TRIAL 1, October 12, 2013. CLASSES TO BE TESTED......U. T.D. and U.T.D.X. Draw will take place at 8:00 a.m. each day with the first dog starting its track at 8:45 a.m. on Saturday, October 12, 2013.

Rendezvous at the McDonalds parking lot beside the Canadian Tire across from the College. We will then caravan to the first track at 8:25, there will be flagging tape given to the participants to tie onto their antennas to identify those in the Urban Trial.

ENTRY FEES: \$ 75.00 per dog/ Per Trial /UTD \$ 85.00 per dog/Per Trial /UTDX

LISTING FEES: \$ 8.40 per dog/ Per Trial

If a dog is not registered individually with the CKC it may be entered at a tracking test as a "listed" dog, provided that: (a) If born in Canada, it is of a litter which is eligible for CKC registration

- (b) If not born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration in the records of the CKC.
- (c) If foreign born and owned, it obtains an Event Registration Number (ERN) or CKC registration number, from the CKC within 30 days of the first test entered.
- (d) It is not a designated Miscellaneous Class Breed.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATON FEE: (Effective January 1, 2011) Policy:

Non-member participation fee

a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within

30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.

c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members

PRIZES: A ribbon stating "Passed U.T.D." or "Passed U.T.D.X." will be awarded to dogs earning these degrees.

NOTE: There will be a \$40.00 service charge on all **NSF** cheques received. Tendering of an **NSF** cheque shall be considered **NON-PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES** and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club.

All entries must be mailed in a separate envelope. Multiple entries in one envelope will \underline{NOT} be accepted.

Entries close Tuesday, October 1, 2013 or when the respective limits are reached.

Entries received prior to the opening date (September 10, 2013) will be discarded and all duplicate entries received for the same dog in one event on or after the opening date will be discarded.

Once the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries will be assigned a position on the "Alternate List" in the order that they are received. Entrants will be notified by phone or email that their entry has been received and accepted for the primary test or the position number as an alternate. Entry fees will be returned within 10 days of the day of the test to Alternates who did not participate in the test.

Upon receipt of a complaint, the Tracking Test Committee of the test-giving club shall conduct an investigation as soon as possible thereafter, but in any event, within 14 days of receipt, and shall conduct a hearing in accordance with the procedure for conducting a Tracking Test Committee hearing as provided in these rules and regulations.

TRIAL RULES:

- 1. Only dogs entered in the trial will be allowed on the test grounds.
- 2. All dogs must be on leash and under control at all times.
- 3. Bitches in season will be allowed to compete but will draw lots for the last tracks.
- 4. Spectators will be expected to obey any instructions given by the Test Chairperson.
- 5. The Competitive Service Dog Club of Alberta will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of the dogs competing, but will not be held responsible for the loss, damage, or injury to dogs or handlers and their property.
- 6. There will be NO prong, pinch or electric shock collars allowed on the test grounds.
- 7. EXHIBITORS MUST BE PRESENT WHEN IT IS THEIR TURN TO RUN THE TRACK. EXHIBITORS THAT ARE NOT PRESENT WHEN THEIR NAME IS CALLED WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- 8. The Competitive Service Dog Club of Alberta, its members, volunteers and the land owners will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. By entering this Test each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the Test and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) and/or leasee(s) of any property upon which the Test may be held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.
