Saturday, April 4th and Sunday April 5th 2020 2 rounds each: Novice, Advanced, Excellent, & working. 1 round of Versatility and Versatility Excellent

Entries for this trial close on March 30th at 9 am. ALL ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER THIS DATE ARE SUBJECT TO \$5 LATE FEE

This is a titling event under CARO rules and regulations. CARO is open to all dogs being at least six (6) months of age, including purebred and mixed breeds, except bitches in season or dogs with injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans. Facility info: The building will be open SATURDAY at 9:00 am and on SUNDAY at 8:00 am for crating and check in. ALL shoes MUST be changed to clean indoor shoes and dog paws cleaned/dried off in the entrance area of the facility. Ring 1 is 50 x 60 feet. Ring 2 is 50 x 90 feet for working and 50 x 60 feet for versatility. No foot traffic on EAST side of the Red Barn. PLEASE drive slowly down our driveway, 10 km/h MAXIMUM!

Amenities: Coffee and tea are complimentary. This trial is a POT LUCK!!! We will have some food and goodies, please plan to bring something to add to the table.

Camping: We have 30 amp service for those wishing to bring RV's, cost is only \$40 plus HST per day. We also have RVs onsite, rental cost is \$85 plus HST per day. <u>Awards:</u> Qualifying and 1st through 4th placement ribbons will be offered. In order to keep entry fee costs down, New Title Rosettes will be available for purchase. Cost is \$8.00 including HST. This is our cost, we do not make any money off rosettes.

A, B & C classes will be combined where applicable. Brace judging and FEO runs (where applicable) will follow regular classes & walk through with everyone in that class.

Owner/Handler Information: All dogs must be shown at all levels of CARO Rally by the owner or by a member of the owner's immediate family. "Immediate family" is defined as: Mother, father, spouse, life partner, brother, sister, child, grandparent or grandchild.

Entries received after closing date please add \$5 PER DOG entered.

HST is not included in these prices and will be added to final amount.

All entries MUST be submitted online and there is NO online entry fee. You will receive an invoice after you enter that has the total you owe.

Confirmations & schedules will be emailed shortly after the closing date of the trial.

Physically challenged handlers are encouraged to participate. Handlers shall provide the judge with a written description of how they intend to perform any of the course exercises (submit with entry on separate sheet of paper).

Move Ups: Same day move-ups will be permitted, please note it is the handler's responsibility to inform the Trial Secretary before their next event.

- All dogs must be kept in a crate or on leash when not in the ring (x-pens are allowed). Handlers are responsible to keep their dogs quiet at all times and clean up after their dogs. Handlers are responsible to clean up after their dogs and exercise them in appropriate areas only. Any dog engaging in aggressive behavior at any time will be required to leave the trial grounds. There will be no refund of fees in such instances.
- Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog, or other participants, judges or volunteers, be it physical or verbal, while on site, will be asked to leave the trial grounds. There will be no refund of fees in such instances and all legs earned will be null and void.

The Rally Novice A Class. The A stream is for the handler who is an inexperienced beginner – who has never titled a dog in any sport. They have not instructed or assisted with dog training classes in any sport. In effect, this is the first time they have worked a dog towards a title. Once the

handler has obtained their RN title, they may continue to the Advanced A stream with the same dog. There is no A or B stream in Excellent or Versatility.

When a competitor has attained their first Advanced A title, they are considered "experienced" and must compete in the B stream with any other dogs they handle.

A handler must own the dog entered, or be a member of the owner(s) household or immediate family to compete in Novice A.

For Exhibition Only" (FEO) Dogs competing under FEO are not eligible for placements in the class.
