ENTRIES: Please complete **ONE(1)** official CKC Retriever Hunt Test entry form **per dog, per test** in which you wish to enter your dog(s). All entries must contain complete information as required by the CKC rules. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee in full, and all listing fees (\$8.82 including 5% GST) where applicable. A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number is not shown on the entry form or ERN notice. **Scratches** will be refunded in full for a bitch in season. All other scratches will be refunded at the field trial committee's discretion, other than a fee of \$10.00.

“Chesapeake Bay Retriever Club of Canada is a member in good standing with the Canadian National Master Retriever Club. As of July 1, 2010 only passes at Hunt Tests hosted by Clubs in good standing of the Canadian National Master Retriever Club are considered in determining eligibility to enter the National Master Hunt Test Stake”.

NOTE: Limited Junior and Senior Hunt Test entries due to combined tests.

- All qualifying dogs will receive a rosette.
- Pheasants, ducks or pigeons will be used on land and ducks will be used for all water tests.
- Bitches in season shall not be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the grounds.
- All throwers, judges and competitors should wear dark or camouflaged clothing.
- The Chesapeake Bay Retriever Club of Canada and its members will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- There shall be no training of dogs on the test grounds, except for single training bumper which are thrown by hand by the handler, within 24 hours of the commencement of the event or at anytime during the event.
- Electric collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by any dog on the grounds at any time during the event.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS AND SPECTATORS

RULE 20.7 of the Hunt Test Rules States: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

NEW CKC RULE - Non-Member Participation Fee: An annual non-member participation fee for awards (placings) and titles will be charged to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards (points) and titles to be cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

Release and Indemnification of Landowners and Chesapeake Bay Retriever Club of Canada: By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the event and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of the property upon which the event is held, together with their agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person, dog, or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant and all of his heirs, executors and assigns.

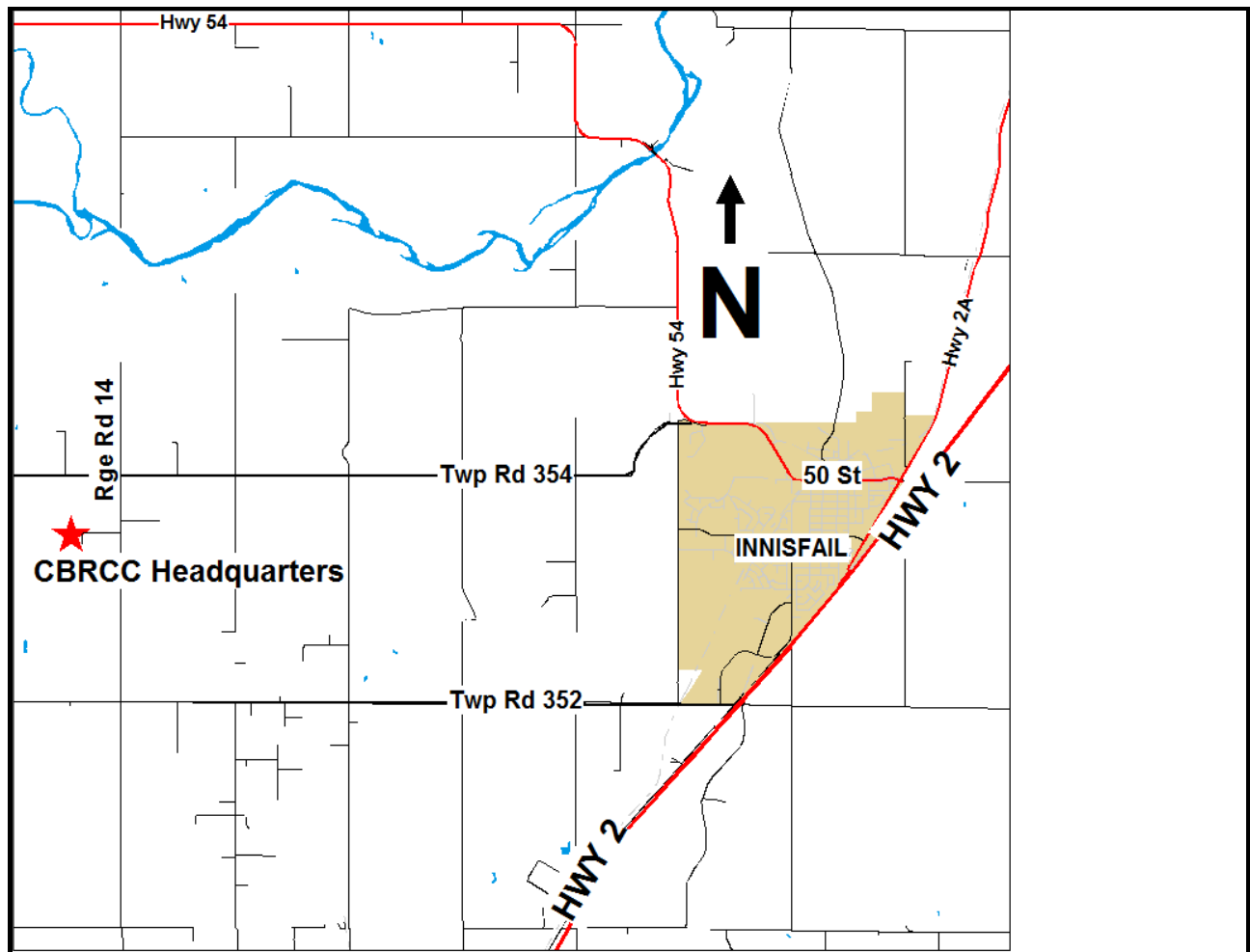
