REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred
Veterans	Specials Only
Veterans' class will be divided	into

7 years old up to, but not including 9 years old,

9 years old and older.

Note: if warranted, Awards of Merit will be granted at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Such award(s) will be given after the judging of Best of Breed.

Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered as Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.

Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes, nor are they required to be listed in the catalogue.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two or more of his Get.

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny.

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed and identical ownership.

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will immediately follow Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

For obedience enthusiasts, see additional information under Other Shows & Trials at the same venue.

OBEDIENCE

The SCWTAC will offer suitable prizes for Wheatens, in addition to those offered by the CBKC at their August 27 two-obedience trials, for Highest Qualifying score (for the day) in each class and for the highest qualifying scoring Wheaten (for the day) in Trial. Should a Wheaten take High in Trial, an additional prize will be awarded.

RALLY O

During the CBKC Rally O Trial #2 on Saturday August 27th, the SCWTAC will offer suitable prizes for Wheatens, in addition to those offered by the CBKC, for Highest Qualifying score in each class.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

- Junior Class, for dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.
- Senior Class, for dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.
- **12-18 Open**, for dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be offered to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps.

Puppy Sweepstakes: the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

- 50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;
- 15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;
- 10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps;
- 25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be four classes in all, divided by sex.

- for dogs at least 7 years of age and up to but not including 9 years,
- for dogs 9 years of age and older.

The winners of all four classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be presented to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps.

Veterans Sweepstakes: the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

- 50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;
- 15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;
- 10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps;
 - 25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

JUNIOR HANDLING

This will be scheduled at the end of our Specialty. The Wheatens do not have to be owned by the Juniors, and will be provided for those in need. Juniors between ages 4-18 are eligible. Allison Foley will be the judge for this event. Pre Registration is appreciated.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

BEST IN SPECIALTY

THE HOLWEIT CHALLENGE TROPHY, a Bronze Study of Ch. Holweit¹s Robin The Bank, mounted on an oak base, to be awarded to the Best of Breed Winner at the Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier Association of Canada's National Specialty. The winner will be presented with a Commemorative Study. For permanent possession, the trophy shall be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog. The trophy is to remain in the possession of Sylvia and Bill Hamilton or their designate until retired. A small keeper trophy for the Best in Specialty will be provided to the winner.

BEST CANADIAN BRED IN SPECIALTY

MAUREEN HOLMES TROPHY, 16 inch sterling silver revere bowl, will be awarded to the Best Canadian-bred Wheaten in Specialty. A rosette will also be presented. A donation to the AKC/CHF Health Fund will be made by the donors, Emily Holden and Carol Carlson in the name of the owner and the dog. For permanent possession, the trophy must be won five times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog. The trophy will remain in the possession of Carol Carlson or her designate until retired.

The Myshawns - Ambassador Award.

Donated by Margaret Stewartson, Saskatchewan, Myshawns Wheatens. "In Loving Memory of my best friend and companion..."

"Shawnie introduced me to the world of purebred dogs, the obedience ring, the show ring and the agility ring. Shawnie's life was in service to his community. He was the little guy with the big heart. He was a true ambassador for the breed. His memory will be lasting as my kennel (Myshawns) is named for Shawnie".

The Criteria:

1. The Wheaten must be CKC registered-- this means dogs from other countries can compete for this Award if they are CKC registered.

2. There must be at least 3 titles achieved from different areas of competition (for example: conformation, obedience, pet therapy, etc).

3. The titles will be evaluated as to the difficulty in obtaining these titles (for example: CDX is more difficult than a CD).

4. The dog must be or has been heavily involved in community activities and not just have received a certain number of titles (pet therapy, etc would be heavily weighted).

5. A committee must receive copies of titles and resume by the closing date of the specialty. The committee includes Margaret Stewartson, Susan Perry (1st recipient of the award) and possibly Catherine Maxim.

A plaque will be awarded along with an appropriate gift.

NEW from the CKC....Please READ

Non-Member Participation Fee Effective January 1, 2011 **Policy:**

a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.

c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

Information:

- 1. A non-member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt. There are 2 options for non-members: either join the CKC or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.
- Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.
- 3. The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs, titles or awards earned, and is assessed against the owner(s).
- 4. Non members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.
- Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.
- 6. Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog.
- 7. Once cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, titles, legs etc. earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.
- 8. The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points, titles, legs and is not prorated.

***Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved
