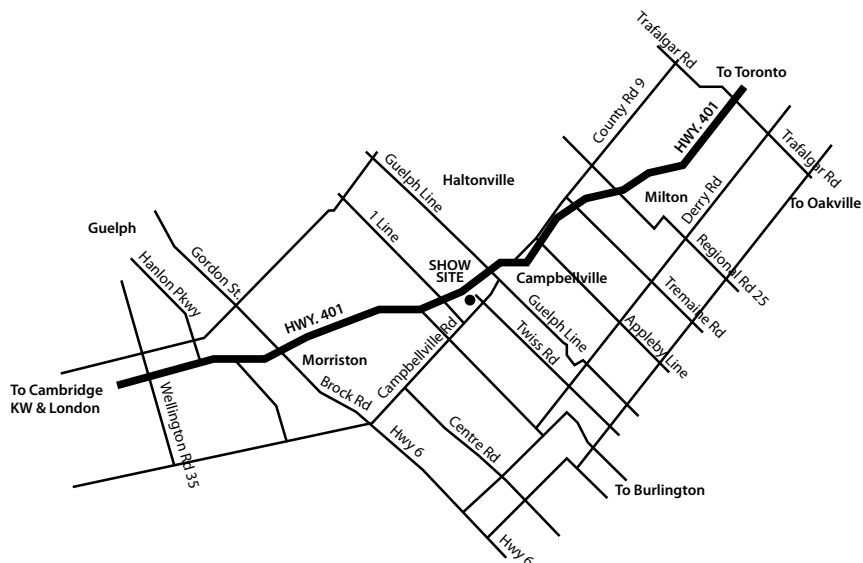

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION CLASSES

OFFICIAL CLASSES:

JUNIOR PUPPY - a dog between 6 mos. & under 9 mos. on day of show.
SENIOR PUPPY - a dog between 9 mos. & under 12 mos. on day of show.
12-18 MONTHS - a dog between 12 mos. & under 18 mos. on day of show..
CANADIAN BRED - a dog which is born in Canada.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR - dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS - for all dogs.
VETERANS CLASS - for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements, and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY - dogs who are Canadian Champions only. Entry of a listed dog is not permitted in this class. PLEASE NOTE: A dog which is registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and has attained championship status may be entered for "Specials Only". Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of Champion has not been confirmed by the C.K.C., but if it is found later that a dog entered at this show had not attained Championship status before the entry was made then all awards attained by that dog at this show will be cancelled.

AWARD OF MERIT - at the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed, which will be presented following Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

EXHIBITION ONLY - This is a non-competitive class which entitles a Cavalier to be present on the show grounds and to be entered in unofficial classes. This class is open to any dog.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$58.50 per dog plus applicable taxes.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4- Section 4.7.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

Judge's Biography

Mr. K.J. Town



My first dog was a Boxer, I saved up and bought it when I was 15 and still at school.

I had always been interested in animals and my older sister introduced me to horse riding when I was 6; a hobby I still enjoy to this day. My Boxer was a kind of substitute horse and I soon got to know some other Boxer owners in the area and they introduced me to the show scene.

When I left school I went to work in one of the old style 'big' kennels. There were 40 adult Boxers and about 20 puppies at various stages of development. I was in heaven! I learned a lot during that time; husbandry, handling, construction and type, not to mention life in general as having been educated by Christian Brothers, I had had a somewhat sheltered childhood. Later on I bought a Basenji puppy and by this time my knowledge of the dog world had increased a bit and she went on to become my first Champion, in 1966.

I bought a couple of Cocker Spaniels from Joe Braddon, who also taught me a lot. I could not get into the coat trimming with the Cockers and I never showed them but some of the ones I bred did well for others.

I had seen Cavaliers at some of the shows I had been to and liked them and when I discovered they were to be completely free of trimming or stripping it occurred to me that this might be just the breed for me.

I went to see Barbara Percival (Littlebreach Cavaliers) who lived quite nearby in Liverpool then. She found me a nice puppy in August 1969 and my career in Cavaliers got started. The tricolours always appealed to me and in due course I became friendly with Sheila Halsall, (Pantisa Cavaliers) who had some lovely tris in quite large numbers. My quest to breed a good tricolour started and eventually Barsac Touch and Go came along who became a champion and was top Cavalier bitch in 1986.

'Toffee' was a great showgirl and a super mum. She in turn produced Ch. Barsac The Palio who was Best in Show at the Cavalier Club Ch. Show in 1990 and won the certificate there again the following year.

Now, my hobby is my work too and I run a busy boarding kennels near Edinburgh where we have a lot of Cavaliers as visitors as well as all kinds of other breeds plus about 40 cats.

I have judged in the UK at Championship shows since 1989 and in various other countries over the years including Sweden, Australia, New Zealand, Finland, Norway and Germany and the USA several times.

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE 8:00 P.M. MONDAY, JUNE 16, 2014** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.**
