Obedience Regulations and Standards shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the obedience trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that the C.K.C. is informed of any infringement of the Regulation, and the Board of Directors shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this Regulation has been violated.
- 2. Dogs must be kept under control at all times. Only dogs entered in these trials will be permitted in the building. T. D.
