

These events are held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club.

Entry Fees: \$20.00 1st dog per CAP test, \$17.00 2nd and subsequent dog per CAP test (same owner). (Includes CKC Recording Fee).

TCN Fee (Temporary Competition Number): \$10.50 Required for any dog without an individual CKC Registration number, Misc. Number, Event Registration Number, or Performance Event Number.

DogShow.ca Service Fees: 10% of total Fees plus GST.

ENTRIES TO BE MADE ON DogShow.ca

EMAIL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR THESE EVENTS.

Any overpayment of entry fees is considered a donation.

The waiver must be completed and emailed/mailed to the Secretary or brought to the field. We must receive a signed waiver for your dog to run.

Judging Assignment: Valorie Hill (all canines)

<u>Handler's Meeting:</u> Will be emailed in advance of the events

Rolling Inspections: Trial 1: from when you arrive until 9:30 am CST. Running of dogs will start after inspection is complete and the field is ready. Trial 2: inspection will end 45 minutes after the end of the first trial but will not end prior to 11:30 am.

Directions to The Field:

The field is about 4 km southeast of Delisle, at the intersection of Range Road 3084 (Durham Road) and Township Road 342. If you are coming north from Calgary on #7, turn Right on #766 approx. 1 km past Delisle, and right at the first turn past the feedlot. The Pattison farm (big red barn, metal roof) is the first place you come to; the field is across the road from the house and the buildings, on the right.

If you are coming from Saskatoon on #7, turn left about 10 km past Vanscoy, onto Durham Road. Continue approx. 3.5 km on Durham Road, crossing 766. The Pattison farm is the second place you come to. The field is across the road from the house and buildings, on the right.

Additional Information:

- Everyone is expected to help fill the gopher holes that are on the field so the dogs may run safely. Bring a shovel to make the task easier for everyone.
- Delisle Veterinary Clinic is within easy access from the field.
- The field is rough hay. It is away from roads but is not fenced.
- There will be a port-a-potty on site.
- Lame dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry fee refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call. Note that DogShow.ca has its own rules regarding refunds for their charges.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety or they shall not be allowed to run. Additionally, the field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- Dogs may run with muzzles & catch collars at the handler's discretion. Catch collars must be snug and be free of any item which may become tangled in the line. No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed on the premises of this event.
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last test.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes. Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- Rosettes will be offered for new titles. Flats will be offered for qualifying performances.
- Visit these websites for dog friendly accommodations in Delisle or Saskatoon www.doginmysuitcase.com, www.travelpets.com, www.officialpethotels.com. Book early, do not leave your dog unattended and remember to "Stoop & Scoop".
- Due to COVID-19 health & safety guidelines, a canteen might not be available. Please bring your own food and water. However, if provincial regulations allow, Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club may host lunch and snack. Stay tuned!
- Bring your own shade as there is no shade on the field.

<u>Exhibitors Please Note</u>: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

SPECIAL COVID 19 PRECAUTIONS/INFORMATION

Please refer to https://www.saskatchewan.ca/covid-19 for the latest Provincial restrictions and guidelines.

Charges to precautions may change with changing situation. Any person(s) found to be willfully disregarding these precautions will be asked to leave the property, with no refund of any entry fees.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING/MASKS: It is highly recommended to maintain a minimum of 6 feet or 2 meters distance from others whenever possible. When arriving at the field, please park in a row(s) 6 feet away from each other. As much as possible, please stay in or near your vehicle except when running or exercising a dog. In situations where physical distancing cannot be maintained, the wearing of a facial covering (mask or face shield) over nose and mouth will be recommended. Participants must provide their own mask or other suitable face covering.

HANDLER'S MEETING:

The handler's meeting information will be sent via email on Thursday, Sept 23rd or before. It is each handler's responsibility to read and follow the information provided.

RUNNING ORDER:

The running order will also be sent via email by Thursday, Sept 23rd. Please print the running order and bring it to the field if possible. If you are unable to print off the running order, please note which dogs you follow so you and your dog will be ready to run when it is your turn. Note there may be the odd omission in the running order following the roll call/inspections.

DAY OF EVENT ROLL CALLS/INSPECTIONS:

Roll Call/Inspection will be done at everyone's vehicle. The roll call committee may wear facial coverings at this time. They will proceed down the row of vehicles and ask handlers to move their dogs for a soundness check. To check for females in season, we will ask the owners of females to wipe their own dogs with a tissue and show the inspection committee the tissue.

CLEANLINESS: Sanitizer will be available at the Secretary's trailer and by the Porta Potty. Bring your own hand sanitizer to use before and after touching your facial coverings, as well as any other incidences of touching objects with contamination potential.

Porta Potty – Please use hand sanitizer prior to touching any surfaces with contamination potential and use the provided spray to sanitize the area after you use it.

FOOD/WATER: A reminder that to comply with health and safety guidelines related to COVID-19, there might be no food or water provided on site. Please bring your own food/refreshments for yourself and for your dog(s). Stay tuned for updates.

WELLNESS: If on the day of these events you or any member of your household are exhibiting any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19, please refrain from attending these events. Entry withdrawals due to illness will have the entry fee component refunded. Beware that DogShow.ca may have their own rule regrading refunding their own fees.

COVID REFUND POLICY: In the event that provincial regulations change and force the cancellation of these events prior to the day of the event, the entry fee component will be refunded. Beware that DogShow.ca may have their own rule regrading refunding their own fees.

CKC CHASE ABILITY PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Participants: Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC; or have an Event Registration Number (ERN); or have a Performance Event Number (PEN); or eligible for registration with the CKC; or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed-breed. Note: Only dogs eligible for a CKC# or an ERN# can be entered as listed. Sighthounds are more than welcome at these events.

Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. An inspection committee, consisting of two experienced persons, shall inspect each entry for lameness, fitness to participate and females in season. If in the opinion of the committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female is in season, it shall not be allowed to participate and the entry fee component shall be refunded.

A dog may enter only once per event. Running order determined based on the entries received. Multiple entries from the same owner will be separated in the running order. The Chase Ability program is a pass/fail event. To earn a Pass a dog must run alone, chasing the lure and complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. If there is a question as to which course a dog will run the judge will decide.

300 YARD COURSE: This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs. Dogs will run one loop.

600 YARD COURSE: This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. Dogs will run both loops.

The course will be reversed for the second event. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the event.

CAP RIBBONS AND TITLES: Gold qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs passing their test.

There are three titles dogs may earn doing the Chase Ability Program.


They are: **Chase Ability** (CA) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges.

Chase Ability Excellent (CAX) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of ten times (CA + 7 additional passes)

Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc)

1. To hold the Saluki Club of Canada including their members, directors, officers and employees (collectively defined as the "SCOC"), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim;
2. To hold the SCOC harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the SCOC or any other person(s);
3.
