

DO YOU HAVE A MIXED BREED OR A BREED NOT RECOGNIZED BY THE CKC?

These events are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds.

CANINE COMPANION NUMBER

For a Mixed or All Canadian Bred Dog

All dogs that are mixed must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized-breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a TCN dog.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

For a foreign-owned, registered dog

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number.

AN ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT TO AVOID CANCELLATION OF AWARDS.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER

Required for an un-registerable purebred dog

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an un-registerable dog of a CKC recognized of listed breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. A PEN dog must meet the following criteria: be of a CKC recognized or listed breed; for one reason or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration; and must be spayed or neutered.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN)

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number.

MAIL IN ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full and accompanied by a signed waiver and entry fees.
- Telephone or Email entries cannot be accepted.
- Cheques dated after the close of entries will not be accepted. Tendering of an NSF cheque will be considered non-payment of entry fees and can result in the cancellation of awards. All NSF/returned cheques will be assessed a \$40 service charge.
- There will be no refund of overpayments or duplicate entries. An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. Written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary by the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the event. Entries that are cancelled before the closing date will be refunded.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE POLICY

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Lamé dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched.
- Muzzles and catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. No Flexi-leads, or prong or electronic collars allowed.
- A \$20 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last course.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes or in the port-a-potty – YOU BRING IT IN YOU MUST PACK IT OUT.
- Foreign born and foreign owned dogs may compete with an Event Registration Number (ERN). This must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a copy of your foreign certificate of registration and a fee of \$57.60 with a letter of request to the CKC. This ERN replaces a CKC individual registration number for American Owned dogs entering events only and is not subject to taxes
- Azawakh's may compete but must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)
- NOTE: a CKC TCN Fee of \$11:30 per dog is payable for each dog that does NOT have a CKC Registration Number, Performance Event Number or Event Registration Number. This \$11:30 is in addition to the regular class entry fee.
- There shall be two course lengths, 300 and 600 yards (273 and 545 meters).
 - The short course shall be for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and/or brachycephalic (flat-faced dogs).
 - The long course shall be used by all dogs not eligible to run the short distance.
 - If there is a question on which course a dog shall run the judge shall decide.

COMPETING DOGS

- Dogs must complete the entire distance of their course with enthusiasm and without interruption.
- Dogs shall run as singles ONLY.
- The dog may wear a catch collar that is free of any item which may become entangled in the line, the collar shall be snug to minimize the chance of getting caught in the line

EQUIPMENT:

A continuous loop machine with white and/or coloured plastic streamers will be used. Back up equipment will be on site.

TITLES

- Chase Ability (CA) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges
- Chase Ability Excellent (CAX) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of ten times (CA + 7 additional passes)
- Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability Event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc.)

From the West on HWY 401

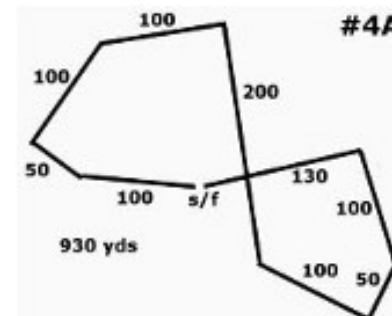
- Take the exit toward Oxford Road 29/County Rd 29
- Turn right onto Oxford Road 29/County Rd 29, Continue onto Oxford St W,
- Turn left onto Wilmot St N/County Rd 3, Continue to follow County Rd 3
- Turn right onto Oxford Road 8/County Rd 8 (signs for ON-401 E)
- Turn left onto Blenheim Rd/Oxford Road 43/County Rd 43
- Turn right onto Oxford Waterloo Rd/County Rd 44,
- Turn left onto Queen St Continue onto Notre Dame Dr/Regional Rd 12,
- Turn right onto Berlett's Rd/Township Rd 2

From the East on HWY 401

- Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 278 for ON-8, toward Kitchener/Waterloo
- Continue onto ON-8 W
- Take the ON-8 W/ON-7 W exit toward Stratford, Merge onto ON-7/ON-8 W
- Take the Regional Road 12/Notre Dame Drive exit toward Queen Street/New Dundee/Petersburg
- Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Waterloo Road N/Petersburg and merge onto Notre Dame Dr/Regional Rd 12
- Merge onto Notre Dame Dr/Regional Rd 12
- Turn right onto Berlett's Rd/Township Rd 2

We will follow Provincial and local guidelines

1. All participant will wear facial coverings over nose and mouth and maintain social distancing of 6 feet.

4. Roll Call will be done at everyone's car, instead of at the secretary's table area. The roll call committee will wear gloves and facial coverings. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
5. We will have instant hand sanitizer and wet wipes in several locations for your use.
6. Porta Potty – Please use the provided spray to sanitize the area after you use it, prop door open for airflow when not in use.
7. Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs.
8. Practice social distancing the best you can. Please act responsibly.
