Lower Mainland Dog Fanciers of British Columbia All Breed Scent DetectionTrials Saturday July 24 & Sunday July 25, 2021 Changes to Scent Detection Protocols

The following motion was passed by the CKC Board on September 22nd, 2020 during a Special Board meeting:

"THAT, <u>effective immediately</u> and until the COVID-19 situation is resolved, that the following section of the Scent Detection Trial Rules & Regulations, effective January 1, 2019 be <u>held in abeyance</u>: 6.8.3 The following classes must be offered: Instinct & Novice. and THAT, effective immediately and until the COVID-19 situation is resolved, clubs will be granted the flexibility to offer their choice of classes,

THAT, effective immediately and until the COVID-19 situation is resolved, clubs will be granted the flexibility to offer their choice of classes, elements and height divisions to meet the availability of facilities and comply with local and provincial regulations relevant to size limits of gatherings."

This motion provides flexibility for clubs holding Scent Detection Trials, allowing them to offer the choice of classes without having to hold Instinct or Novice classes, offer some or all of the various components (Containers, Interior and Exterior), and offer some or all of the various height divisions (Small, Medium & Large) during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

A reminder that these are temporary policies in place during the COVID-19 pandemic.

L.M.D.F.B.C. Club Note: All classes are offered for these Trials. Height divisions will be required on entries. Whether height divisions will be used to designate a distinction in judging order will be at the discretion of the judge and trial chairperson.

10.1 Classes, Components & Titles

- 10.1.1 Titles may be earned by class or by component. A dog may be entered in either the class or the component they are eligible for. Titles will be awarded once requirements are met for the class or component,
- 10.1.2 CKC Scent Detection Instinct-This is an optional title with no prerequisites. This class is open to dogs who have not attained a CKC Scent Detection Novice title. A dog must obtain one Qualifying score in the Instinct Class to obtain SDIN title. SDIN will be a suffix title.
- 10.1.3 CKC Scent Detection Novice-This class has no prerequisites. This class is open to dogs who have not attained a CKC Scent Detection Open Title. A dog must obtain one Qualifying score in the Novice Class in each of the three Novice components of Containers, Interior, and Exterior to obtain the SDN title. Qualifying scores do not have to be earned at the same trial. SDN will be a suffix title.
- 10.4.1 CKC Scent Detection Open A dog must first obtain a CKC Scent Detection Novice Title (SDN) before earning a title in this class. This class is open to dogs who have not attained a CKC Scent Detection Excellent Title. A dog must obtain one (1) Qualifying scores in the Open Class in each of the three Open components of Containers, Interior, and Exterior to obtain the SDO title. Qualifying scores do not have to be earned at the same trial. SDO will be a suffix title.
- 10.1.5 CKC Scent Detection Excellent A dog must first obtain a CKC Scent Detection Open Title (SDO) before earning a title in this class. This class is open to dogs who have not attained a CKC Scent Detection Master Title. A dog must obtain one (1) Qualifying scores in the Excellent Class in each of the three Excellent components of Containers, Interior, and Exterior to obtain the SDE title. Qualifying scores do not have to be earned at the same trial. SDE will be a suffix title.
- 10.1.6 CKC Scent Detection Master A dog must first obtain a CKC Scent Detection Excellent Title (SDE) before earning a title in this class. A dog must obtain one (1) Qualifying scores in the Master Class in each of the three Master components of Containers, Interior, and Exterior to obtain the SDM title. Qualifying scores do not have to be earned at the same trial. SDM will be a suffix title.
- 10.1.7 Container Title A dog may earn a Container title by earning 1 qualifying score in each of the levels. The levels are completed in the following order: Novice, Open, Excellent and Master. A dog may not be entered in a component level for which they are not eligible. Once requirements are met, the title earned is Scent Detection Container (SDC). This title shall be a suffix title.
- 10.1.8 Interior Title A dog may earn an Interior title by earning 1 qualifying score in each of the levels. The levels are completed in the following order: Novice, Open, Excellent and Master. A dog may not be entered in a component level for which they are not eligible. Once requirements are met, the title earned is Scent Detection Interior (SDI). This title shall be a suffix title.
- 10.1.9 Exterior Title A dog may earn an Exterior title by earning 1 qualifying score in each of the levels. The levels are completed in the following order: Novice, Open, Excellent and Master. A dog may not be entered in a component level for which they are not eligible. Once requirements are met, the title earned is Scent Detection Exterior (SDX) This title shall be a suffix title.
- 10.1.10 Scent Detection Grand Master A dog must have already obtained a CKC Scent Detection Master Title (SDM) to be eligible for this title. A dog must obtain 5 additional qualifying scores in the Master Class in each of the three Master components of Containers, Interior, and Exterior to obtain the SDGM title. Qualifying scores do not have to be earned at the same trial. SDGM will be a suffix title.
- 10.1.11 Once a dog has qualified in a component at one class, they may move to the same component in the next class (Example: A dog qualifies in Novice container may move to Open container).
- 10.1.12 A dog that obtains a Scent Detection Container Champion (SDCHc), a Scent Detection Interior Champion (SDCHi) and a Scent Detection Exterior Champion (SDChe) shall earn the title of Scent Detection Champion (SDCH). A dog that obtains a Novice Scent Detection (SDN), an Open Scent Detection (SDI) an Excellent Scent Detection (SDM), and a Master Scent Detection (SDM) shall earn the title of Scent Detection Champion (SDCH). SDCH Shall be a suffix title.

