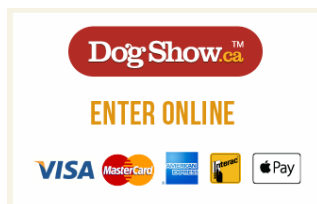

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- These events are held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club (CKC).
- Competitors, through the submission of an entry, acknowledge that they know and accept the CKC rules.
- Only official scents will be used in all CKC events, you can find a list of approved scents and rules at <https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/Scent-Detection-Trial-Rules-and-Regulations>.
- All dogs (pure breed, unrecognized breed, mixed breed) must be individually registered with the CKC or eligible for CKC registration.
- Dogs that are foreign-born and owned who enter Canada for the sole purpose of competing in CKC events do not require a CKC registration number, but do require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event.
- Dogs with Temporary Competition Numbers (TNC) will be charge \$10.50.
- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the award/titles earned, the non-member will have the choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only for dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

- Entries are limited. We reserve the right to refuse any entry. Handler/dog teams may enter one, two or all three components. A handler may enter a maximum of 1 dog in a given component.
- In the event that the entry limit is reached before the official closing date, an Alternate List will be compiled in the order received. Alternate dogs will be allowed to run in the place of any absent dogs. Alternate dogs which are not able to run shall have the entry fees refunded.
- The payment must be received with or immediately following the registration form. All checks must be made out to Guides Canins Inc.
- Each component & costs \$35+tx (40,24) before the closing date (Instinct test included). It will be possible to register after the closing date, if there is still room. The cost for late entries will be \$42+tx (48,28).
- For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries are not accepted.
- Scribe sheet copies will be available after each run.
- A ribbon will be awarded to each team earning a qualifying score. Title ribbons will be awarded for each title.
- Dogs who have earned a CKC title may advance to a higher level, provided that the secretary is notified in writing as soon as the results are published. Same day move ups are accepted (if there is room) must be done no less than 15 minutes prior to the start of the class.
- The results will be posted on site and published on the DogShow.ca website, as soon as possible.
- The ribbons will be awarded after each class.
- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.
- Participants cancelling before the closing date will obtain a refund.
- A refund will be issued for bitches that come into heat or dogs and handlers that are injured, providing that they send a doctor or veterinarian note and that the trial secretary is advised within 24 hours of the start of the first day they are registered.
- Any refund issued will be minus a 10% administrative fee.
- A \$20 fee will be charged for NSF checks and refused credit cards.
