NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non-member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This non member fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.

In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

All Entry Fees should be forwarded to our Show Secretary prior to Closing Date & Time. Personal cheques & money orders for the full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to "THE GERMAN SHORTHAIRED CLUB OF CANADA" (can be written as GSPCC)

No post dated cheques will be accepted. A post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. **All N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a charge of \$20.00.** N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fee and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention USA Exhibitors: Please note that due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, **however**, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par", they will NOT be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we suggest that you purchase a bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You!

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR GERMAN SHORTHAIRED POINTERS

Regular Classes

The following Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only
Altered Class		

Veteran Class will be divided as follows:

7 years up to 9 years, 9 years up to 12 years, 12 years and older

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs: These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best of Altered In Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the Regular Classes

POINTS

Chapter 20, Section 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show held under the CKC Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship Points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of Championship Points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of Championship Points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breeds awards Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Non-Regular Classes

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class: shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only.

Brood Bitch Class: shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only.

Brace Class: shall be for two dogs of the same breed, colour and identical ownership

Unofficial Class

Field Dog & Field Bitch: For all German Shorthaired Pointers who have earned a Qualifying Score at a Licensed CKC Field Dog Test (Canada) or at a Licensed AKC Hunting Test (USA), or have received a placement at a Licensed CKC Field Trial (Canada) or at a Licensed AKC Field Trial (USA) prior to the closing of the entries

NOTE: All Non-Regular and Unofficial Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Be sure to mark non-regular & non-regular classes entered on your Regular Entry Form

PUPPY & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

These sweeps will take place Saturday 30th July 2011

Judge: Lynn Thomas

Puppy Sweeps

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class: for GSPs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months

Senior Class: for GSPs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months

12-18 Open: for GSPs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best In Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth place in each class as well as to Best In Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in sweeps.

Veteran Sweeps

Veteran Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 years up to 9 years: for GSPs at least 7 yrs of age up to but not including 9 yrs

9 years up to 12 years: for GSPs at least 9 yrs of age up to but not including 12 yrs

12 years of age & older: for GSPs 12 years of age and older.

Sweepstakes Prize Distribution

For both Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes the Class Winners will compete for Best In Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the Entry Fee for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class

15% of the Total Sweeps Entry Fees will go to the Best In Sweeps

10% of the Total Sweeps Entry Fee will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

DOG SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

A copy of the CKC rules pertaining to Conformation Shows is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the CKC regarding their event.

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.3 states "a Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out".

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.6 states "no person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action may be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act".

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ❖ The Precincts of the show will be the Show Site and Entrance, within 30 feet of the rings.
- ❖ The show Superintendent will be in full charge of the Show,
- ❖ Unless officially entered, no dogs under 6 months of age are allowed with the Show Precincts.
