Brace

Non-regular class: For 2 dogs handled by 1 person, with 1 lead. Dogs must be entered in a regular class, altered class or exhibition only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed. Ownership does NOT need to be identical.

Stud Dog & Get.....And......Brood Bitch & Progeny

Non-regular class: A dog or bitch with 2 or more offspring.

Dogs must be entered in a regular class, altered class or exhibition only. Dogs may be

neutered/spayed. Ownership does not need to be identical.

Award of Merit

One (1) Award of Merit for every ten (10) dogs competing at the Best of Breed level (regular classes only) shall be awarded.

Puppy & Veteran Sweeps

Classes (divided by sex) are: 7 to 10 years, and over 10 years.

All dogs must be entered in the Specialty or in Exhibition Only; Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

Puppy Sweepstakes
