**********JUNIOR HANDLING*********

Junior Handling will be offered at both shows. Dogs being used in JH must be entered in that class when entered into the show.

Also required will be the Name of Jr Handler as well as the class he/she will be competing in. NO ENTERING AT THE SHOW!

*******ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS********

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN (Event Registration Number). This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have it's own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate along with the correct fee. All info can be found on CKC.ca



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

Temporary Competition Numbers: Self-serve Online Registration for Listed Dogs

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Chapter 15: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded Winners at a Conformation Show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more

Section 15.1.8. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level,

A class dog awarded Best In Show at a championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

Effective January 1, 2012 to read as follows: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points

In addition to the 10 point/3 judges rule: "In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion.....the dog must.....have earned at least one 2- point win either at the breed or group level".

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars ONLY. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.
