SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Baby Puppy Class - Dogs 3 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non regular class.

Altered Class Dogs 6 months and older who have been neutered or spayed by a veterinarian. Altered dogs attaining Winners Male and Winners Female may earn Altered Championship points.

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The official CKC classes, divided by sex, will be provided. Enter one category only.

Junior puppy	a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior puppy	a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show
12-18 months	a dog between 12 months up to 18months on the day of show
Canadian bred	a dog which was born in Canada.
Bred by exhibitor	a dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open class	all dogs
Veterans	all dogs 7 years of age or older. Dogs may be neutered.
Specials only	dogs who are Canadian champions only
Exhibition	dogs 6 months and over, not in competition

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS - CHAPTER 21

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded Winners

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Building will open at 7:00am on Saturday& Sunday. On Friday, the Building will be open from **4:00pm until 8:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.**
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- **All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.**
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The RCC and CDC will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The RCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the RCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- The precincts of the show shall be the entire building and it's entrances.