6.9 Moving Up

- 6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the **next** level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 15 minutes before the start of the class. *(emphasis is mine)*
- 6.9.2 The Event Secretary shall amend the judge's book and the marked catalogue, which are to be sent to the CKC with the requests attached to the appropriate entry forms.
- 6.9.3 If it is established by the CKC that a dog moved up to the next level has not completed the requirements for the lower level before moving up, then all qualifying ribbons and/or awards earned by the dog incorrectly entered shall be forfeited and cancelled by the CKC and the owner may be subject to disciplinary action.
- 6.9.4 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a Performance Event Number (PEN), an Event Registration Number (ERN), a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) or a Canine Companion Number (CCN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

3.6 Indignities to a Judge

14.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the event- giving club to see that a judge, club official, steward, volunteer or competitor at a Scent Detection event held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue

4.4 Limited Entries

- 4.4.1 If indications point to a probable entry in any or all classes in excess of the club's capabilities, it may limit entries in any or all classes by prominent announcement on the title cover page of its premium list.
- 4.4.2 When the advertised limit (if applicable) has been reached, all remaining entries may be assigned a position (by class) on a wait list. The person making the entry shall be notified of his position on the list. In the event that the entry of a bitch in season is withdrawn after the closing date, it may be substituted with one from the wait list up to and including the day of the event. At the club's discretion, if the club is notified in writing after the closing date that an entry other than a bitch in season will be absent from an event, the entry may be substituted with one from the wait list up to 24 hours prior to the event. Fees will not be refunded for any reason other than a bitch being in season and to those on the wait list who did not participate in the event. Entry fees will be refunded within 10 days following the trial for those on the wait list who did not participate in the event.

6.1 Entry Requirements

- 6.1.1 Every dog entered in an approved event or sanctioned match must be one of the following:
- (a) Registered with the CKC
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN)
 - (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, and have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)
 - (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
 - (f) Have a Canine Companion Number (CCN)
- 6.1.2 To be eligible to compete at approved trials or sanctioned matches a dog must meet the requirements of Section 6.1.1, and:
 - (a) Must be at least 6 months of age.
 - (b) May be spayed, neutered, or debarked.
 - (c) Must not be lame (it is the judge's responsibility to determine whether a dog is lame).
 - (d) Must not compete if it has tape or bandages that may impair its working ability (such a dog must be immediately excused and under no circumstances may it be returned later for judging after the tape or bandages have been removed).
- 6.1.3 If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number, provided that:
 - (a) If born in Canada, it is eligible for individual CKC registration
 - (b) If not born in Canada it is eligible for individual registration in the records of the CKC
 - (c) If it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first trial entered
 - (d) The entry of a dog with a Temporary Competition Number at a Scent Detection event held under these rules (sanctioned matches excluded), must be accompanied by the appropriate Temporary Competition fees. Breeds of dogs on the miscellaneous list may not be entered using a Temporary Competition Number, but must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN). Mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds also may not be entered using a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) but must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN).

- The club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or vendors/concessions. Check for lost property at the security desk. The club reserves the right to refuse an individuals entries, for just cause.

Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers if judging times for their dogs conflict.
