CLASSES OFFERED

OBEDIENCE CLASSES: REGULAR

Refer to Section 9 of the O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below: The following REGULAR classes, are offered at these trials:

NOVICE A CLASS- shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of CD in Canada or any other country. A dog shall not be entered in a Novice class once it has been exhibited in an Open class.

Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. No professional handler or trainer, or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

NOVICE B CLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of CD in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog that has earned the title of C.D., or a comparable title in any other country, but has not earned its title of C.D. in Canada, may only be entered in the Novice B Class.

OPEN A CLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have earned the title of CD in Canada but have not earned the title of C.D.X. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families and must be eligible to handle under S.10.1 .3. No professional handler or trainer, or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

OPEN B CLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B classes at any one trial.

UTILITY CLASS A-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of CDX in Canada. Dogs in this class must be handled or exhibited by the owner or immediate family member. However, the same person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person that has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may NOT handle in this class

UTILITY CLASS B-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of CDX in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. However, the same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES: Transition

Refer to Section 13 of the O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below: The following transition classes, are offered at these Trials:

PRE-NOVICE CLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of P.C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may be entered in Pre-Novice that has earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex that have earned the title of C.D., CDX, UD and any other advanced obedience title in Canada. Dogs may be eligible for entry in Open and Novice C and Novice Intermediate at the same trial. This is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to an Open class. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class

indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

NOVICE C CLASS-open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title C.D, C.D.X., U.D. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class. Exhibitors may compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs may be in N.I. and this class and/or any of the Official or Unofficial Classes.

Exhibition Only

Refer to Section 14 of the O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below. The following class is offered at these Trials: EXHIBITION ONLY-is an official class. No dog so entered can compete in any Regular class, however it may be entered in and compete in any Unofficial class or Parade if offered. A listing fee is not required for a listed dog entered in Exhibition Only (not entered for any competition).

**The following Unofficial classes are being offered on

OBEDIENCE CLASSES: Unofficial

Refer to Section 15 of the O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below. The following classes are offered at these Trials:

BRACE CLASS- is open to any 2 dogs of any breed and of either sex that has attained not less than a C.D. title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor that they be of the same breed.

VETERAN'S CLASS-is open to dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years and older. Dogs entered in this class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES: Official

Refer to Section 9-11 of the R.O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below. The following classes are offered at these Trials:

RALLY NOVICE A is open to any dog who has not won a C.K.C. R.N. title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice and and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

RALLY NOVICE B is to to any dog who has not earned a Qualifying Score in Rally Advanced. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY ADVANCED A is for dogs that have won the R.N. Title but have not won the R.A. title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY ADVANCED B is for dogs that have won the R.N. Title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT A is for dogs that have won the R.A. Title but have not won the R.E. title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT B is for dogs that have won the R.A. Title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

TROPHY LIST - OBEDIENCE

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

- ❖ The club reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the show and the show grounds. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of these shows and trials, which are governed by CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB(CKC) rules.
- ❖ A Judge officiating at a trial held under the CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Trial chairperson shall promptly investigate and report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation.. The Discipline committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on the report indicating that his rule has been violated.
- ❖ Any person excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the shows, trials and or events.
- ❖ The Show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.
- ❖ Dogs must be on the grounds 1 hour prior to their trialing.
- ❖ The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- ❖ Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
- ❖ All recreational units will have buckets underneath for their sink drains. Any one found discharging water on the grounds will be removed by order of the Health Department, and may be subject to fine.
- ❖ If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, there is no refund of entry.
- ❖ Dogs must be on leash at all times on the show grounds or within the show building with the exception of the obedience rings.
- ❖ Exhibitors are expected to maintain a clean area. Please be considerate when utilizing the building facilities. No dogs are permitted in the washrooms.
- ❖ The welfare of any children is deemed to be the responsibility of the guardian or parent. Please exercise control and restraint over your child's behavior.
- ❖ The club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or vendors/concessions. The club reserves the right to refuse an individuals entries, for just cause.
- ❖ The club reserves the right of restricting exhibitors space.
- ❖ Fire lanes in all areas will be maintained.
- ❖ Entries which are incomplete after the closing date/time will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made.

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

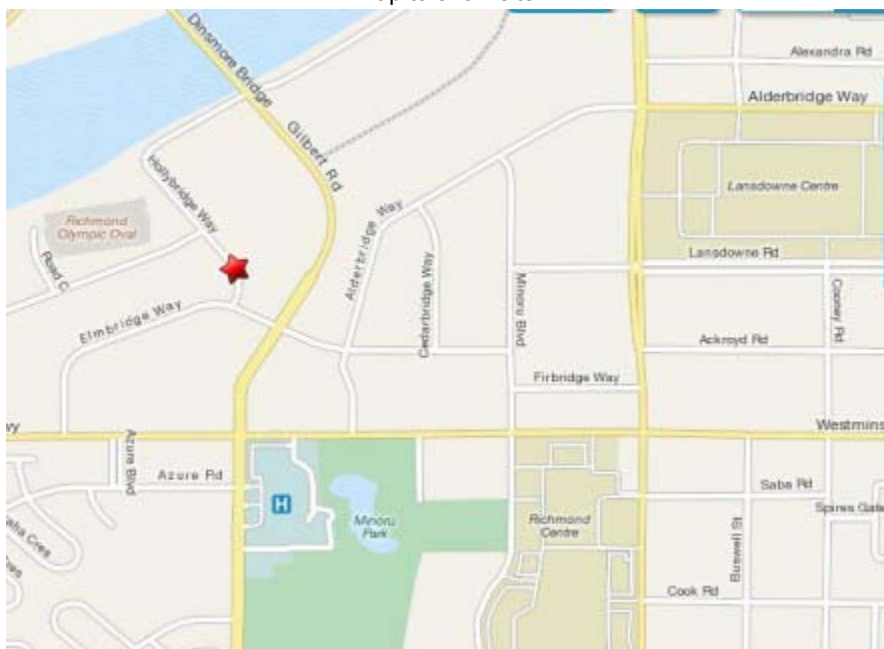

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Richmond Dog Fanciers Association and their respective members; directors; governors; officers; agents; superintendents or show secretaries and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
