Started – Container, Interior and Exterior Vehicle Advanced – Container, Interior and Exterior Vehicle *limited entry of 75 components per day

If spaces remain onsite entries will be accepted. Entry forms will be available for completion at the check in table.

Entry confirmation: Confirmations will be emailed upon receipt. Payment is due upon confirmation of entry. <u>Payment must be sent within 48 hours of receiving confirmation.</u>

Entry Limits: Entries are limited to 75 entries total per day. Handlers wishing to enter a second dog may do so on **Sunday September 27th only.** Complete separate entry forms for each dog.

Refunds: Refunds will be issued for any dog withdrawing for medical reasons. A Veterinarian Certificate must be submitted before the start of the trial.

General Rules and Regulations: Through submission of your entry, you acknowledge that you have reviewed, and agree to abide by, the Rules and Regulations in the Master Rule Book on the SDDA website: <u>www.sportingdetectiondogs.ca</u>. Specific site related rules and guidelines will also be shared with competitors before and at the trial with the expectation that these will also be strictly adhered to.

TRAINING AND/ OR UNOFFICIAL USE OF ODOUR IS NOT PERMITTED ON TRIAL GROUNDS.

Dogs must be under control at all times. This is a fully public venue so respect for noncompetitors on site is a MUST. Pick up promptly after your dog and ensure your dog is on leash at all times when not crated. All dogs must be on a flat collar or harness in the search areas. Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment towards any dog will be asked to leave the premise without a refund.

Titles: All three (3) components (Container, Interior, Exterior) must be successfully completed (qualifying scores earned) to earn the SD-S or SD-A title. The SP (Special) designation will be added to the title of any dog that completes the three components on the same day, at the same trial.

Awards and Prizes: Qualifying ribbons will be presented per component, rosettes for titles and Certificates will be awarded for placements. *We are pleased to have the Alberta Havenese Association (AHA)* providing a fabulous prize basket for raffle and there will also be a door prize draw.

Check In: All Competitors are required to check in upon arrival.

Running Order: Will be decided by random draw and displayed for competitors.

Bitches in heat: Bitches in Heat **must** wear panties when trailing and will be placed at the end of the running order for each component.

Parking: Ample free day parking is available onsite, watch for the signage and parking stewards to direct you. There will be a reactive dog parking area, ask the parking stewards to direct you to this area if you require this space. If needed separate parking can also be allocated for bitches in heat.

Accommodations: <u>Onsite accommodations may be available stay tuned for updates.</u> There are several pet friendly hotels that are 5 minutes drive from the location (below). Be sure and notify them you are traveling with your pet to get the best rate, in some cases a pet fee applies.

No Shows: Are considered competitors who are not present as of the time of their level briefing and who have not made contact with the show chair to give notice. No show spaces will be made available to those who showed up for onsite entries.

Trial Site Directions: Site address does work in Google maps/GPS: Springbrook Multiplex, 3216 22 Street, Airport Drive, Springbrook, AB T4S 1W4 Watch for the **purple balloons** to guide you. Parking stewards will direct you upon arrival.

Directions From Red Deer – Take Taylor Drive Southbound to Highway 2A. Continue on highway 2A following the signs to Springbrook (approx. 10km), turn right onto Airport Drive into Springbrook. Turn right onto 34th Avenue and your first right onto 22nd Street, which leads to the Multiplex.

Directions Travelling from the North – From Highway 2 (QE II) southbound go past Red Deer and exit onto Township Road 374/MacKenzie Road westbound. Turn left onto Highway 2A southbound and watch for the exit to Springbrook. Turn right onto Airport Drive into Springbrook. Turn right onto 34th Avenue and your first right onto 22nd Street, which leads to the Multiplex.

Directions Travelling from the South - From Highway 2 (QE II) northbound take the exit onto Highway 42 towards Penhold. At the intersection of Highway 42 and Highway 2A turn right, heading north towards Springbrook. Watch for the signs indicating the exit into Springbrook and turn left onto Airport Drive into Springbrook. Turn right onto 34th Avenue and your first right onto 22nd Street, which leads to the Multiplex.

Next Day Move ups: Competitors who successfully complete the Started level on Saturday may move up to Advanced on Sunday, but must notify the trial committee *before leaving* on Saturday to request a move up. Competitors who complete Advanced on Saturday will not have the option of move up but may compete in the working stream for Advanced on Sunday.

Benching: Indoor benching will <u>not</u> be provided. Come prepared to bench in your vehicle or outdoors in the designated area. Pop up tents will be allowed however they must be removed at night.

Food & Refreshments: Springbrook Multiplex is home to **The Hanger Pub and Grill** as well as the **Springbrook General Store**. Both offer a variety of meal options to satisfy any craving!
