REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open

Exhibition Only Veterans Specials Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed..

ALTERED CLASS: Competition for sexually altered dogs will be offered.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two or more of his Get .

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny.

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed and identical ownership.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Samoyeds at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for Samoveds at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for Samoyeds at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Runner Up in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be four classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 10 years for Samoveds at 7 years of age up to but not including 10 years. 10 up to 11 years for Samoyeds at 10 years of age up to but not including 11 years.

11 years plus for Samoyeds at least 11 years of age

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Runner Up in Sweeps.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class:

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Runner Up in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

First in each class will receive a prize and rosette.

Rosettes will be given for up to Four Awards of Merit to be chosen at Breed Level.

The Samoyed Association of Canada will provide suitable prizes and rosettes for the High Scoring Samoved in Trial and High Scoring Samoved in each obedience and rally class on Saturday May 19, 2012.

Suitable prize will also be given to all Samoyed qualifying scores in rally and obedience on that

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler or run through the building or stands
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling.
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The SAC and Amherst Stadium will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight. Dogs will **not** be allowed in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.

- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The SAC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the MGRC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- The precincts of the show shall be the arena and it's entrances.

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 21

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

The official CKC classes, divided by sex, will be provided. Enter one category only.

Junior puppy a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.

Senior puppy a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show

12-18 Month a dog between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of show

Canadian bred a dog which was born in Canada.

Bred by exhibitor a dog owned and handled by the breeder

Open class all dogs

Veterans a dog 7 years of age and older

Specials only dogs who are Canadian champions only
Exhibition dogs 6 months and over, not in competition
OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Pre-Novice for all purebred dogs over 6 months of age (Not eligible for HIT competition)
"A" classes for dogs handled by owner or immediate family member through all exercises

"B" classes for trainers, multiple entries, co-owned dogs, exhibitors who have attained a Cdn. OTCh degree or dogs who have

earned titles in another country.

"C" classes for dogs who have completed a CD title in Canada (Not eligible for HIT competition)

CDI Class Novice-Intermediate, for dogs who have earned a CD title in Canada. (Not eligible for HIT competition)

Open for dogs who have earned a C.D.

Utility A for dogs who have earned a C.D.X.

Utility B for dogs who have earned a UD

A separate entry is required for each class entered in obedience trials. To facilitate setting up the jumps in open and utility classes please designate jump heights on the entry form.

Entry fees will be refunded for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the show. To obtain this refund a letter from a Veterinarian must be presented to the Trial Secretary **before** the commencement of the trial.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

 All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY.

- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show / trials secretary after the closing date and time.
- Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- Y. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.
- Include with the above a cheque or money order for the required amount (plus GST or HST where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.
