

Classes Offered

Regular Classes: The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be offered at this Specialty:

6-9 months; 9-12 months; 12-15 months; 15-18 months; Canadian Bred; Bred By Exhibitor; Open Black; Open Landseer; Field Class; 7-8 years Veteran; 9+ years

Veteran; Specials Only

Veteran's Class: Dogs in this class do not compete for Winners, but the winner of each class goes directly on to compete at the Best of Breed level. Dogs competing in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Field Class for Draft Dogs*: for any dog that holds a CKC Draft title (DD, DDX, BDD, and BDDX). Field Class dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winners of these classes shall go directly on to compete for Best of Breed. *Dogs competing in this class may be spayed or neutered.*

Non- Regular Classes:

Exhibition Only: All dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades. All dogs in this class must be eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club.

Exhibition Only 3-6 months: for dogs 3-6 months of age on the day of the show provided that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. Puppies in this category may enter and compete in sweepstakes if offered. All dogs in this class must be eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club.

Baby Puppy: Dogs 3-6 months of age on the day of the Specialty.

Sexually Altered Classes: Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female

All dogs must be entered in Regular classes, Veterans, Altered or Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes (no Baby Puppies permitted):

Brace: Two dogs (either sex or mixed) shown on one lead, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Stud Dog & Get: Stud dog and TWO or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Get MUST be entered in a Regular class.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Brood bitch and TWO or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Progeny MUST be entered in a Regular class.

Parades: Please Include a short written article (about 100 words) along with your entry – email to sasknewfdog@gmail.com. May be altered and shown in unorthodox trim. Must be entered in an Official class or Exhibition Only.

Parade of Titlists: For any Newfoundland holding a CKC recognized title e.g. working, obedience, championship, CGN, etc.

Parade of Veterans: For any Newfoundland seven years of age or older on the day of the Specialty.

Obedience classes offered: Novice A, B & C; Open A & B; Utility A &B, Pre-Novice; Novice Intermediate: Veterans; Brace; Exhibition Only

JUNIOR HANDLING

Conformation only on Saturday August 27, 2016



The following classes will be offered: Junior Novice / Intermediate Novice / Senior Novice / Junior Open / Intermediate Open / Senior Open

Junior handling for Conformation will be offered with preregistration only. These events are for Newfoundland dogs only. Dogs do not have to be owned by the handler but no bitches in season are allowed in these competitions.

Junior Conformation Handling Prize List:

The Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada – Sk Region is pleased to offer ribbons to all Juniors placing in Conformation Handling. Doug and Cindy Savory offer an award for first in each class and Best Overall Junior Handler. A Rosette will be presented to Reserve Junior Handler and Best Overall Junior Conformation Handler. Additionally, each entrant will receive a memento of their participation.

CONFORMATION

Junior Novice Class: This class is for handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Junior Open Class: This class is for handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year who have won 6 first places with competition.

Intermediate Novice Class: This class is for 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open Class: This class is for 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition who have won 6 first places in the same class with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open Level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Senior Novice Class: This class is for 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition and up to 18 years of age, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

Senior Open Class: This class is for 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition and up to 18 years of age, who have won 6 first places in the same class with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Held under CKC Rules.

Newfoundland dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show/trial on that day.

**Please Note: Effective Jan. 1, 2016 - Section 3.4.1 "All Junior Handlers with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

Attention U.S. Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

To obtain an ERN: Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number. Please indicate coat type and size, if applicable. Fee for an Event Registration Number with the CKC is \$59.40 + GST of 5%. Include your payment in the full amount in Canadian funds. Payment may be made with VISA or MasterCard, personal or business cheque or money order. For Non-Members, please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non- residents of Canada, please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your VISA or MasterCard number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature. An ERN must be obtained within thirty (30) days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a thirty (30) day extension. Notice to All Canadian Residents Only New CKC Rule - TRACKING FEE FOR NON-MEMBERS

Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee (\$59.40 + GST of 5%)

- A) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canandian non-member of CKC.
- B) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more		
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5		
*Includes the dog awarded Winners								

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1..

GENERAL INFORMATION

Show precincts shall be those areas specifically designated for use by the SKOC.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Saskatoon Kennel & Obedience Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this Specialty

Entries will be acknowledged after they are received. If acknowledgment has not been received after one week after the closing of entries please contact the Show Secretary.
