GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

ENTRY FEES

CLASS INFORMATION

- Introduction to Quarry (IQ)** Open to all eligible dogs that have not completed requirements for a Junior Earthdog title or higher title
- Junior Earthdog (JE)**
Senior Earthdog (SE) For dogs that have completed the requirements for a CKC Junior Earthdog title
 A dog that has completed the requirements for a JE or SE title is not required to move up to the next level.
- Master Earthdog (ME)** Open only to dogs that have earned a CKC Senior or Master Earthdog title.
 A dog that has earned a Master Earthdog title may continue to enter any regular earthdog class and may enter multiple classes in one test, but no further certificates will be issued.

- Quarry used in these tests will be 2 adult rats -

ELIGIBILITY

- Tests are open to all purebred Dachshunds and those Terriers in Group IV and on the Miscellaneous list seeking eligibility for Group IV that are small enough to navigate a 9 inch drain. (6.6.1)
- Spayed/neutered/debarked dogs are eligible to participate.
- Dogs must be 6 months of age or older.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (Continued)

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. If you pay by personal American cheque, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Do not write "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par". This is not acceptable and will not clear the bank. To simplify the process, we urge you to buy bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Or to simplify the process use the THE ENTRY LINE. (see box advertisement in this Premium List)

Entries: Entries must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC entry form.

Confirmation of Entry: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return e-mail address on their form

Order of Judging: The order of competing shall generally be the order that entries are received with the exception of multiple entries from the same handler which will be separated whenever possible. Time and entries permitting, dogs that are entered in Introduction to Quarry and Junior Earthdog will be scheduled to run in Introduction to Quarry before Junior Earthdog. A running list will be posted at the site.

Schedule: The Secretary's table will be open for check in from 8:00am on each morning of the tests. Gate entries and move ups accepted at the Secretary's table up to one hour before the scheduled starting time of the class.

Border Crossing: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Canadian Food Inspection Agency regulations can be viewed at: <http://www.inspection.gc.ca/english/animal/heasan/import/dogse.shtml>

Event Registration Number (Foreign Born/Owned Dogs): For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born/owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of the dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$56.70 Canadian funds) along with the completed application form. The form can be downloaded from www.ckc.ca/forms or ordered from the CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040.

Regulations: It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC *Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations* are available from the Canadian Kennel Club at 1-800-250-8040

Validation of Entries: All participants are required to fill and sign the Earthdog Participation Agreement (EPA) on the reverse of the entry form. Entries submitted without this agreement filled in and signed will be refused participation in the tests. ENTRY LINE entries must sign EPA prior to competing.

REFRESHMENTS

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (Continued)

CKC Regulation 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Move Ups: Move ups are permissible from IQ to JE one (1) hour before the class or immediately upon the completion of the IQ level. Move ups are NOT permissible in the regular classes in one test, but are permissible for the next test. (eg dogs entered for JE for both Saturday and Sunday tests, but completing JE on Saturday, may move up to SE for the Sunday test. The Secretary must be notified of any move ups one (1) hour before the scheduled starting of the class.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in Season shall NOT be eligible to compete in the Test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Test Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test, must reach the Test Secretary on or before the date of the Test. Alternatively, the bitch may be presented to a member of the test committee no later than one (1) hour before the scheduled start time of the class to determine she is in season. The test-giving club must refund any entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

Awards and Prizes: Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry test will receive flat ribbons. Qualifiers in the Junior, Senior and Master Earthdog tests will receive rosettes and an individual prize.

Test Precinct: The precinct of this test will be the marked section of "Laurelwood", Pontypool, ON. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100ft) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE
Effective January 1, 2011, an annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a CANADIAN non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

From West (Toronto) - Take 401 East to Exit # 436 Hwy 115/35 North. Stay on Hwy 115 & exit at Rd #32/Porter Rd. Turn left (North) and proceed to Solanum Way. Turn right (East) and then right on Col. Williams Lane to end of road.

From North - Take Hwy 35 south of Lindsay and turn left (East) on Hwy 7A towards Bethany. At the Cango Gas Station go right (South) on Rd #32/Porter Rd. to Solanum Way. Turn left (East) and then right on Col. Williams Lane to end of road.

From East (Kingston) - Take 401 West to Exit # 436 Hwy 115/35 North. Stay on Hwy 115 & exit at Rd #32/Porter Rd. Turn left (North) and proceed to Solanum Way. Turn right (East) and then right on Col. Williams Lane to end of road.
