LIMITED ENTRY

When Judges' assignments have reached 7 hours, entries will close automatically, even if the official closing date has not arrived. CKC Rule 4.3.3.: The 7 hours is based on the formula of 9 Pre-Novice entries, 8 Novice entries, 7 Open entries, 6 Utility entries per hour and 20 dogs per hour for Rally. When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries may be assigned a position (by class) on the reserve list. The person making the entry shall be notified of his/her position on the list. In the event the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after the closing date, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to, and including, the day of the trial. BITCHES IN SEASON

Where a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial. The trial giving club will refund the entire entry fee.

*REMEMBER: SAME DAY ENTRIES AND MOVE-UPS MAY **NOT** BEING OFFERED AT THESE TRIALS DUE TO CHANGING COVID-19 GUIDELINES*

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBERS (TCN)

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event

Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

CANINE COMPANION NUMBER

A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows mixed-breed dogs and unrecognized breeds to compete in CKC Agility Trials, Obedience Trials and Rally Obedience Trials.

To be eligible to receive a CCN, all the following must be met:

The dog must be either a Mixed Breed (a dog of unknown ancestry that belongs to no recognized breed and is not the result of selective breeding) or an Unrecognized Breed (a dog of known ancestry no on the CKC list of recognized or miscellaneous breeds and that is registered with a Registry recognized by the CKC) Mixed Breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized Breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC microchip.

A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a Listed Dog. Dogs may only enter an event after a CCN has been issued to that dog. Dogs with a CCN will be entered as All Canadian where the breed is indicated on the entry form and in the catalogue. The CKC may cancel any Canine Companion Number.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registerable dog of a CKC registered breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Those events are as follow: Obedience Trials, Rally Obedience Trials, Tracking Tests, Herding Trials, Draft Dog Tests, Agility, Lure Coursing, Earth Dog Test, Hunt Tests, Working Certificate Test and Pointing Field Dog Tests.

To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following must be met:

The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC.

The dog, for one reason or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration.

The dog must be spayed or neutered.

The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (not necessary for ILP dogs).

The dog cannot be on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List.

In case of a foreign-born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC ILP number.

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS – ENTRY INFORMATION

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars, called for on the entry form, are completed in full. Handler and Agents, please note that the full name and address of all owners must be filled in. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Changes or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the trial. Judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after entries close. Any NSF cheques or credit cards will be subject to a \$25 service charge. Entry fee plus the service charge must be paid in cash prior to competing.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Trial precincts shall be the interior of the Canine Coaching Club. The trial chair will be in full charge of the trials, which will be governed by CKC rules. The TBK&TC and the trial committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume, any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused. Entry fees will not be refunded should a dog be absent, sick, lame or excused by the vet., judge or Superintendent. The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the CKC Obedience and Rally Trials rules. Indignities to a Judge 3.6.1 A judge officiating at a trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at any hotels and the trial site. Owners are responsible and liable for any damages. THERE IS NO CANTEEN OR LUNCH AVAILABLE AT THE TRIAL SITE. NO FOOD OR DRINK WILL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE BUILDING.

To remind everyone once again, changing Covid Guidelines will affect our trial format and entry requirements. Which, at this point, could include proof of complete vaccination. Please keep up to date on the club Facebook page for changes from the Ontario Ministry of Health and Thunder Bay Regional Health Unit. Guideline changes will be directed to CCC, the event facility, and the Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Club may be altering our normal trial procedure to keep current with the guideline changes so we can hopefully have the trials proceed.

We ask for your patience, the trial committee in conjunction with CCC are trying their best. By entering this trial, you are agreeing to follow the rules and procedures as determined by the trial committee. <u>If the possibility of changing guidelines do not suit you, please do not enter</u>. If your entry has been received, request to cancel your entry before closing and we will gladly do so.
