This could change prior to our closing date. If it has not, and you choose to enter, taking a chance that the borders will open prior to the show allowing exhibitors from outside the Atlantic Bubble to attend, and they do not, there will be no refund of entry fees. If it becomes necessary to cancel this show due to changes in provincial guidelines brought on by an increase in the incidence of positive COVID-19 cases all entries will be refunded. We respectfully request that if you cannot or will not comply with these guidelines Do Not Enter or Attend! THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN REQUIRED. Our Waiver must be signed by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Volunteers, Vendors, Family

Members, Friends etc. Contact tracing information must be provided for all who attend (name & phone number) Everyone must wear masks correctly over mouth and nose: Exhibitors, Judges, Stewards in the rings during judging. A 120 X120' perimeter will be fenced around the show pavilion and rings, and masks will be required while in this space. They will also be required anywhere on the property where

social distancing (2 meters) cannot be maintained. (e.g. Vendor area, in Washrooms)

Social Distancing (2 meters) is Mandatory in the rings, under the tents, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth. Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers. Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the ring, NO RECYCLING of ribbons.

Exhibitors are encouraged to return to their set up after they have exhibited their dog. SHOW and GO!

Parking will be directed, and space is not an issue. You may request as much space as required for your set-up. Generators are permitted in the parking area, as are personal ex-pens, grooming tables, pop-up tents, portable picnic tables etc.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Dog Show is NOT OPEN to the General Public.

Show Site Access Process: The waiver will be emailed along with the judging schedule, you will be required to print off enough waivers to so that every individual traveling with you has their own waiver. The Waiver(s) will be handed into the club upon arrival at show site, attendance wrist band will be provided at this time only. It is recommended that each group provides a cell phone contact number upon entering that will be in use during the show. We will have an individual monitoring each ring and notifying exhibitors of possible delays, etc. (Ring times will be posted in the schedule after every three breeds while we try to maintain a steady but easy pace.)

The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations, and there will be a "limited" supply of masks available.

Grooming tables used in the ring will be cleaned frequently. No indoor grooming area, and power is not supplied. You must be self-sufficient. (Love those portable generators!!) No grooming tables, crates or trolleys under the pavilion No chairs under the pavilion

No public ex pens.

The food concession will be TAKE-OUT ONLY. Menus will be provide in your entrance packet, orders will be phoned in and delivered to your numbered parking spot. Be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks. Do not leave personal belongings at ringside. Do not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc. behind, dispose of these items in the garbage bins.

Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instrument.

OUR SHOW WILL HAVE A WELL-IDENTIFIED COVID SECURITY TEAM WHO WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MONITORING PROTOCOL VIOLATIONS. IF YOU OBSERVE ACTIVITY WHICH CAUSES YOU CONCERN, PLEASE REPORT IT IMMEDIATELY TO THE TEAM OR OUR SHOW SUPERINTENDENT. WE WANT TO MAINTAIN A NON-CONFRONTATIONAL ENVIRONMENT IN ALL ASPECTS OF OUR EVENT, WHICH AT TIMES IS DIFFICULT WHEN DEALING WITH THIS VERY POLARIZING ISSUE. The Show Secretary is NOT RESPONSIBLE for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Please read your entry carefully before you submit it. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the errors were made. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.

Photocopy extra Entry Forms if required. If a dog is entered in more than one class or eent, a separate entry form is required for each one. NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a \$30.00. NSF cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibiters. Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please note that the full name and address of owners MUST be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2 Dog Show Rules)

### **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- 1. send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as

"LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

#### **TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (\* EFFECTIVE MARCH 2, 2020)**

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

#### TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly.\*

Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

\* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

Senior Puppy	A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show.
12-18 Months	A dog 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show.
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada.
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions.
Veteran Class	Dogs must be seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.
Altered Class	Eligibility for the altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six (6) months of age that have been spayed or neutered
	by Veterinary procedure. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the altered class judging.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculations of Championship Points.** 

#### NON MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled. Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

#### NON-PUREBRED DOGS IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS

Non-purebred dogs will be accepted in both Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials. If entering your non-purebred dog in either of these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number. Please check the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual Chapter 6.34 (found on line at the CKC website) for requirements to obtain your dog's CCN.

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms and separate entries are required for each class entered. Be sure to state the jump height

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or participant at any event held under CKC Rules, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.
