NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial is being held under the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) rules.
- Competitors, through the submission of entry, acknowledge that they know the CKC Agility rules. <u>www.ckc.ca</u>
- All dogs (pure breed, unrecognized beed, mixed breed) must be individually registered with the CKC or eligible for CKC registration.
- Dogs that are foreign-born and owned who enter Canada for the sole purpose of competing in CKC events do not require a CKC registration number, but do require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event.
- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the award/titles earned, the non-member will have the choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only for dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.
- Entries are limited. We reserve the right to refuse any entry. Entries close automatically when the limit has been reached or at the date stated whichever comes first.

- In the event that the entry limit is reached before the official closing date, an Alternate List will be compiled in the order received. Alternate dogs will be allowed to run in the place of any absent dogs. Alternate dogs which are not able to run shall have the entry fees refunded.

- An invoice will be sent to you by email. Payment must be made promptly after receipt of this
 invoice. Registration will be valid only after receipt of payment.
- Payment can be made by electronic transfer to info@guidescanins.com with the answer to the
 question your dog's name in all small letters without spaces, without accent or by credit card
 directly from your account.
- The classes cost \$21+tx before the closing date.
- PRE REGISTRATION SPECIAL! 5 runs same dog -10%. 10 runs same dog 15%.
- It will be possible to register on site, if there is still room. The cost for late entries will be \$25+tx.
- All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- All contact obstacles and tables are rubberized.
- All single jumps have wings, plastic strip cups and are not attached, all tunnels are anti-slip.
- A wall and a broad jump can be used in all the courses and levels.
- An electronic timer will be used for all the events, in all the rings.
- In all classes, rosettes/ribbons from 1st to 4th place for dogs with qualifying scores in each division and height category. All dogs with a qualifying score will be awarded a flat qualifying ribbon. All titles will be awarded by a title rosette.
- Same day move up accepted.
- The running orders will be sent by email.
- The course maps will be sent by email two hours before the Trial starts and will be posted on site.
- The results will only be posted on site and sent by email at the end of the day.
- The ribbons will be available on a self-service basis.
- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.
- Participants cancelling before the closing date will obtain a refund.
- A refund will be issued for bitches that come into heat or dogs and handlers that are injured, providing that they send a doctor or veterinarian note and that the trial secretary is advised within 24 hours of the start of the trial.
- Any refund issued will be minus a 10% administrative fee.
- A \$20 fee will be charged for NSF checks and refused credit cards.

Personal cheques will be accepted; however they are payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out of the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques ``Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.
