GENERAL INFORMATION

The Tantramar Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators

The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.

Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.

Due to the limited amount of space, the superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken u p by x- pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the superintendent in this regard.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Disci pline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the TKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made. Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted in the building.

Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.

Champions and championship points - chapter 15

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder: **Section 2**:
