DOG SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

A copy of the CKC rules pertaining to Conformation Shows is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the CKC regarding their event.

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.3 states "a Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out'.

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.6 states "no person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action may be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act".

GENERAL INFORMATON

- The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Building will be open Friday 12 July for set up and for Friday evening events.. The building will open daily at 6:00 a.m. & close at 10:00 p.m.
- 3. To comply with CITY OF BATHURST regulations NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.
- 4. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- 5. No "Puppy or Dog For Sale" signs will be permitted in the building.
- 6. The NB Toy Dog Club will use all care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and the exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability, in the event of an accident or any misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron.
- 7. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or return of entry fees will be made.

TRAILER AND RV ACCOMMODATIONS

There are 12 spaces available for RVs and Trailers that are equipped with hook-ups. Fee is \$30.00 for the weekend and comes on a First come First served basis. Send remittance with your entry.
