Classes Offered

Regular Classes:

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be offered at this Specialty:

6-9 months; 9-12 months; 12-18 months; Canadian Bred; Bred By Exhibitor; Open; Veteran; Specials Only.

Veteran's Class: shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over. Dogs in this class do not compete for points; the winner of each class goes directly on to compete at the Best of Breed level. They may also be spayed or neutered.

Sexually Altered Classes:

Two classes only will be offered - Altered Male and Altered Female, winners of the class will compete for Best Altered in Breed and Best of Opposite Altered in Breed

Non-Regular Classes:

All dogs must be entered in the Regular classes, Veterans, Altered or for Exhibition
Only to compete in the following non-regular classes.

Brace: Two dogs (either sex or mixed) shown on one lead, not necessarily owned by the same owner

Stud Dog & Get: Stud dog and TWO or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Brood bitch and TWO or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Baby Puppy Classes: All dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

Awards for Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female and Best Baby Puppy in Breed.

Sweepstakes

The following Classes will be offered , divided by sex only: **Juvenile:** 6-9 months, 9-12 months & 12-18 months.
Veterans: 7yrs – 9yrs, & Over 9yrs.

Prize list will be as follows:

First in each class - 35% of class entry plus ribbon.

Best in Sweeps - 25% of overall sweeps entry & ribbon

Best of Opposite sex - 15% of overall sweeps entry & ribbon

The remainder is to be retained by the Club.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Portage Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to the specialty.
2. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt and judging schedules. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
3. **Due to limited grooming space NO private x-pens will be allowed.**

ACCOMODATIONS & CAMPING & INDOOR POWER

Please see the Portage Kennel Club premium list for Hotels, Motels and for on-site Camping as well as information on indoor power for grooming.

****New as of March 2 , 2020 Temporary Competition Numbers or (TCN)****

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN. While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number. The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone. Before you apply for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if CKC has already created a TCN for them. There will be a tab for TCN Dogs on the Owner's Portal account. Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

Notice to All Canadian Residents Only

Section 24-12-3.

Non-member participation fee

- A) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC**
B) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN) : Effective Jan. 1, 1992, all foreign born and foreign owned dogs that enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration #, but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Forms to apply for an ERN will be available at the show. Or simply send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, with a written request for an ERN number and a check for \$58.85 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club, Shows and Trials, 200 Ronson Dr., Suite 400, Etobicoke, Ontario. M9W 5Z9

CKC Rules

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The

Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 – A dog awarded **Winners** at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded **Winners** shall be as follows.

DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from the ring by the judge **shall not** be included in the calculation for championship points.

The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded **Winners** also places in the **GROUP** as listed below.

A class dog awarded **Best in Show** at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five (5)** points at a **single show**. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number. (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. (15.1.13).

Best Puppy in Breed – Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed, is **NOT** required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each.

Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honored up until July 1, 2022.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of **Chapter 20** of the **Dog Show Rules**, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing **at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show**, by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration **BEFORE** the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a **LISTED** dog. Listing fees, however, **WILL NOT be refunded**.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)
