NATIONAL SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR CLUMBER SPANIELS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months Sexually Altered

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open

Veterans Specials Only Exhibition Only

<u>Note:</u> Award of Merits will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Best Altered Male, Best Altered Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

NOTE: Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny only

Brace Class – For two Clumber Spaniels competing together as a brace.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Hunting Dog/Bitch - shall be for any dog/bitch that has earned at least a leg towards a JH, SH, MH title under AKC/CKC rules & regulations. Only dogs with these titles qualify. Must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only.

<u>Note:</u> All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to enter non-regular classes on your regular entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Clumbers at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 Months
Senior Class for Clumbers at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12months
12-18mth Class for Clumbers s at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only. There will be 4 classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 10 years for Clumbers at least 7 years of age up to and including 10 years.

10 Years + for Clumbers who are 10 years of age and over.

PRIZES

SPECIALTY SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES – Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows: 25% of total fees will be retained by the club for administration. Best in Sweepstakes will receive 25% of total entry fee. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive 20% of total entry fee. First Place winners in each class will divide the remaining 30% of the total entry fee.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they
 are handling and must use the designated areas. Pacific Kennel Club supplies bins for recycling and Poop.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The CSCC and Pacific Kennel Club will not be held responsible for any equipment left on the grounds overnight. NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT on the grounds OVERNIGHT. No equipment may be left on the grounds overnight
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- The CSCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. The precincts of the show shall be the 30 feet
- The Club reserves the right to remove any person from these shows, which will be held strictly under Canadian Kennel Club Rules.
- The Club reserves the right to decline to accept entries for just cause, in which case the fee will be refunded with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club holding the show or any official connected therewith for refusal of an entry.
- Only dogs entered in the Show will be permitted on the show premises.
- Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds. Exhibitors are responsible for their equipment and possessions.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. The club will not be responsible for and not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agent of breed
 or class judging. NO RING WILL BE HELD UP WAITING FOR EXHIBITORS OR HANDLERS.
- For the benefit of the health of animals, the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping the show grounds as clean as possible.
 EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS. Dogs are to be exercised in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. Failure to comply may result in future entries being refused. Please place all garbage in the correct bin.
- All trailers, motor homes, campers and recreational units will have buckets underneath their sink drains. Anyone found discharging gray or black
 water from their unit will immediately be removed from the grounds. All generators must be vented and no run at night.
- There will be no other facilities in case of inclement weather.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- Entries will be acknowledged (with a judging schedule by email) as soon as possible after the closing date. If it is not received within a reasonable
 time please contact the Show Secretary.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Any exhibitor wishing to substitute or cancel an entry must do so in writing before the hour of closing. Substitutions or cancellations of entries after the closing time are prohibited. THERE WILL BE NO REFUND FOR OVERPAYMENT OR DUPLICATE ENTRIES..
- All Exhibitors are encourage to review the Canadian Kennel Club rule book at http://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations
- Dogs must be kept ON LEAD in all Public Areas.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1.No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. **Entries positively close 12:00 noon (PDT) June 30, 2016,** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- 6. Judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- 7. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. or returned item will be subject to a minimum \$50.00 service charge. \$50.00 will be charged on all returned items NSF cheques.

Reservations are strongly recommended. Deadline for reservations July 13, 2015 noon PDT.

Spaces are assigned on a first come first served basis, in order of ARRIVAL.

Gates will be open at 3PM on Wednesday.

WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND THAT YOU BRING PROOF OF YOUR RESERVATION!

RV Parking:

Reserved \$35 per night. Unreserved \$45 per night EXACT CASH ONLY Adjoining sites must be booked together. RV Parking fee includes: 1 tow vehicle/car plus 1 RV per space. An Extra Vehicle placard may be purchased for \$20 flat rate, for the event. You may purchase as many Extra Vehicle Placards as you want, provided the vehicles fit within the confines of your RV space. RV Spaces are approximately 25' x 40'. ALL vehicles and equipment must fit into this space. Generators must have adequate exhaust venting and ground protection. There is no power or septic service available. ABSOLUTELY No dumping of gray or black water on site.

Day Tenting (no tenting/cover provided):

Violators will face disciplinary action.

Reserved \$15 per day. Unreserved \$20 per day EXACT CASH ONLY Adjoining sites must be booked together. There is NO overnight parking or camping in this area. Pens and tents may be left overnight at owners risk. All vehicles and dogs must be removed daily. Space is to accommodate one 10 x 10 tent and ONE (1) vehicle. You will be issued a placard to hang on your rear view mirror. It can be transferred to any vehicle but only ONE (1) per site. Do not lose it; no replacements, no refunds, no exceptions.

Ringside Tenting (no tenting/cover provided): NO VEHICLE ACCESS - CRATE DOLLY ONLY!

ALL SITES MUST BE RESERVED \$60 PER 10X10 space for entire event. Adjoining sites must be booked together. No Generators - No power available. Equipment must remain within the confines of your space. No dogs left overnight. You may leave your equipment overnight, at your own risk. No tents may be set up or dismantled during show hours. ALL Tents MUST be secured to the ground. One day parking pass provided per 10X10 Ringside spaced reserved. Check in at RV Booth - Bring confirmation of reservation.
