TRAVEL AND GATHERING FOR GROUP SPORT

SUMMARY

Under the current BC Public Health Officer (PHO) Order of March 31, 2021(see details below): -

Travel

- 1. You can travel for this Rally Obedience trial if your primary residence is in the Comox Valley or if you live outside the Comox Valley but are a member in good standing of the FPOTC (Section G. 2. of Order below)
- 2. You CAN NOT travel for this trial if you live south of Qualicum Beach or north of Oyster River on Vancouver Island, or the BC mainland (Section G.1. below). For reference see the map link below.

Gathering

1. No more than 10 persons may gather for an outdoor group sport.

ACTION REQUIRED BY EXHIBITOR

1. Evaluate whether you can travel or not for the trial.

2. If you should NOT travel to the trial under the current order, you may still enter, however your entry will be placed on a wait list. Should restrictions **NOT** be lifted by May 10th 2021, your entry will be removed from the trials. Paid entry fees will be refunded, **service fees will not be included in refund**.

DECISION BY FPOTC

- 1. The Canadian Kennel Club requires all clubs hosting events to comply with local public health orders.
- 2. The two relevant sections of the Order are shown below.

F. GROUP SPORT

1. A person may permit a place, other than a private residence or vacation accommodation, to be used for, or may provide, or may participate in group sport, if the following conditions are met: a. if the group sport is indoors, only two persons participate.

- b. if the group sport is outdoors, only two persons participate.
- c. the participants maintain a distance of three meters from one another while engaged in the
- group sport, unless the participants reside in the same private residence.

d. there are no spectators, unless the presence of a spectator is necessary in order to provide care to a participant.

2. No person may permit a place be used for, or may provide, or may participate in group sport, unless the conditions in section 1 are met.

3. No person may be present as a spectator at group sport, unless the presence of the person is necessary in order to provide care to a participant.

G. TRAVEL FOR SPORT

1. No person may travel for children and youth sport or group sport, including for training, practice, games or tournaments.

2. Section 1 does not apply to travel by a person to the person's home club sports facility at which the person regularly trains or practices.

2. FPOTC reserves the right to take binding decisions on entries and safety protocols.
