GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ARGUS KENNEL CLUB

- 1. All entries must be complete, Note: the full name of the owner as well as the address must be complete. The club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject CKC rules.
- 2. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how the error was made. Changes or cancellation after closing date is prohibited. All entries must be in the hands of the show secretary prior to closing.
- 3. The Show Superintendent will have full charge of the Show.
- 4. Private Exercise Pens will be allowed only on permission of the Superintendent. <u>Abuse of this PRIVILEGE</u> will result in removal from the building. <u>PLEASE KEEP YOUR AREA CLEAN.</u>
- 5. Dogs not entered in the Show may not enter the building.
- NO REFUND of entry fees will be made if it is impossible to open or complete the shows because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the ARGUS KENNEL CLUB
- 7. 7. The Argus Kennel Club will use diligence to ensure the care and safety of all dogs exhibited but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of loss or damage to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators whether the result of accident or otherwise. All dogs must be under control.
- 8. The building will be open Thursday, at 7:00 p.m. for set up. Dogs may be left in building but there is no security.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born & foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. Dogs may be entered as LISTED; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 DAYS of the first event will result in the <u>CANCELLATION</u> of any wins, awards or scores. Any points or scores earned prior to January 1, 1992 are not subject to cancellation due to the lack of an ERN number. To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number. Include payment in full amount \$59.53 (Canadian). Provide a full return address. Faxed request will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa & MasterCard number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature.

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

CHAPTER 20 **CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

SECTION 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more	
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the Dogs in the competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best Breed of Best of Opposite Sex and then consult schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points Inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

IN NO CASE MAY A DOG EARN MORE THAN FIVE POINTS AT ANY SINGLE SHOW.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate the dog must

A: earn at least 10 Championship points under 3 different judges.

B: be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an ERN number.

C: have earned at least one 2 point win at either the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

DOG SHOW RULES. CHAPTER 13, SECTION 13, of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which has been assigned and "individually C.K.C. OR ERN REGISTRATION NUMBER AT THE TIME OF CLOSING" By the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of a championship, after the date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW, by the Owner or Handler

CLASSIFICATIONS

In all breeds recognized by C.K.C. the following classes will be provided for, divided by sex. JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months and under 9 months

SENIOR PUPPY - 9 months and under 12 months

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

12-18 MONTHS -dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. OPEN - for all doos

SPECIALS ONLY - for Canadian Champions.

EXHIBITION ONLY - For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with The Canadian Kennel Club

NOTE: In breeds where classes are divided by colour, weight, or coat, indicate clearly in the class division (champions of any country excluded) on the entry form.
